| JERUSALEM | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On November 14th 2014 The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 35 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Detention:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned in Jerusalem detained Jibril Shanat (A resident of Abu Dis) for allegedly possessing a knife and entering the city with out a valid permit. • <u>Injury:</u> At 02:00, Ahmad Sajadiya was hospitalised after a tear gas grenade canister fired by Israeli forces exploded leaving hm hospitalised. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured two residents including a child: Firas Shahin (14 years old) and Tahadi Al-Tukhali as well as suffocating Wurud Nassar with tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned at the Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Ibrahim Al-Karaki. (iii) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at Hizma junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (v) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned the entrance of Anata fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 12:20, a demonstration took place in Bil'in protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result injured Haytham Al-Khatib (A journalist) after being struck by a tear gas grenade canister and left several others suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. |

(iii) At 16:10, Israeli forces positioned at “Alon Muriya”fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 06:30, Israeli forces positioned at Huwara checkpoint temporarily detained Samer Al-Qawieq then released him after confiscating his personal Identification card and his driver’s licence. |
