WEST BANK

JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
 - (iii) At 09:30, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba’ checkpoint along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and as a result impeded the free flow of traffic.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) On the morning of November 13th 2013, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Musa Al-Abbassi and Ahmad Al-Ghoul after storming their homes in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
 - (ii) At 13:50, Israeli forces detained Saleh Al-Suwiety in the old city of Hebron.
- **Attack**
 - (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned near Ras Al-Amoud School in Jerusalem fired stun grenades towards several residents.
 - (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near Anata junction fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Obstruction of Places of Worship:** On the morning of November 13th 2013, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem provoked several worshipers.
- **Settler Violence:** On November 12th 2013, Israeli settlers stormed the old city of Jerusalem and assaulted Adnan Basla, a resident of Al-Isawiya as he was passing near the “Barq” Wailing Wall after stoning him and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions.
- **Wall Gates:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in

	<p>Abu Dis town.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • Flying Checkpoint: At 12:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Silwad, impeded the free flow of traffic and as a result clashed with several residents as they temporarily detained Rami Hamad and released him at a later time. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Mazra'a Al-Gharbiya village, clashed with its residents and temporarily detained Mohammad Biyouid and released him at a later time. (ii) At 18:40, Israeli forces raided Silwad and stormed a gas station. (iii) At 01:20, Israeli forces detained Al-Bireh city, stormed and searched an internet café then withdrew at 03:20. • Attack: At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • Settler Violence: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:45, Israeli settlers stoned vehicles passing near "Bet El" settlement junction. (ii) At dawn on November 14th 2013, Israeli forces raided Sinjil, set fire to Khalid Khalil's home and as a result injured 3 of his family members who suffocated from smoke inhalation and then wrote racist graffiti inside his home. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • Checkpoint: At 18:35, Israeli forces closed "Movo Dotan" checkpoint located on the main road connecting Jenin and Tulkarem and impeded the free flow of traffic until reopening it at a later time. • Flying Checkpoint: At 23:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Wadi Al-Asal area located between Ya'bad and Barta'a checkpoint. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, Israeli force raided Bir Al-Basha, stormed and searched Sharif Ghawadeh's home, temporarily detained several of his family members and questioned them after his son Hussein (16 years old) allegedly attempted to stab an Israeli soldier in Al-Afoula city in Israel, served an order for the home to be demolished and again at 23:50, Israeli forces stormed the same home and detained 3 residents then withdrew at 05:00.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) At 18:35, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad, clashed with residents as they stormed 2 homes then withdrew at 20:00. (iii) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Jamalat village, fired stun grenades as they stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 01:00. (iv) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Yamoun, stormed a home and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Tawfiq Ghawardeh, Mu'tasim Ghawardeh and Arafat Ghawardeh in Bir Al-Basha village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Abdallah Yassin in Al-Jamalat village. (iii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Abu Habjat in Al-Yamoun. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces uprooted 100 Olive trees located along the main road connecting Jenin and Tulkarem in Ya'bad 20m long and 3 km wide and are owned by 70 residents in Ya'bad for alleged military purposes. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv: checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:10, Israeli forces raided Kafr Sur village until 18:45. (ii) At 19:40, Israeli forces raided Shufa village, stormed a coffee shop, temporarily detained several residents as they interrogated them then withdrew at 20:10. (iii) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Shuwikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem, set up a checkpoint, temporarily detained Aythar Nafayeh then released him at a later time. • <u>Detention:</u> On November 13th 2013, Israeli forces detained Suliman Atoni, a resident of Izbit Jarrad village. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Nazlat Issa village temporarily detained Mazen Aloush and Amir Aloush then released them at a later time. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 18:30, Israeli forces set up checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:45, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Qalqiliya opened fire towards several residents. (ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate located at the West entrance of Qalqiliya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several

	<p>children for alleged stoning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate closed the steel gate at 11:55 and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction was continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Checkpoint: At 17:10, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint until 11:35. • Flying Checkpoint: At 10:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 11:35. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:35, Israeli forces raided Tel village, stormed 2 homes then withdrew at 21:30. (ii) At 06:00, Israeli forces raided Nablus, stormed a home and detained a resident. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:35, Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint located along the main road connecting Nablus and Ramallah detained Khalid Adli, a resident of Beita. (ii) Israeli forces Khalid Halawah in Nablus. • Settler Violence: At 12:10, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land near the outskirts of Burin village during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several school children as they attempting to repel the settler attack then withdrew at 16:45.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: At 09:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Ballut.

JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 17:10, Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction until 16:45. (ii) At 20:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Fasayil village. • <u>Raid:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja.

(vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) At 14:00, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jinata village. (ii) At 20:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Shwarat village until 21:40. • <u>Raid:</u> At 13:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem, clashed with its residents, temporarily detained Ibrahim Abu Sarsour and released him at a later

(ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou’ village with cement blocks. (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to “Haji” settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic • <u>Flying checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Haji settlement in south Hebron. (ii) At 16:30 and again at 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge. ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Khan Yunis and Central Gaza and as a result injured a resident. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by raiding and opening fire towards Khan Yunis.
