JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint. (i) Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On the morning of October 13th 2011, Israeli forces closed Shu’fat checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic, and fired teargas grenades towards demonstrators who marched in solidarity with Palestinian detainees, who have been on a hunger strike for the past 17 days. The checkpoint was later reopened. • Detention: On 14.11.2011, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Abu Assabin Al-Thuri. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma’ale Adumim because of Sabbath holiday.

<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • Flying Checkpoints: Between 09:40 and 12:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ur Al-Foqa, searching people and cars. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Silwad village. (ii) On 14.11.2011 in the morning, Israeli forces raided Kobar village, and raided the homes of Nael and Fakhri Bargouthi and they were handed orders to report to the Israeli intelligence (iii) In the morning on 14.11.2011, Israeli forces raided Ramallah and detained one resident. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Ahmad Salem Safwan during their raid into Ramallah. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of ‘Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement ‘Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages because of Jewish Sabbath Holiday.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i>, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying checkpoints: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Qedumim settlement, searching people and cars. (ii) At 08:00 & 17:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction, searching people and cars. (iii) At 20:05, Israeli set up a checkpoint at Jinaafuot village junction, searching people and cars. • Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:30, Israeli forces raided Habla town, and stormed Muhammed Mustafa, a released prisoner and handed orders to meet Israeli intelligence. (ii) At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Qalqilya, and stormed 3 homes belonging to Shadi Odeh, Akram Mansour and Ibrahim Dawoud, and handed orders to meet Israeli intelligence. • Detention: At 14:30, Israeli forces detained Younis Hanum from Al-Nabi Elias village. • Settlement Activities: At 08:30, Israeli forces levelled land in Azzoun Al-Atma village, to establish 150 meter deep buffer zone inside the village. • Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras ‘Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma’ale Shomron settlement because of Sabbath Holiday.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and 02:00 (ii) At 'Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00, and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. (ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli army continues restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 14:30 & 19:30 – 20:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Kafil Harres and Harres villages, searching civilians and vehicles, • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Harris village (ii) At 19:15, Israeli forces raided Kafil Harres, detained residents and released them at a later time. (ii) Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 <i>dunums</i> of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages. • Checkpoint: At 06:45, Israeli army continues to restrict access at the "Container" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Taqou's entrance, searching civilians and vehicles. (ii) Between 15:15 and 16:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Harmala village, searching civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 18:55, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint under the Al-Khader bridge, searching civilians and vehicles.

	<p>(iv) At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Al-Nashaah junction, searching civilians and vehicles.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raids: (i) On 13.11.2011, at 00:30, Israeli forces raided Jinata town, and handed a notice to Yassin Al-Arouj to meet Israeli intelligence (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces raided Nahalin village. • Demonstration: At 11:00, Palestinian and international peace activists demonstrated at Al-Walajeh village, protesting the confiscation of lands and the construction of the wall; Israeli forces fired rubber-coated steel bullets and teargas grenades at the protestors, briefly detained Nisreen Al-Araj and Mohamad Radwan and detained two protestors. Three residents were also injured: Nadiyah Awwad, Mahmmoud Abu Khalifa and Muath Odeh. • Detentions: Mazen Qumsyiah and Mustafa Al-Jouri were detained during the Al-Walajeh protest. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed northwest of Beit Jala town because of Sabbath holiday.
<p style="text-align: center;">Hebron</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village. (ii) Since 15. 10. 2011, Israeli forces closed two entrances lead to Beit Ummar town. • Flying Checkpoints: (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Younis (on the Hebron-Bethlehem road), searching civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint on road 35 north of Tafouh town, and confiscated the identity card of the Yousef Azreqat, a security officer, and ordered him to report to a nearby settlement. (iii) (iv) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Fawar refugee camp, searching civilians and vehicles. • Raids: (i) On 12.11.2011, at 24:00, Israeli forces raided Arroub refugee camp and detained 3 residents, including a child.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from its positions at the Green Line towards North Gaza and Israeli Naval vessels opened fire at Palestinian fishermen off the shores of Rafah. • Armed Palestinian groups broke the ceasefire by firing rockets towards the Green Line.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is opened, for humanitarian aid • Air Assaults: At dawn on 14.11.2011, Israeli warplanes fired missiles at a target in Beit Lahiah, killing one, and injuring 4 others, one critically, in addition to damages to nearby properties and homes. • Killing: Mohammed Al-Kilani was killed in the air strike on Beit Lahiah • Attack: On 13.11.2011 at evening, a rocket was fired towards the Green Line by a group of Palestinian militants. •

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.

<p style="text-align: center;">RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: • Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. • Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed • Sufa Crossing is closed. • Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially opened, allowing food, cooking gas, humanitarian assistance, 45 vehicles and building materials for projects belong to international NGO's . • Al Awda crossing – Rafah is open for patients, students and civilians with permits.
