# ALL DISTRITS

- At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 11 November 2012 at 18:00
- On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark.
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats of the shores of North Gaza.
- Israeli military Helicopters broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards North Gaza.
- Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching projectiles and opening fire towards the Green Line.

# NORTHERN GAZA

- Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for international access only.
- <u>Attack:</u> On the evening of November 13<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli naval vesseles launched missiles towards a plot of land in Beit Lahiya.
- Aerial Assault: On the evening of November 13<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli F-16 fighter Jets launched a missile towards agricultural land in Al –sudaniya area in Beit Lahiya.
- <u>Palestinian Attack:</u> On the evening of November 13<sup>th</sup> 2012, Palestinian gunmen launched 1 projectile towards the Green Line.

# Detainees Update

• Israeli military court sentenced Jihad Al-Thaher, a resident of Gaza to 33 years in prison.
