At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 23 June 2012 at 24:00.</li> <li>• On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark.</li> <li>• Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green line towards Khan Yunis.</li> <li>• Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by firing several tank artillery shells from their positions behind the Green Line towards Gaza.</li> <li>• Israeli military Helicopters broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Gaza, Central Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah which killed 6 residents including 2 children and 2 Palestinian gunmen and injured 34 residents including several women and children and 12 gunmen.</li> <li>• Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching 91 projectiles and opening fire towards the Green Line.</li> </ul>
