- On November 11th 2013, several marches took place in all districts in the West Bank to commemorate the 9th Anniversary of President Yasser Arafat's death.

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli army continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksha villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksha village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> On November 11 2013, Israeli forces imposed Afif Kastro to demolish a mobile home used to shelter his family after Israeli forces demolished their home which consisted of 2 floors almost 9 months ago in Beit Hanina. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> On the evening of November 11th 2013, Israeli forces raided Silwan neighbourhood then stormed an Athletic center in the neighbourhood then served the centres administrators a notice which prevents them from commemorating the 9th Anniversary of President Yasser Arafat death, during which they clashed with its residents and as a result injured a resident.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Obstruction of Places of Worship:</u> On the morning of November 11th 2013, Israeli settler under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces raided Beit Illu and clashed with its residents. (ii) At 15:15, Israeli forces raided Beituniya and stormed several homes. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces positioned at Attara bridge fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 students: Mohammad Dweik (16 years old) and Mohammad Al-Barghouthi. (ii) At 11:20, Israeli forces positioned at Ofar prison fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 11:35, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning leaving 2 residents including a child suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (iv) At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 12:40, an Israeli settler driving a vehicle chased several school children during which Israeli forces temporarily detained 4 children then released them at 13:00. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Provocation of Palestinian Security Forces:</u> At 12:10, Israeli forces positioned at Barta'a checkpoint seized a Civil Defence Fire Fighting Unite while it was returning from performing their duties of extinguishing a fire located near the wall gate the allowed it to pass through at 13:30. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services

	for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: At 16:00, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: At dawn on November 11th 2013 and again at 02:30 on November 12th 2013, Israeli forces raided Tubas, stormed 2 homes.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoint: Israeli forces continues to intensify their restrictions at ‘Eniv: checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Shweikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem, installed a checkpoint then withdrew at 22:55. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying Checkpoint: At 14:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Qalqiliya. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:30, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, temporarily detained 2 children: Nur Abed (13 years old) and Ali Abu Tabikh (12 years old) as they were near the wall gate entrance then released them at 17:40. (ii) At 01:35, Israeli forces raided Azzun and detained 5 residents • Detention: Israeli forces detained 5 residents: Ali Sowidan, Abdel Hadi Shabitat, Musa Saleem, Arwat Radwan and Ahmad Odwan. • Attack: At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Kafr Qaddum fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents after being struck by tear gas grenade canisters. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate closed the steel gate at 11:55 and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction was continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.

(ii) At 10:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Tel and Sarah villages, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning then withdrew at 11:55. (iii) At 10:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Assira Al-Qibliya and Orif villages until 11:10. (iv) At 11:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Sharah village junction until 12:00. (ii) At 05:30, Israeli forces raided Nablus, stormed and searched a home, detained a resident after assaulting his father then withdrew at 05:50. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Hirzallah in Nablus. • <u>Land Levelling:</u> At 12:00, Israeli military bulldozers levelled a plot on land in Al-Sarasra area in Qaryut village which is located near "Shilo" settlement.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 12:40, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint, detained residents for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Farkha village until 02:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint detained Wi'am Sa'aydeh , a resident of Tel village. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 07:00, Israeli forces positioned at the north entrance of Salfit assaulted Najeh Madi (51 years old), a resident of Salfit. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea Junction until 09:35. • <u>Raid:</u> At 16:55, Israeli forces raided Fasayil village.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the

exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.

- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) At 14:00, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) At 14:40, Israeli forces closed the bypass road leading to Khirbeit Al-Dier village with concrete blocks

- **Flying Checkpoint:**

- (i) At 08:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Jallah until 11:20.
- (ii) At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Taqou', temporarily detained several residents including Obayda Sha'er (A National Security Officer) and released them after obtaining their cellular phone numbers then withdrew at 16:20 .
- (iii) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up 3 checkpoints at the entrances of Jinata, Taqou' and Khirbeit Al-Deir village.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Ayda camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed a (UNRWA) funded school and as a result injured Sa'ed Odeh leaving him hospitalised with contusions.
- (ii) At 03:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Obidiya, detained 3 children and summoned Thaer Salah to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 05:40.

- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Fadi Sarhan (16 years old), Mohammad Abu Sarhan (15 years old) and Mohammad Abu Sarhan (16 years old) in Al-Obidiya.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 08:15, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Taqou' fired tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 09:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Ayda camp in

	<p>Bethlehem fired tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning and as a result left several school children including several journalists visiting the school suffocating from tear gas inhalation.</p> <p>(iii) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Nashash junction fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <p>(iv) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction has continued in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks. (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna. (ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Hebron. (iii) At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Wadi Qabbun area located in north Hebron. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Awwa. (ii) At 23:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Burj village. (iii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed 7 homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 05:45. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces raided Yusef Salhab in Hebron.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:10, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp, near Beit Awa junction , near Al-Tabaqa and near Al-Fuwar villages fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Mohammad Abu Sil (17 years old), a resident of Al-Urub camp. (ii) At 11:25, Israeli forces positioned in Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents and as a result injured 7 residents: Ahmad Taha, Salem Zibidat, Ahmad Al-Atrash and Lu'ay Abu Hadid as well as the infant Alaa Abu sneineh leaving them suffocated from tear gas grenades. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
