Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in (ii) the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating (ii) the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint. (i) Checkpoints: Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border (i) **JERUSALEM** crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. On the morning of October 13th 2011, Israeli forces closed Shu'fat (ii) checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic, and fired teargas grenades towards demonstrators who marched in solidarity with Palestinian detainees, who have been on a hunger strike for the past 17 days. The checkpoint was later reopened. **Detention:** On 14.11.2011, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Abu Assabin Al-Thuri. Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu (i) (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shavvah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiva and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim because of Sabbath holiday.

- (ii) At 'Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00, and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint.
- (iii) At 17:20, Israeli forced increased restrictions at Huwara checkpoint, stopped a vehicle and temporarily detained 6 civilians and impeding the free flow of traffic.

- (i) At 10:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Qusin village junction, searching civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Wazan village junction, searching civilians and vehicles.
- (iii) At 11:40 12:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Nablus and Assira Al-Shamaliya, searching civilians and vehicles.
- (iv) Between 19:05 and 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Sarra village junction, searching civilians and vehicles.

- (ii) At 00:20, Israeli forces raided Kafer Qalil village.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.
- (ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- <u>Checkpoints</u>: Israeli army continues restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- **Flying Checkpoints:** At 14:30 & 19:30 20:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Kafil Harres and Harres villages, searching civilians and vehicles,
