JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli army continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Ein Al-Lawza area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets , stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they stormed a home and as a result injured 2 children: Diyana Taya (15 years old) and Baha Taya (16 years old) with moderate contusion sand detained a resident. (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:45, Israeli forces detained 3 residents including a child: Mohammad Al-Maghrabi (17 years old), Hisham Abu Al-Hawa and Mahdi Abu Al-Hawa in Jabal Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (ii) Israeli forces detained Ayoub Maraghat in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-

	<p>Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Silwad. (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ras Kar Kar. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the evening of November 9th 2013 and again at 03:30 on November 11th 2013, Israeli forces raided Beit Liqya, detained 3 residents including a Palestinian Police officer. (ii) At dawn on November 10th 2013, Israeli forces raided Silwad, clashed with its residents as they stormed several homes and summoned 2 residents: Abdel Karim Hamad and Hussien Hamad to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (iii) At dawn on November 10th 2013, Israeli forces raided Beitin village, stormed a home and summoned Musa Ghanam to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (iv) At 15:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Mazra'a Al-Gharbiya, clashed with its residents, temporarily detained Basel Sharih (A Presidential Guard) then released him at a later time. • Detention: Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Rabah Arfa (A Palestinian Police Officer), Ayman Assi and Billal Assi. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:40, Israeli forces raided Beir Al-Basha village until 15:15. (ii) At 10:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Yamoun until 11:40. (iii) At 12:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Silah Al-Harhiya and clashed with several school children. (iv) At 18:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Zawiya village and stormed a home. (v) At 04:40, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad, stormed a home, detained a resident (Fares Abu Baker) and confiscated a computer. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

	<p>Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 07:15, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv: checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Shufa and Izbat Shufa villages until 14:40. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:45. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mustafa Budeir in Tulkarem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:50, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Izbat Suliman village opened fire towards several labourers as they were attempting to enter Israel through an opening in the wall and as a result injured 2 residents: Baha Odeh and Hamza Owisat leaving hospitalised and temporarily detained the child Ismail Odeh and released him at 23:10. (ii) At 21:50, Israeli forces positioned at the wall gate in south Qalqiliya fired flash grenades into the sky as they surveyed the area. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate closed the steel gate at 11:55 and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u>Wall construction was continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:05, Israeli forces raided Tel village until 01:35. (ii) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Nablus, stormed several homes, detained 3 residents including 2 children then withdrew at 05:00. • <u>Detention:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:20, Israeli forces positioned at Huwara checkpoint detained Suhayb Nur, a resident of Anabta in Tulkarem. (ii) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Isam Al-Shunar (13 years old), Bara Thouqan (17 years old) and Yazan Nuri. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On November 10th 2013, Israeli settlers stoned vehicles passing along the road entrance leading to Beita and damaged a vehicle owned by Hisham Abu Zaytun, a resident of Beita.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 13:30, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea Junction until 10:40.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalim and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.

(ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks. (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic • <u>Flying checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance Al-Urub camp and temporarily detained 2 residents: Yusef Al-Titi and Hussien Al-Titi

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by raiding and opening fire towards North Gaza • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • Raid: At 10:00 on November 8th 2013, Israeli forces escorting several military bulldozers stormed 200 m into the vicinity of Al-Shuhada Cemetery in east Jabaliya and opened fire as they levelled a plot of agricultural land. • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 04:30 on November 9th 2013, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya. (ii) At 10:00 on November 10th 2013, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya and detained 2 fisher men after confiscating their fishing boat. • Detention: Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Saleh Abu Warda and Mahmoud Abu Warda off the shores of Beit Lahiya.

Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
