- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 19:30, Israeli forces detained Sundos Al-Azza (17 years) and released her at a later time.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 19:00, Israeli settlers assaulted Hijazi Jaber; he was hospitalized.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town for the Jewish Sabbath.

GAZA STRIP

At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed ALL on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from its positions DISTRICTS at the Green Line towards North Gaza and Israeli naval vessels opened fire at Palestinian fishermen off the shores of Rafah. Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed. Attack: At 06:30, on November 12th 2011, Israeli forces opened fire towards **NORTHERN GAZA** Palestinian farmers in Beit Lahia. **Closure of Crossing Points:** (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. **GAZA** (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. **Closure of Crossing Points:** Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed. Al Awda crossing – Rafah is open for patients, students and civilians with **RAFAH** permits. **Attacks:** At 04:30 on November 12th 2011 Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Rafah.
