JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 17:00, Israeli forces closed Jaba’ checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jerusalem , Ramallah and Jericho thus preventing residents from entering or exiting the checkpoint and reopened it at a later time. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Sheikh Sa’ed village in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 18:15, Israeli forces positioned near the north Junction of Al-Ram fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on November 10th 2014, Israeli forces detained Majdi Al-Rajabi in Silwan neighbourhood. (ii) At dawn on November 11th 2014, Israeli forces detained eight residents: Mohammad Shriqat, Ehab Zahayqa, Baha Zahayqa, Tariq Hashim, Ahmad Amouri, Naziya Amouri, Mohammad Kadamani and Mohammad Obied in Jerusalem. • <u>Injury:</u> At 16:50, 3 children: Sufiyan Abdel-Jabbar (2 years old), Adel Khalaf (14 years old) and Mohammad Shwiqat (11 years old) were injured after a tear gas grenade canister exploded near Hizma and as a result were hospitalised.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshipers. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:20, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Thuri neighbourhood and chanted anti-Arab slogans. (ii) At 01:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Nassari neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem and sprayed pepper spray onto the face of Khalil Abu Zahrah as he was passing by the area. (iii) At dawn on November 11th 2014, Israeli settlers stormed Beit Safafa village and slashed the tires and spray painted racist slogans on five vehicles owned by owned by the Ibrahim, Khalil and Al-Mukhtar families. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sinjil until 14:00. (ii) At 17:30 and again at 22:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atarah Bridge until 23:15. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:45 and again at 17:30, Israeli forces raided Deir Abu Mash’al village, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards a local girl’s school and as a result left several school girls suffocated from tear gas inhalation and clashed with several residents. (ii) At 16:55, Israeli forces raided the city of Ramallah, and El Bireh confrontation took place, the child Muhamed Reda Gosha was temporary detained, and released later. (iii) At 04:00 Israeli forces, raided Silwad detained two persons. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained two residents: Mahmoud Awad and Musa Hamad in Silwad. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:25, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of “Ofar” Military Base/ Prison fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Kafr Malik village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 21:30, Israeli settlers closed the main road connecting Deir Ibzi’ and Kafr Ni’meh villages thus preventing residents and vehicles from passing through from both ends then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces at 00:20.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near “Aveni Hivits”. (iv) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Nabi Eliyas village and the agricultural road located between Qalqiliya and Nablus with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 14:00, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 16:15, Israeli forces positioned along the main road leading to “Havtish” settlement temporarily detained three residents: Abdallah Odeh, Bara’ Fuqaha and Riyadh Dabouri (All residents of Shufa village) for alleged stoning then released them at 23:00.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction until 16:15. (ii) At 19:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun, impeded the free flow of traffic after closing the main steel gate then reopened it at 20:45. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:30, Israeli forces raided Azzun. (ii) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Kafr Thulth, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:50. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ahmad Issa in Kafr Thulth. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 11:20, Israeli forces stormed Hajja village and served

	<p>demolition orders for four homes owned by Yusef Haliyan, Ibrahim Haliyan, Billal Masalha and Nathim Masalha for allegedly being built without a licence because of their location in area C which is under Israeli Military and Administrative authority.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 21:25, Israeli forces closed the main entrance gate at Huwara checkpoint during which Israeli settlers stoned several Palestinian vehicles passing through the checkpoint then reopened it 01:10. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Yitsahar” settlement located in North Huwarah, prevented residents from accessing the bypass road leading to Al-Jit village in order to allow Israeli settlers in the area then allowed them through at 00:10. (ii) At 22:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Bithan road located at the east entrance of Nablus until 23:15. (iii) At 22:15, Israeli force set up a checkpoint along Salim, Deir Al-Hatab and Azzmout village junctions until 23:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:30 on November 10th 2014, Israeli forces raided Salem village, stormed several homes and detained two residents. (ii) At 17:15, Israeli forces raided Askar camp in Nablus, served an eviction order for the home of the child: Nur Abu Hashiyeh (who was detained by Israeli forces after he allegedly stabbed an Israeli soldier in Tel Aviv) as well as ordering hid family to empty their belongings from the house for demolishing the home during which they clashed with several residents and fired stun and tear gas grenades towards them and withdrew at 03:15 (iii) At 22:05, Israeli forces raided Huwarah and imposed a cerfew then withdrew later. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:10, Israeli forces detained the child Nur Al-Din Abu Hashiyeh (17 years old) { A resident of Askar camp in Nablus) as he allegedly stabbed an Israeli soldier in Tel Aviv). (ii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Fadi Ishtayeh and Sharif Ishtayeh in Salim village. (iii) Israeli forces detained four residents: Khalid Abu Hashiyeh, Waleed Abu

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 18:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Deir Istiya with dirt mounds. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Qarwat Bani Hassan, temporarily detained several residents then released them after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officers. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 21:20, Israeli forces positioned near "Ariel" settlement temporarily detained Ashraf Fadel (A special needs patient) {A resident of Aqraba in Nablus} then released him at 24:00. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On the evening of November 10th 2014, Israeli settlers positioned near Za'tara checkpoint junction stoned residents and vehicles passing through the checkpoint and as a result damaged 30 Palestinian vehicles.

(ii) At 17:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho. • <u>Raid:</u> At 17:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Jiftlik village and clashed with several residents as they stormed four homes.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road

(ii) At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Kafr Itsoyon” settlement junction and prevented vehicles from accessing the main bypass road (60) connecting Hebron and Bethlehem. (iii) At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nashash area located in south Bethlehem and prevented vehicles from accessing the main bypass road (60) connecting Hebron and Bethlehem. • <u>Raid:</u> At 11:45, Israeli forces raided Kisan village, served demolition orders for three homes owned by Nasser Obiyat, Radwan Ghazal and Mohammad Ghazal for allegedly being built without licences then withdrew at 12:15. • <u>Detention:</u> At 07:00, Israeli forces positioned at container checkpoint detained Ibrahim Awad (A resident of Beit Ummar in Hebron). • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:45 and 19:15, Israeli forces positioned near Dar Salah village located at the east entrance of Beit Sahur fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning. (ii) At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 19:10, Israeli forces positioned near Dar Salah village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 07:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Taqou’ fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada’ Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron’s Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction,

the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

(vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiw Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna located near the wall gate.

(vii) At 13:40 on September 16th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron.

- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 14:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Tabaqa village and detained a resident.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 11:45, Israeli forces raided Mu'in village located in east Yatta, served demolition orders for a school and three homes owned by Mohammad Makhater, Issa Makhater and Yusef Makhater for allegedly being built without licences.
- (ii) At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Dura, clashed with several residents as they stormed two homes then withdrew later.
- (iii) At 19:15, Israeli forces raided Hebron, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched the home of Maher Hashlamoun (after he allegedly stabbed three Israeli settlers near Kafr Itsiyon) and detained three residents and searched a demolition order for their home.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 11:50, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Fuwar camp junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Juhar area in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- **Home Demolition:** On November 10th 2014, Israeli forces stormed Wadi Rakhim area located in south east Yatta and served demolition orders for two residential tents owned by Ihsan Shaniran and Saed Shaniran.

- **Land Confiscation:** At 09:15, Israeli forces stormed Al-Urub camp and served a military order for the confiscation of a plot of land in Jabal Abu Suda area for alleged military and security purposes.

- **Settler Violence:**

- (i) At 20:25, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli military forces stoned residents and vehicles passing along road (60) in north Hebron.
- (ii) At 20:30, Israeli settlers positioned near "Hagi" settlement located in south Hebron under the protection of Israeli military forces attacked several homes during which Israeli forces detained a resident as he attempted to prevent the settler attack.

- **Detention:**
