Killing	3	—	3	A 22 year old resident was killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards him during confrontations in Budrus village in Ramallah, another 23 year old resident { University student } was killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards him near Hahloul bridge in Hebron and another 22 year old residents died of injuries sustained after Israeli forces opened fire towards him during confrontations near the entrance of Sa'ir in Hebron.

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On November 13th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks. (iv) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the 4 entrances of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood with cement blocks. (v) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the three entrances of Sur Bahar with Cement blocks. (vi) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za’im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks. (vii) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Wadi Al-Rabaybeh area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:35, Israeli forces raided the area located between Kafr Aqab and Qalandiya camp; stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 23:20. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they were demanding the release of corpses of residents killed by Israeli forces and for the removal of cement blocks placed in front of the neighbourhoods and camps of Jerusalem and protesting against raids on Al-Aqsa mosque

(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages (ii) . On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near “Bet El” settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) Since 18:40 on October 16th 2015, Israeli forces closed the road between Silwad and Deir Jreir village located near “Ofra” settlement and closed the road connecting Silwad and Ain Yabrod with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ur Al-Foqa then searched residents and vehicles until 23:35. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Silwad, demolished {using explosives} the home of Moath Salah Hammad during which they clashed with several residents and then withdrew at 06:00. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:15, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near “Bet El” settlement in North Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (who were protesting against the continued Israeli Military and Settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound)for alleged stoning and as a result injured 26 residents including 4 children: Suliman Nassar Hamdan (15 years old), Mohammad Musien Attiya (17 years old), Riyadh Abdel-Min’im Mattar (17 years old), Mohammad Yahya Al-Toukhi (16 years old), Wassir Rasem Hamdan, Abdel-Majid Hassan Badr, Qussay Saleh Al-Fara, Halimeh Damih Hassan, Basil Ibrahim Rayash, Abdel-Rahman Ahmad Hussien, Ahmad Mohammad Turki and Mansour Yasser Shawamra as well as leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Abboud fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of “Pesagout” Settlement in east Al-Bireh city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near the east entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several

	<p>residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Ahmad Husam Hamad.</p> <p>(v) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <p>(vi) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Budrous village fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and as a result killed a resident.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Killing:</u> Israeli forces opened fire towards and killed Lafi Yusef Awad (22 years old) in Budrous village. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:20, a demonstration took place in Bil'in protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation and also temporarily detained Mohammad Al-Khatib and 3 International Peace Activists then released them at a later time. (ii) At 12:30, a demonstration took place in Ni'lin protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (iii) At 12:40, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against land confiscation for the purpose of settlement construction and expansion during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Nazlat Zied village, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Hadi Abdel-Rahman Zied in Nazlat Zied village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Zieta temporarily detained the child Layth Muwafaq Masarwat (14 years old) as he was farming land near the wall gate then released him at 19:00.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds (iv) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel Gate • <u>Attack:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Azzun, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 residents (ii) At 15:15, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in West Qalqiliya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 13 residents including: Wissam Mahmoud Al-Bat and Saed Al-Qaman Nazal as well as leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 12:30, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces tried to disrupt the demonstration by firing live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators who attempted to reach they demonstration site and as a result left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) At 22:00 on October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta village with dirt mounds. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 13:00, Israeli forces closed Beit Furiq checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic then reopened it at 18:00. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Qussin village junction then searched vehicles and inspected resident’s identification cards. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:10, Israeli forces raided Nablus, occupied 3 homes owned by Ra’id Mansour, Abu Hikmat Al-Masri and Abdel-Fatah Al-Naqib then converted their rooftops into military posts and demolished 3 homes {detonating explosives} owned by the detained residents: Karam Al-Masri, Yahya Al-Haj Mohammad and Samitr Kusa {They are detained for allegedly killing a Israeli settler and his wife near Beit Furiq as mentioned in the reports of October 2015} during which Israeli forces clashed with several residents and as result injured 9 residents {1 of whom was ran over by an Israeli military vehicle}; Yazan Bakr Ighbar, Khaled Fawaz Al-Ba’sh, Issa Ashraf Othman, Yusef Hassan Abdel Qadder, Nour Masri Anayteh, Jihad Hikmat Istitah, Raed Mohammad Druzat {Injured after being run over}, Mu’tasim Ghalib Triyaki and Hamza Zahar Elweh as well as leaving several others suffocating from tear gas inhalation then withdrew at 05:45. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 14:40, Israeli forces positioned at Beit Furiq checkpoint temporarily detained two Palestinian Civil Defence force Officers: Mohammad Assad Badad {a resident of Jaba’ in Jenin} and Mohammad Nasser Barahma then released them at 16:00.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:40, Israeli forces positioned near “Yitmar” settlement located in south Beit Furiq fired live ammunition, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child: Mohammad Raed Rida Hanini (16 years old) leaving him hospitalised. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 16:00, a group of Israeli settlers positioned in the vicinity of Huwara checkpoint stoned several vehicles and residents as they were passing through the checkpoint.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 16:15, Israeli forces raided Kafr Al-Dik and stormed a home • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Harris village temporarily detained Ziedoun Tahsin Burziya then released him at a later time.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Ein Dwik village located in north Jericho then searched residents and vehicles until 17:00. (ii) At 07:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho then searched residents and vehicles until 08:00.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’mān village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu’mān: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near “Ifraṭ” settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to “Newe Daniyyel” settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za’tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.

- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
 - (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
 - (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
 - (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
 - (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
 - (ix) Since 10:45 on September 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amous" settlement with dirt mounds.

 - (i) At 13:40 and again at 20:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village located near the east entrance of Beit Sahour and detained a resident.
 - (ii) At 21:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ush Al-Ghurab area located in east Beit Sahour then searched residents and vehicles until 22:30.
 - **Raid:**
 - (i) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Aza camp located in Bethlehem, stormed a home and summoned Ra'fat Muslih Mohammad Al-Najjar to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
 - (ii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Husan village and summoned Ziyad Nimr Hamarat to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:35.
 - (iii) At 03:35, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar and summoned Mohammad Ali Thawabteh to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
 - **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Farhan Mohammad Mahmoud Salah (A resident of Ramallah) near Dar Salah village.
 - **Temporary Detention:** At 18:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Fajjar temporarily detained Mahmoud Nabil Ahmad Thawabteh (13 years old) then released him at a later time.

 - (i) At 12:40, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem, in Al-Ayda camp located in North Bethlehem and in Um Al-Rakaba in Al-Khader fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 5 residents including a child: Majdi Ramzi Al-Warani (16 years old), Mohammad Hassan Salah, Dina Ali Muslih, Ahmad Ismail Qaraqe' and Hiba Muh'sien Mohammad Abu Yabis as well as suffocating the infant leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation and also damaged the front windshield of a vehicle and damaged water tanks and a water heating solar panel on the rooftop of Khader Ali Salah's home in Um Al-Rakaba area.
 - (ii) At 13:10, Israeli forces positioned near the west entrance of Beit Fajjar fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
 - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) At 05:50 on November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading Farsh Al-Hawa area in Hebron with Cement blocks.
 - (vi) At 10:30 on November 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the junction located near "Hagi" settlement located in south Hebron with cement blocks.
 - (vii) At 21:00 on November 11th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Beit Awwa and Al-Majd village with cement block and dirt mounds.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 14:45, Israeli forces set up 9 checkpoints at the entrances of Sa'ir, Al-Samou', Al-Thahriya, Raboud, Abu Al-Arqan, Abu Al-Asja Al-Sara villages and at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp, prevented residents from entering or exiting through the checkpoints {for the alleged shooting of 2 Israeli settler vehicles near "Anatil" settlement which killed 2 settlers and injured another as alleged by the Israeli military}.
 - (ii) At 22:05, Israeli forces set up 4 checkpoints at the entrance of Beit Ummar, Al-Huwar area (located at the north entrance of Halhoul), at the entrance of Beit Anoun village and along Wadi Sa'ir road as they searched vehicles and inspected residents identification cards.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 14:45, Israeli forces raided Yatta, Al-Samou', Al-Thahriya, Al-Samiya village (located in North Al-Samou') {for the alleged shooting of 2 Israeli settler vehicles near "Anatil" settlement which killed 2 settlers and injured another as alleged by the Israeli military} and stormed and searched several homes, detained 3 residents in Al-Simiy a village located in north Al-Samou', temporarily detained 5 residents including a child: Ghalib Abu Aqil (17 years old), Nasser Ahed Abu Sundus, Hussien Taye' Al-Rashadat, Ghalib Abu Aqil and Mahmoud Abu Aqil {All resident of Al-Simniya village} then released them after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officers.
 - (ii) At dawn on November 14th 2015, Israeli forces raided Dura, stormed and searched the District Attorney's office and a court house after detonating the front entrances.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained three residents: Bakr Yacoub Abu Aqil, Akram Ahmad Sayed Ahmad and Ashraf Ismail Abu Al-Saba' in Al-Simiya village located in North Hebron.

(v) At 17:10, Israeli forces positioned in the south area of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Killings:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:50, Mahmoud Mohammad Issa Al-Shalaydeh (22 years old) {a resident of Sa’ir died of injuries sustained during confrontations with Israeli forces in Sa’r as mentioned in the previous report. (ii) Israeli force positioned in the vicinity of Halhoul bridge, Ras Al-Jura area located in North Hebron killed Hassan Jihad Al-Bo {23 years old}(A resident of Halhoul). • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 13:30, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near “Kafar Itsiyon” settlement assaulted several residents as they were collecting Olive harvest and as a result injured Jaber Abdel-Hamid Al-Wahadin and Hamad Abdel-Hamid Al-Wahadin.
