<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On November 12th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound, which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks. (iv) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za’im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 07:45 on November 12th 2015, Israeli forces closed Shu’fat checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until reopening it later. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On November 12th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and detained two residents. (ii) At 17:30, Israeli forces raided Qutna village, stormed a home and detained a resident. (iii) At 17:45, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and Al-Eizariya until 19:40. • <u>Attack:</u> At 07:45 on November 12th 2015, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Shu’fat checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On November 12th 2015, Israeli forces detained Na’ima Hamdan (A resident of Jerusalem). (ii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Mahmoud Issam and Maher Al-Qadamani in Al-Eisawiya village. (iii) Israeli forces detained Adam Musa Mohammad Taha in Qutna village.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Expulsion:</u> On November 12th 2015, Israeli authorities served expulsion orders for Nasser Ajjaj from Al-Aqsa mosque compound for a period 45 days in the old city of Jerusalem and two residents: Hamza Ajjaj and Ahed Al-Rashq for a period of 1 month from Al-Aqsa mosque compound. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages (ii) . On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near “Bet El” settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) On November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Silwad and Ein Yabroud village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atara bridge located in North Bir Ziet, and impeded the free flow of traffic • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Qubbar village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 05:50.
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on November 12th 2015, Israeli forces raided Barta’a village and detained a resident. (ii) On the morning of November 12th 2015, Israeli forces raided Bi’r Al-Basha village, stormed, and searched two homes. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Alaa Rateb Qubha in Barta’a village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
<p style="text-align: center;">TUBAS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Property:</u> On November 12th 2015, Israeli forces forcibly removed 13 families from their homes from 06:30 until 12:00 on November 9th 2015 in Hamsah Al-Foqa village located in the North Jordan valley in Tubas for alleged military training in the area.
<p style="text-align: center;">TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Attack:</u> On November 12th 2015, Israeli forces positioned in “Ghishouri” factory area located in West Tulkarem fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning residents (who were protesting against the continued Israeli Military and Settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound) and as a result injured 14 residents and left 23 resident suffocated from tear gas inhalation and also detained a University student. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces positioned in “Ghishouri” factory area located in West Tulkarem detained Qassim Sadouq (A University student).

<p style="text-align: center;">QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel Gate • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction then searching vehicles and inspecting residents Identification cards until 23:00. • <u>Raid:</u> On November 12th 2015, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, clashed with several residents and as a result injured seven residents and left 27 others suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) At 22:00 on October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Shave Shomron" settlement junction then searching vehicles and inspecting residents Identification cards until 22:30. • <u>Detention:</u> At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint in Beit Furiq detained two residents: Mohammad Salman Mohammad Hanini and Malik Aziz Hanini {Both residents of Beit Furiq}. • <u>Attack:</u> On the morning of November 12th 2015, Israeli forces positioned in east Azmout village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and temporarily detained the child Murad Nafe' Sawalha (17 years old) then released him at a later time.
<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint detained Suhayeb Atef Ziyad Bani Odeh (A resident of Tamoun in Tubas district).
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District and impeded the free flow of traffic.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. (ix) Since 10:45 on September 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amous" settlement with dirt mounds. • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on November 12th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Ubidiya and detained a resident. (ii) At dawn on November 12th 2015, Israeli forces raided Nihalin village and detained three residents. (iii) At dawn on November 12th 2015, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and Beit Jallah. • <u>Detention:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli force detained Jawad Hassan Radaydeh in Al-Obidiya. (ii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Abdel-Kareem Shakarneh, Abdel-Hadi Shakarneh and Bara' Radwan Ghayatha in Nihalin village.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
 - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
 - (vi) At 11:00 on August 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Hajara village located in south Dura with cement blocks.
 - (vii) At 05:50 on November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading Farsh Al-Hawa area in Hebron with Cement blocks.
 - (viii) At 10:30 on November 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the junction located near "Hagi" settlement located in south Hebron with cement blocks.
 - (ix) At 21:00 on November 11th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Veit Awwa and Al-Majd village with cement block and dirt mounds.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 19:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bani Na'im Sa'ir then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards.
 - (ii) At 19:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards.
- **Raid:** At dawn on November 13th 2015, Israeli forces raided Hebron and detained three residents after storming their homes.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Sameh Ammar Assa'id, Diyab Musa Al-Junaydi and Muhab Musa Al-Junaydi
- **Attack:** On the afternoon of November 12th 2015, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Sa'ir fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Mahmoud Mohammad Al-Shalladeh (22 years old){Critically injured}.
- **Destruction of Property:** On November 12th 2015, Israeli forces stormed Khilat Al-Bakar area located in Jabal Juhar in the old city of Hebron and demolished several barracks and a Live stock barn and confiscated A dairy preservation cooler and several electrical pumps {used to milk cows} owned by Adnan Al-Rajabi and a member of Idris family.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • Attack: At 21:15 on November 11th 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land located east of Al-Shuada cemetery in east Jabaliya.
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
