WEST BANK

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem and has set up checkpoints in the old city of Jerusalem and around Al Aqsa Mosque compound. • Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Qalandiya checkpoint and to impede civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up at the entrance to the village of Beit Iksa and to impede civilian access. • Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, Beit Hanina, and around the settlement of Ma'ale Adumim. • Flying Checkpoint: The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the settlement of Ma'ale Adumim and searched civilians and vehicles. • Raid: The Israeli army raided the town of Abu Dis and arrested 1 civilian. • Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Ali Saleh Muhsen in the town of Abu Dis. • Demonstration: A mass demonstration took place in the town of Al 'Eizariya in protest against Wall construction. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilian protestors.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: At 14:45, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at the 'Atara overpass checkpoint. The Israeli army then closed the checkpoint, denying civilian access in both directions, and reopened it at a later time. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the areas of Al Midya to Budrus, Al Midya to Ni'lin, Bil'in to Saffa, in the village of Beit Liqya, and in the town of Beituniya. • Flying Checkpoint: At 18:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the settlement of Rimonim on Al Mu'arajat road connecting the districts of Ramallah and Jericho, searched civilian vehicles, and arrested 2 civilians. • Raids: From 21:00 until 21:30, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided and patrolled the villages of Qarawat Bani Zeid and Mazari' an Nubani. • Arrests: Israeli troops positioned at the flying checkpoint set up on the junction to the settlement of Rimonim on Al Mu'arajat road arrested 2 civilians:

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) 'Anan Waleed Saleh; and (ii) Ayham Ahmed Qar'an. • Settler Violence/Physical Assault: A group of Israeli settlers from the settlement of Ma'ale Levona severely beat 1 female civilian from the village of Sinjil, after which she was transported to hospital for treatment of injuries sustained.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades As Suweitat road southeast of the city of Jenin. • Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas and to impede civilian access. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. • Raids/Detentions/House Occupation/School Disruption: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:45, Israeli Special Forces, supported by 20 Israeli army jeeps, raided the city of Jenin, raided 1 commercial complex, detained civilians inside, and arrested 2 civilians. The Israeli army also occupied 1 house, converted it into a military post, and withdrew at 03:00. (ii) At 16:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Zububa. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians, after which the Israeli army arrested 5 children and withdrew at 17:00. (iii) At 07:20, the Israeli army, including 30 jeeps, raided the town of Az Zababida, surrounded 1 dormitory belonging to students from the Arab American University, and detained students after forcing them to evacuate. The Israeli army also opened intensive fire towards the dormitory although a number of students were present inside. Additionally, the Israeli army surrounded a number of houses neighbouring the dormitory, claiming to be searching for wanted individuals. The Israeli army remains positioned in the area as of 08:00 this morning. • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the city of Jenin: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Abdul Jabbar Mohammed Jarrar; and (ii) Abdul Basset Abdul Lateef Jameel al Hajj. The Israeli army arrested 5 children in the village of Zububa: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iii) Ahmed Rafiq 'Amarneh, 12 years old; (iv) 'Assem Ibrahim Abu Nassar, 13 years old; (v) Harb Jamal al Mutayyam, 14 years old; (vi) Waheeb Hisham 'Atatrah, 15 years old; and (vii) Mahmoud Jamal al Mutayyam, 17 years old.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the iron gate set up on the junction to the settlement of 'Einav along the Tulkarem-Nablus road, denying access to civilian vehicles in both directions.

	<p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the roads from the town of Bal'a to Dahiyat Iktaba, the town of Deir al Ghusun, and the village of Al 'Atara, as well as the road between the town of Kafr al Labad and the village of Al Hafasa.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. • Flying Checkpoints: <p>(i) At 10:35, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Far'un and searched civilians and vehicles.</p> <p>(ii) At 20:35, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the town of Bal'a and searched civilians and vehicles.</p> • Raids: <p>(i) At 10:35, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the towns of 'Anabta and Bal'a.</p> <p>(ii) At 01:55, the Israeli army raided the city of Tulkarem and Tulkarem refugee camp and arrested 3 civilians. At 4:30, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.</p> • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the city of Tulkarem and Tulkarem refugee camp: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) 'Omar Mahmoud Abu Tammam; (ii) 'Azeez 'Imad Hattab; and (iii) Ala' Kamal 'Azem.
<p style="text-align: center;">QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Gates: <p>(i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector.</p> • Wall Construction: Land levelling for Wall construction continues in the village of Immatin and east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun. • Flying Checkpoint: At 08:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Hajja and searched civilians and vehicles.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the main road leading to the district of Jenin between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. Alternatively, the Israeli army has forced civilians to travel along an unpaved 1.5-km-long road, which branches off from the Nablus-Tulkarem road and intersects with the Nablus-Jenin road opposite the village of Sabastiya.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira ash Shamaliya.</p> • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing Huwwara, Beit Iba, At Tur Mountain, and Beit Furik checkpoints around the city of Nablus. The Israeli army closes the checkpoints overnight and

	<p>reopens them at various morning hours, with the exception of Huwwara checkpoint where civilians may exit the city of Nablus from 05:00 to 23:00 only, but entry is allowed around the clock.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid/Detention/Destruction of Property:</u> At 00:15, the Israeli army, accompanied by 1 bulldozer, raided the city of Nablus, ‘Askar refugee camp, and the neighbourhood of the ‘popular’ housing project east of the city of Nablus. In the neighbourhood of the ‘popular’ housing project, the Israeli army surrounded 1 building and detained residents after forcing them to evacuate. An armed confrontation took place between an armed Palestinian individual and the Israeli army, during which the Israeli army killed the Palestinian individual. An Israeli army bulldozer demolished the wall surrounding the building on the corpse of the killed individual. Subsequently, the Israeli army searched a number of houses in the city, refugee camp, and the neighbourhood of the ‘popular’ housing project, arrested 8 civilians, including 3 brothers, and withdrew at 05:30. • <u>Killing:</u> The Israeli army killed Amjad Rashid Hinnawi in the neighbourhood of the ‘popular’ housing project east of the city of Nablus. • <u>Arrests:</u> The Israeli army arrested 8 civilians in the city of Nablus, ‘Askar refugee camp, and the neighbourhood of the ‘popular’ housing project: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Ayman ‘Adel al Mathbouh; (ii) Ihab ‘Adel al Mathbouh; (iii) Ala’ ‘Adel al Mathbouh; (iv) Mahmoud Sameeh al Habash; (v) Ibrahim Mohammed Kittaneh; (vi) As’ad Ghassan al Masri; (vii) Waheeb al Masri; and (viii) Ahmed Nabhan Saqr. (ix) At 16:00, Israeli troops positioned at Huwwara checkpoint arrested Zeidan Mustafa Bsharat. • <u>Settler Violence/Destruction of Property:</u> At 17:30, a group of Israeli settlers set fire to civilian land cultivated with olive trees in the village of ‘Awarta, damaging a number of trees.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades. The road has been closed since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of Qarawat Bani Hassan with an iron gate. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the towns of Jamma’in and Kafr ad Dik with cement blocks. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close the western entrance to the village of Bruqin with dirt barricades. (v) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the road connecting the town of Deir Ballut and the village of Rafat.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Deir Ballut checkpoint overnight and open it at various morning hours, impeding civilian access. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues near the Green Line in the town of Deir Ballut and the villages of Az Zawiya and Rafat, northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari'el.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja is closed with cement blocks. The Israeli army prevents farmers not holding Jericho ID cards from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also sporadically impedes civilian movement into the city of Jericho, except for Jerusalem and Jericho ID holders. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Al Hamra checkpoint on the road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:55, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the junction to the settlement of Vered Yericho and searched civilians and vehicles until 10:30. (ii) At 10:45, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of 'Ein ad Duyuk and searched civilian vehicles.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the road to the village of An Nu'man in the north-eastern Bethlehem district, isolating the village. The Israeli army considers the civilians' residence in the village illegal because they hold West Bank identity cards while their village is located within the Israeli-defined municipal boundaries of Jerusalem. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the villages of Husan and Nahhalin with cement blocks. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up near the settlement of Kfar 'Eztion on Road # 60 connecting the districts of Bethlehem and Hebron and to impede civilian access. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues north of 'Ayda refugee camp towards the area north of the city of Beit Jala. • <u>Raids/Destruction of Property:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, and again at 22:25, an Israeli army patrol raided the city of Bethlehem, set up a checkpoint, searched civilians and vehicles, and patrolled the area. At 23:25, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. (ii) At 14:10, the Israeli army raided 'Ayda refugee camp. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians.

	<p>(iii) At 00:40, the Israeli army raided the town of Al Khadr, searched 1 house, damaged the house's furniture, and arrested 1 civilian. At 01:30, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.</p> <p>(iv) At dawn, the Israeli army raided the village of Husan and arrested 1 civilian.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrests: (i) The Israeli army arrested 'Imad Isma'il Mohammed 'Issa in the town of Al Khadr. (ii) The Israeli army arrested Hussein Hamamreh in the village of Husan.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and barbed wire Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh, and with an iron gate the old gold market, all in the H2 section of the city of Hebron, denying access to civilians and vehicles. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the only entrance to Al 'Arrub refugee camp with an iron gate. • Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close Road # 60 that passes through the Gush 'Etzion settlement block on the road to the city of Hebron. The Israeli army also continues to force civilian vehicles travelling between the districts of Hebron and Bethlehem to take the eastern road that connects the town of Za'tara junction, located east of the city of Bethlehem, to the city of Hebron. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close Road # 35 between the towns of Tarqumiya and Idhna, denying access to civilian vehicles. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues west of the town of Surif to Beit Ula, in the town of Idhna, from the village of Deir Samit to the village of Beit 'Awwa, from Beit 'Awwa to the village of Al Burj, and south of the towns of Adh Dhahiriya and As Samoa'. • Flying Checkpoints: (i) The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the overpass to the town of Beit Kahil and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Dura, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded civilian access. • Raid: At 22:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Hebron and the town of Dura.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Israeli army continues to impose a closure on Gaza Strip districts, after a Palestinian individual carried out a suicide attack in the city of Al Khudeira (Hadera) inside the Green Line, and to prevent civilians and workers from crossing the Green Line.

<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open to humanitarian cases and VIPs only. • Attacks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:55, the Israeli army fired 3 tank shells from its location inside the Green Line towards Palestinian territory opposite Point 58 on the Green Line east of the town of Jabalya. At 19:20, the Israeli army fired 1 more shell. (ii) At 19:50, the Israeli army fired 3 tank shells from its location inside the Green Line towards Palestinian territory opposite Point 59 on the Green Line east of the town of Jabalya. (iii) At 20:20, the Israeli army fired 3 tank shells from its location inside the Green Line towards Palestinian territory opposite Point 54 on the Green Line southeast of the town of Beit Hanun. (iv) At 20:45, the Israeli army fired 3 tank shells from Points 54 and 58 on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory east of the towns of Beit Hanun and Jabalya. At 21:15, the Israeli army fired 2 more shells. (v) At 21:40, the Israeli army fired 1 tank shell from Point 58 on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory east of the town of Jabalya. At 22:15, the Israeli army fired 2 more shells. • Air Patrol: At 20:20, an Israeli army reconnaissance aircraft patrolled the skies over the district of Northern Gaza.

<p style="text-align: center;">CENTRAL GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack/Injuries: At 08:00, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from Point 96 on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory in Wadi Gaza southeast of Gaza city, killing 1 civilian. Moreover, 2 civilians sustained injuries, including 1 civilian in critical condition: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Mussbah al 'Aydi; and (ii) Wisam Daghmarsh. • Killing: The Israeli army killed 'Imad Abdul 'Aal in the area of Wadi Gaza.

<p style="text-align: center;">RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah Crossing is closed. • Palestinian Security Measure: At 05:30, Palestinian National Security forces arrested 5 Palestinian individuals while they were attempting to infiltrate into areas inside Egyptian territory.

WORK PERMITS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <u>West Bank:</u> Israeli authorities cancelled all previously-issued access permits for work inside the Green Line after a Palestinian individual carried out a suicide attack in the city of Al Khudeira (Hadera) inside the Green Line.• <u>Gaza Strip:</u><ul style="list-style-type: none">(i) Israeli authorities renewed 270 permits for workers to cross the Green Line. However, only 180 workers (approximately 67% of those possessing work permits) were allowed to access areas inside the Green Line.(ii) Israeli authorities issued 132 permits for Gaza Strip workers to stay overnight inside the Green Line.
