JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On the morning of October 13th 2011, Israeli forces closed Shu’fat checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic, and fired teargas grenades towards demonstrators who marched in solidarity with Palestinian detainees, who have been on a hunger strike for the past 17 days. The checkpoint was later reopened. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the evening of November 11, 2011, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Amoud in Jerusalem’s Old City, fired stun and teargas grenades towards several civilians for alleged stoning and detained a civilian. (ii) On the evening of November 12th 2011, Israeli forces fired stun and teargas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they stormed silwan neighbourhood and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Hamad Jaber near Ras Al-Amoud in the Old City of Jerusalem. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Atiya in Silwan neighbourhood. (i) <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim for the Sabbath holiday.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Rima, searching civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Taiba junction (on the main road connecting Ramallah and Jericho), searching civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ur Al-Fauqa. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:05, Israeli forces raided Kharbatha Al-Misbah, during which confrontations ensued between residents and Israeli forces. (ii) At 00:20, Israeli forces raided Beit Rima, and served Mohammad Zeid a summons to report to Israeli Intelligence. (iii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Beitunia. (iv) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Ramallah and detained a resident. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Ahmad Sufan during their raid into Ramallah. • Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages for the Jewish Sabbath.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. • Flying checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Mansour village junction, searching civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Arraba village junction, searching civilians and vehicles. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:55, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad.. (ii) At 17:40, Israeli forces raided Bir Al-Basha village. • Detention: Israeli forces positioned at Araba checkpoint detained Fayez Abiedi • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint to between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00 • Raids: At 11:30 raided Aqaba village.. • Temporary Detention: At 13:30, Israeli forces detained Muhieb Daraghma as he was herding his sheep near Khirbet Samara and released him at 15:00.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: the Israeli army increased restrictions on Palestinian access at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoints: At 19:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the western entrance of Beit Lid, searching civilians and vehicles. • Raids: At 09:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Shweikeh neighbourhood in Tulkarem. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall. • Wall Construction: Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route was suspended in the area surrounding Jubara village According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village for the Sabbath Holiday.
QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i>, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:35 and again at 19:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Immatin village, searching civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 11:05, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Hija village, searching civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 11:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Qalqilya, searching civilians and vehicles. (iv) At 11:20, again at 19:30 and at 07:45, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Jit village, searching civilians and vehicles. (v) At 19:05, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Azzoun, searching civilians and vehicles. • Raids: At 22:10, Israeli forces raided Jit village. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras 'Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended in Kafr Laqef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement for the Jewish Sabbath.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the

	<p>southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and 02:00 (ii) At 'Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00, and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. (iii) At 11:50, at 19:00 and again at 02:40, Israeli forces restricted access at "Shave Shomron" checkpoint, detained 4 civilians and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:50. (iv) At 11:40, Israeli forced increased restrictions at Huwara checkpoint, stopped a vehicle and temporarily detained 6 civilians and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Burin village junction, searching civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 19:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Maslakh area east of Nablus, searching civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Furik junction, searching civilians and vehicles.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Checkpoints: At 11:50 the Israeli army increased restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Deir Ballout and Rafat village. (ii) At 08:30 and again at 18:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Kafil Harres and Harres village, searching civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 11:45, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Salfit and Burqin, searching civilians and vehicles until 12:25. (iv) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint Qaryut and Zeita Jami'ya villages, searching civilians and vehicles until 13:00. • Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement for the Sabbath holiday.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Ouja village with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area. (ii) Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on

	<p>the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, again at 18:00 and 04:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance to Jericho city, searching civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Ein Al-Diouk village (northern entrance to Jericho city), searching civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Al-Nabi Mousa junction (the main road connecting Jericho and Jerusalem), searching civilians and vehicles. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces at the Allenby Bridge detained Alaa Khourish, a resident of Tulkarem, upon his return from the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan. (ii) At 13:50, Israeli forces at the Allenby Bridge detained Husam Sa'aida, a resident of Tulkarem, upon his return from the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 <i>dunums</i> of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 23:20, Israeli army continues to restrict access at the "Container" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:55, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Al-Nashaah junction, searching civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:55, Israeli forces raided Taqou. (ii) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Ibeidia . (iii) At 04:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Shawawrah village. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was suspended northwest of Beit Jala town for the Sabbath holiday.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzaq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.

Hebron	<p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.</p> <p>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.</p> <p>(iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village.</p> <p>(iii) Since 15. 10. 2011, Israeli forces closed two entrances lead to Beit Ummar town.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <p>(i) At 11:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar, searching civilians and vehicles.</p> <p>(ii) At 11:35, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Zif village junction, searching civilians and vehicles.</p> <p>(iii) At 15:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at between Surif and Khursa villages, searching civilians and vehicles.</p> <p>(iv) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Khursa village junction, searching civilians and vehicles.</p> <p>(v) At 07:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Younis (on the Hebron–Bethlehem road), searching civilians and vehicles.</p> • <u>Raids:</u> <p>(i) At 22:30, Israeli forces raided Abdat village.</p> <p>(ii) At 23:20, Israeli forces raided the area between Beit Ummar and Saffa village.</p> <p>(iii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou.</p> • <u>Detention:</u> On November 12th 2011, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar detained Thaer Abu Hashem. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 19:30, Israeli forces detained Sundos Al-Azza (17 years) and released her at a later time. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 19:00, Israeli settlers assaulted Hijazi Jaber; he was hospitalized. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was suspended in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town for the Jewish Sabbath.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from its positions at the Green Line towards North Gaza and Israeli naval vessels opened fire at Palestinian fishermen off the shores of Rafah.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed. • Attack: At 06:30, on November 12th 2011, Israeli forces opened fire towards Palestinian farmers in Beit Lahia.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. • Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed • Sufa Crossing is closed. • Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed. • Al Awda crossing – Rafah is open for patients, students and civilians with permits. • Attacks: At 04:30 on November 12th 2011 Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Rafah.
