## WEST BANK

## JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
  - (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
  - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
  - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
  - (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Raid:**
  - (i) At dawn on November 13<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces raided Hizma and detained two residents.
  - (ii) At dawn on November 13<sup>th</sup> 2014 and again at dawn on November 14<sup>th</sup> 2014 , Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya and detained 7 residents
- **Detention:**
  - (i) At dawn on November 13<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained three residents: Mohamamd Abu Sbitan, Ahmad Baker and Shadi Nassar in Al-Tur and Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhoods.
  - (ii) At dawn on November 13<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained three residents: Mohammad Al-Razim, Sharif Al-Rajabi and Ehab Sarhan in Siulwan neighbourhood.
  - (iii) At dawn on November 14<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained Issam Sadr in Al-Thuri neighbourhood.
  - (iv) Israeli forces detained two residents: Abdallah Al-Khtib and Ibrahim Al-Khatib in Hizma.
  - (v) Israeli forces detained seven residents: Hakim Idris, Mohammad Mustafa, Yahaya Mustafa, Majd Darwish, Musa Idris, Taner Obied and Nadim Obied.
- **Attack:**
  - (i) At 11:35, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Eisawiya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents including a child: Sameer Mahmoud(11 years old) and Khadr Obied (A school principle.).
  - (ii) At 16:25, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired
