WEST BANK

• Closure:

- (i) On November 11th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound, which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- (iii) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks.
- (iv) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za'im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks.

JERUSALEM

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

• Raid:

- (i) At 07:50 on November 11th 2015, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and as a result injured 8 residents including 5 children: Mohammad Samer Hassan (10 years old), Malik Ahmad Ismail Al-Qam (13 years old), Mo'men Mohammad Shihadeh (13 years old), Abdallah Hussien Abu Latifa (14 years old), Mahmoud Ayman Matier (16 years old), Mohammad Ali Matier, Hadi Mohammad Aliyan and Ahmad Mufid Abu Maliya leaving them all hospitalised then withdrew at 08:35.
- (ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis until 05:00.

• Detention:

- (i) On November 10th 2015, Israeli forces detained four children {all residents of Al-Eisawiya}: Assad Murad Dari (17 years old), Sami Zuhier Al-Khatib (17 years old), Mohammad Abdel-Halim Dari (16 years old) and Annas Ali Abu Assab (15 years old).
- (ii) On the evening of November 10th 2015, Israeli forces detained two residents of Al-Eizariya: Suliman Abdel-Hay Al-Ajlouni and Hisham Al-Rajabi.

- (iii) On the morning of November 11th 2015, Israeli forces detained Jibril Al-Awar (14 years old) as he was in class after the stormed Silwan Secondary school in Silwan neighbourhood.
- (iv) At 17:30, Israeli forces detained Issam Abu Sariya (A resident of Jerusalem).
- (v) At 21:00, Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Ishaq Abu Sara (A resident of Shu'fat camp in Jerusalem).
- Assault on Places of Worship: At 11:30, a group of Israeli settlers under the
 protection of Israeli Military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound
 in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.

• Wall Gates:

- The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages
- (ii) . On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks.
- (iii) On November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Silwad and Ein Yabroud village.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 09:00 and again at 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atara bridge located in North Bir Ziet, clashed with several residents and as a result injured the child Badr Firas Sabih (14 years old) and detained a resident
- (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village and impeded the free flow of traffic after closing the steel entrance gate.

• Raid:

- (i) At 11:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, detained a child then withdrew at 13:45.
- (ii) At 03:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Jalazoun camp, detained 3 residents including 2 children then withdrew at 16:10.

• Attack:

(i) At 12:35, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near "Bet El" settlement in North Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (who were protesting against the continued Israeli Military and Settler assault on Al-Agsa mosque compound) for alleged stoning and as a result injured 74 residents including 44 from live ammunition and , 18 children {1 critically injured}: Ibrahim Abdel-Halim Daoud (17 years old){Critically injured}, Omar Mohammad Qandah (16 years old), Raed Hamad Sarisi (16 years old), Omar Bassam Omar (16 years old), Mahmoud Shaltaf (17 years old), Mustafa Khaled Al-Kasbeh (15 years old), Razan Mohammad Al-Ghalith (17 years old), Omar Ahmad Anis Hanoun (13 years old), Obieda Jamal Hajaji (17 years old), Wa'ed Samer Jaser Arrar (17 years old), Ahmad Talib Arrar (17 years old), Mohammad Mahdi (17 years old), Yasser Abdel-Wahab Ghandour (12 years old), Omar Akram Al-Rajoub (16 years old), Alaa Amer Al-Najjar (14 years old), Mujahid Ahmad Tukil (17 years old) Nadeem Arouf (17 years old), Mohammad Nawas Abu Qar' (14 years old), Yazen Mohammad Zied, Mahmoud Jamil Dars, Dima Najhat Issa

(ii) At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned at "Pesagout" settlement located in the east area of Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning (iii) At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and then detained four residents including three children. (v) At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Illo village fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (vi) At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Deir Nathim village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Sari Abdel-Rahman Odah and Hamza Abdel-Rahman Odeh (after being struck with a tear gas grenades to the abdomen) then temporarily detained the child Sufwan Abdel-Karim Ahmad Saleh (8 years old) then released him at a later time. (vii) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. **Detention:** (i) Israeli forces positioned at Atarah Bridge located in North Bir Zeit detained Husam Rajeh Lufti Musalem (A resident of Talfit village in Nablus). (ii) Israeli forces detained Adham Mohammad Aref Hamoudeh (15 years old) in Al-Berih city. (iii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Mohammad Hisham Hamoudeh Safi (15 years old), Ali Salem Dabour (15 years old) and Mohammad Wajid Mahmoud Safi. (iv) Israeli forces detained four residents: Mustafa Ramadan Safi (14 years old), Mahmoud Suliman Al-Sayed Suliman (14 years old), Aaws Mahmoud Yassin Najlat (14 years old) and Mahmoud Suliman Al-Masri. (v) Israeli forces detained Fadi Mahmoud Thiyab Hamad in Silwad. **Closure of Main Road:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. **JENIN** Raid: At 03:20, Israeli forces raided Sanour village, stormed and searched three homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:30. **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Billal Abdel-Latif Omar Issa in Sanour village. Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it. **Checkpoint:** At 11:15, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" **TULKAREM** checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 12:30.

• Raids:

- At 20:10, Israeli forces raided Anata, stormed a coffee shop then withdrew at 22:00.
- (ii) At 01:35, Israeli forces raided Shweikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem, stormed a home, summoned Shorouk Rayeq Raji Abdallah to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 05:05.
- (iii) At 03:20, Israeli forces raided the area between Allar and Ba;a'a, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 03:40.
- (iv) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Allar until 05:00.
- Attack: At 09:30, Israeli forces positioned in "Ghishouri" factory area located in West Tulkarem fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning residents (who were protesting against the continued Israeli Military and Settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound) and as a result injured 38 residents including 15 children: Fadi Baha Zuheir Fahoumi (17 years old), Waleed Salem Abu Sariya (15 years old), Mohammad Eid Sabri Al-Ghoul (15 years old), Mohammad Salah Nayef Abu Al-Rub (17 years old), Mohammad Abdallah Radwan (16 years old), Amid Mohammad Zubadi, Bara Muntasir Abu Thker, Mansour Zuhier Rabay'a, Karam Abdel-Jabar Abu Mukh, Husam Basam Malah, and Yahya Omar Sarhan and left 27 resident suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

• Closure of Roads:

- (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.
- (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.
- (iii) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel Gate
- **Raid:** At 13:25 and again at 02:00, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, clashed with several residents and as a result, suffocated Ahmad Radi Abu Assab from tear gas inhalation leaving him hospitalised, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:20.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Majd Saber Shatara Sharim in Qalqiliya.
- Attack: At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jaljouliya gate located in South Qalqiliya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as result injured eight residents and left 56 others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.
- (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
- <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.

NABLUS	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.
	(iii) At 22:00 on October 3 rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta village with dirt mounds.
	• Raid:
	 (i) At 15:05, Israeli forces raided Huwara, imposed a curfew in the town and forced merchants to close their shops for the alleged firebombing of an Israeli settler vehicle in the area as alleged by the Israeli military. (ii) At 21:35, Israeli forces raided Qabalan, temporarily detained Qasem Abdallah Mustafa Abed then released him later. (iii) At 00:10, Israeli forces raided Nablus as they escorted a group of Israeli settlers who stormed Joesphes Tomb, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 03:50.
	• <u>Temporary Detention</u> : At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Furiq temporarily detained two residents including a child: Mohammad Haytham Hanini (14 years old) and Ahmad Harbi Mohammad then released them later.
	Attack: (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Furiq fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
	(ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Sawiya school located in the area between Al-SAawiya and Al-Laban Al-Sharqiya villages fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured two residents.
	Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. Since 11:00 on July 30 th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.
SALFIT	 <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 11:15, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 14:10. <u>Raids:</u>
	 (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces raided Yasuof village and clashed with several residents. (ii) At 15:30, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya, stormed several homes for the alleged fire-bombing of an Israeli settler vehicle then withdrew at 16:00. Attack: At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Fariz area located in North West Salfit fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
JERICHO	<u>Checkpoints:</u> At 20:20, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District and impeded the free flow of traffic.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement, the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- (ix) Since 10:45 on September 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amous" settlement with dirt mounds.
- (x) At 13:35, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Beit Fajjar with cement blocks.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village located at the east entrance of Beit Sahur then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards until 14:35.
- (ii) At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards until 15:45.
- (iii) At 14:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jinata then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards until 15:50.

• Raid:

(i) At 07:45 on November 11th 2015, Israeli forces raided Taqou', clashed with several school children then positioned near the school entrance and temporarily detained the school principle Majed Al-Sha'er and Mohammad Jamil Al-Amour (12 years old) and released them at a later time then withdrew at 08:25.

BETHLEHEM

- (ii) At 04:20, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, Al-Aza and Al-Ayda camps and detained 2 residents in Al-Aza and Al-Ayda camps.
- (iii) At 04:45, Israeli forces raided Za'tara and detained a resident.

• Detention:

- (i) At dawn on November 11th 2015, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Ahmad Al-Ghafour (A resident Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem).
- (ii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Ahmad Foad Nofal Al-Sadawin (A resident of Al-Aza camp in Bethlehem) and Sami Hamad Yacoub Hamad (A resident of Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem).
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Khaled Ibrahim Taqish in Za'tara.

• Attack:

- (i) At 12:40, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Billal Bin Rabah mosque and in Al-Ayda camp located in North Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as result injured 2 children: Abdallah Samir Yusef Asdaqo (11 years old) and Ma'moun Abdel-Qader Ibdier (14 years old) leaving them hospitalised.
- (ii) At 23:10, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Betar village fired rubber coated steel bullets , stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

HEBRON

- (vi) At 11:00 on August 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Hajara village located in south Dura with cement blocks.
- (vii)At 05:50 on November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading Farsh Al-Hawa area in Hebron with Cement blocks.
- (viii) At 10:30 on November 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the junction located near "Hagi" settlement located in south Hebron with cement blocks.
- (ix) At 21:00 on November 11th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Veit Awwa and Al-Majd village with cement block and dirt mounds.

• <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 0900, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sa'ir then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards.

• Raid

- (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces raided Surif and stormed two homes.
- (ii) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Awwa, stormed several homes, summoned Thabet Mohammad Suliman Masalmah, Yusef Hussien Abdel-Fattah Masalmeh, Ehab Mohammad Masalmeh, Siraj Ismail Abdel-Hadi Masalmeh, Abdel-Sharif Nawaf Maslameh and Bassam Mohammad Ismail Masalmeh to report to Israeli Intelegnce for questioning.
- (iii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Wadi Al-Huriya area in Hebron and summoned Kamal Osama Jamal Al-Muhtasib to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- (iv) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Ahli hospital in Hebron city and stormed the surgery unit, detained a residents {A injured resident who was shot by a Israeli settler in Wadi Sa'ir as he was collecting Olive harvest as mentioned in October 26th 2015 report} and opened fire towards another residents asn as a result killed him.
- (v) At dawn on November 12th 2015, Israeli forces raided Dura, stormed and searched several homes and detained four residents.
- <u>Killing:</u> Israeli forces opened fire towards and killed Abdallah Azzam Sha'ban Al-Shalldlah (27 years old) {a resident of Sai'r} as they stormed raided Al-Ahli hospital in Hebron city.

• Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained Azam Izzat Al-Shaladah {A resident of Sa'ir} {who was shot by an Israeli settler in Wadi Sa'ir as he was collecting Olive harvest as mentioned in October 26th 2015 report}.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained four residents: Omar Tarik Darabi', Firas Khalaf, Tarik Khalaf and Mu'taz Sabr Abu Arqoubin Dura.

• Attack:

- (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Aroub camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 08:45, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 09:40, Israeli forces positioned near Beit Anoun village junction fired, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 10:20, Israeli forces positioned near Halhoul bridge fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (v) At 10:50, Israeli forces positioned in Sa'yadeh area in Beit Ummar fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (vi) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Ramat neighbourhood located in North Hebron fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (vii)At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned near Beit Awwa fired live ammunition rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.
- <u>Injury:</u> On November 11th 2015, 28 residents including a child were injured during confrontations with Israeli forces near the entrances of Al-Aroub, Al-Fuwar camps, near the entrances of Beit Einoun village, Beit Awa, Assaydeh area located in Beit Ummar and near Dahiyat Haram neighbourhood in North Hebron: Qusay Hani Masalmeg (16 years old) {A resident of Beit Awwa}.

At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of **ALL** movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be DISTRICTS held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Central Gaza. Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores North Gaza. Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad **NORTHERN** through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. **GAZA Attack:** At 09:20, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya area located in west Beit Lahiya. **Closure of Crossing Points:** (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. **GAZA** (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Attack: At dawn on November 12th 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green **CENTRAL** Line opened fire towards agricultural land located in east Deir Al-Balah. **GAZA Closure of Crossing Points:** (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed **RAFAH** (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and
