JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 08:00, Israeli forces closed Shu’fat checkpoint in Jerusalem and impeded the free flow of traffic (including several school children on the way to school). (iv) At 08:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba’ checkpoint, which connects Jerusalem, Jericho and Ramallah and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ijza and detained a Police officer. (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Suriq village and detained three children. (iii) At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and clashed with its residents. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Shu’fat camp in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near Anata junction fired rubber coated

(ii) Israeli forces detained Murad Salem (A Police officer) in Beit Ijza village. (iii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Mohammad Abu Ismail (17 years old) and Ibrahim Al-Shiekh (17 years old). • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces assaulted the child Khalil Abu Zahrah (17 years old) {A resident of the old city of Jerusalem}. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> On November 11th 2014, Israeli forces stormed Jabal Al-Mukabir and served a military order for the demolition of a home owned by Khalil Bashir for allegedly being built without a licence. • <u>Land Confiscation:</u> On November 11th 2014, the Israeli Military served an order for the confiscation of 35.1 dunumes/acres of land in Beit Hanina for alleged military and security purposes. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:00, Israeli settlers the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

	<p>15:10.</p> <p>(iii) At 17:30, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at Atarah Bridge, impeded the free flow of traffic and destroyed several Flags and posters of the late Palestinian President: Yasser Arafat (Abu Ammar) carried by residents as they were travelling to Ramallah city then withdrew at 16:00.</p> <p>(iv) At 18:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Mughier village.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city until 11:45. (ii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, opened fire towards several residents as they stormed a home and as a result injured Ahmad Hassuneh, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Samer Awad (A resident of Nablus) in Beituniya. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, again at 10:00 and at 21:10, Israeli forces positioned at Atarah Bridge in North Bir Zeit fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 09:55, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of “Ofar” Military Base/ Prison fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 7 residents including 2 children: Eyad Aliyan (14 years old), Ibrahim Qandah (17 years old), Mahmoud Aliyan, Eyad Samarah, Ahmad Harish, Abdel-Rahman Samarah and Ahmad Othman. (iii) At 10:00 and again at 19:30, Israeli forces positioned in Sinjil fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Abdel-Jawad Saleh (A resident of Awarat). (iv) At 10:35, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of “Pesagout” settlement in east Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (v) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (vi) At 14:10, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 20:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed the entrance of Silwad, stoned several residents and vehicles and as a result damaged a vehicle owned by Fadi Al-Madi then withdrew at 21:00.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 05:20, Israeli forces raided Bruqin, stormed and searched seven merchant shops, detained a National Security force officer and confiscated the Identification cards of Sami Ghaniyem (A Security force officer) and Amin Ghaniyem, and then temporarily detained Nabil Shaduf and Mohammad Shaduf then released them later and withdrew at 06:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ahmad Ghanayem (a Security Force officer) in Bruqin. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 15:40, Israeli forces temporarily detained Yusef Raba’ya (A resident of Maythaloun) as he was attending his brother court hearing

(iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near "Aveni Hivits". (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iii) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned at the west entrance of Taqou' fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
 - (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiwn Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna located near the wall gate.
 - (vii) At 13:40 on September 16th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron.
 - **Flying Checkpoint:** At 21:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main connecting Al-Fuwar camp and "Hadjji" settlement until 22:10.
 - **Raid:** At 12:05 and again at 00:45, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 02:30.

 - (i) At 08:40, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Fuwar camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 09:30, Israeli forces positioned at Beit Anun village junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (iii) At 09:30, Israeli force positioned near Halhul bridge fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (iv) At 11:55, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result killed a resident.

 - (vii) At 12:50, Israeli forces positioned in Bab Al-Zawiya area, near the entrance of Beit Kahil, Bani Na'im and Beit Awwa fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Mohammad Manassrah (14 years old).
 - **Killing:** Israeli forces fired live ammunition towards and killed Mohammad Jawabrah (21 years old) in Al-Urub camp.
