| JERUSALEM | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya and detained two residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on November 12th 2014, Israeli forces detained Raed Assaliya in the old city of Jerusalem. (ii) At 01:30 on November 12th 2014, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Bakri in Sur Bahar village. (iii) At dawn on November 13th 2014, Israeli forces detained 10 residents including a child: Misalam Odeh (14 years old), Ehab Hamdan, Hamza Abbassi, Hiba Makiya, Mohammad Abu Lafi, Mu’amar Abu Al-Hawa, Ramzi Ibrahim, Mo’yad Eiwisat, Fadi Eiwisat and Shadi Eiwisat. (iv) Israeli forces detained two residents in Al-Eizariya: Mustafa Basa and Ahmad Basa. • <u>Settlement Activity:</u> On November 12th 2014, Israeli Authorities approved plans for the construction of 200 settlement units in “Ramot” settlement located in North Jerusalem on land occupied in 1967. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli settlers the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshipers. (ii) At 12:30, the former head of the Israeli Security Agency (Shabak): Ami Yalon under the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> |

(ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces positioned at the west entrance of Al-Mughier village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Beit Illu fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 16:25, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 09:15, Israeli settlers positioned at the bypass road near “Ofrat” settlement chanted anti-Arab slogans then withdrew at 11:40. |

(iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near “Aveni Hivits”. (iv) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Nabi Eliyas village and the agricultural road located between Qalqiliya and Nablus with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 13:15, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Shweikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:30 and again at 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Azzun, temporarily detained Amar Shabita (a Civil Defence officer) and released him later and withdrew at 18:50. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 12:40, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate located at the entrance of Azzun Atma assaulted Ayman Salah (A resident of Bidya) as they temporarily detained him and confiscated his identification card. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. |

(iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance. • Attack: On the afternoon of November 12th 2014, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Rafah and destroyed a fishing boat. |
