JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On November 14th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound, which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks. (iv) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the four entrances of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood with cement blocks. (v) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the three entrances of Sur Bahar with Cement blocks. (vi) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za’im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 16:45, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba’ checkpoint located along the main road connected Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho districts. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:20, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, temporarily seized a bulldozers as it was working on removing dirt from the vicinity of Al-Quds University campus. (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces raided Jaba’ village. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned in Wadi Al-Joz neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Eisawiya village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Ishaq Abu Samara (A resident of Shu'fat camp in Jerusalem). (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces detained Yunis Maraghat in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood in Jerusalem. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 14:20, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Al-Tur neighbourhood and abducted the child Yazen Mahmoud Al-Hadrat (15 years old) as he was near the Al-Tur junction then took him to Al-Harjiya area in Deir Yassin village then proceeded to assault him before he was able to flee from the settlers and was then hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages (ii) . On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) Since 18:40 on October 16th 2015, Israeli forces closed the road between Silwad and Deir Jreir village located near "Ofra" settlement and closed the road connecting Silwad and Ain Yabrod with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ni'lin then searched residents and vehicles until 16:45. (ii) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Turmus'aya then searched residents and vehicles until 16:45. (iii) At 20:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Um Safaa village then searched residents and vehicles. (iv) At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Abu Mash'al village then searched residents and vehicles until 21:45. (v) At 22:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village and impeded the free flow of traffic after closing the steel gate entrance. (vi) At 22:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Burqa village and detained two residents for allegedly carrying knives. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, stormed several homes and summoned two residents: Khaled Fathi Matariya and Samir Jamil Mohammad Matariya to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 06:50. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:25, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near "Bet El" settlement in North Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (who were protesting against the continued Israeli Military and Settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound) for alleged stoning then detained a resident and temporarily detained the child Ahmad Mahmoud Abed (17 years old) then released him at 15:45. (ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Budrous village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (as they were participating in the funeral processions of Lafi Awad) for alleged stoning and as a result injured six residents.

	<p>(iii) At 15:10, Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout” Settlement in east Al-Bireh city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near “Bet El” settlement in North Al-Bireh city detained Baha Abdallah Mahmoud Abed (A resident of Al-Bireh city). (ii) Israeli forces detained Muthna Adel Mahmoud Mu’tan and Mauth Ali Mahmoud Mu’tan near the entrance of Burqa village.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 09:05, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jalmah crossing point temporarily detained Ahmad Al-Ali Abu Ali then released him at 10:00. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 14:45, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Khodari college located Tulkarem temporarily detained the College Vice President and several Collage employees then released them at 15:30.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) <u>Closure of Roads:</u> (ii) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (iii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iv) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds (v) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with a steel Gate • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of the Village Azoun Atma, and searched vehicles and civilians. (vi) <u>Attack:</u> At 15:15, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in West Qalqiliya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 10 residents including Qusay Mohammad Arrjan (13 years old), Adli Mohammad Thalja and Mu’en Mahmoud Qubtan and detained Mu’en Mahmoud Qubtan. (vii) <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mu’en Mahmoud Qubtan after injuring him during confrontations near the wall gate in West Qalqiliya. (viii) <u>Wall Gates:</u> (ix) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (x) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the

<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) At 22:00 on October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta village with dirt mounds. • Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:20, Israeli forces closed Beit Furiq checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic. (iii) At 20:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Burin village and prevented residents and vehicle from exiting the village through the checkpoint in order to allow an Israeli settler demonstration in the area. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:55, Israeli forces raided Wadi Azmout area. (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Furiq , stormed a home and summoned Suhayeb Badi’ Sadeq Khatatbeh to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 01:30. (iii) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Beit Dajjan village. • Attack: At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned near “Yitmar” settlement located in south Beit Furiq fired live ammunition; fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and also occupied the home of Jallal Nassasrat and converted its rooftop into a military post then withdrew at 17:20. • Settler Violence: At 16:00, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near “Yitsahar” settlement junction stoned several vehicles and residents as they were passing near the checkpoint.

(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.

BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

(ii) At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village located at the east entrance of Beit Sahour then searched vehicles and inspected resident’s identification cards until 19:35. (iii) At 19:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Um Salmuna village then searched vehicles and inspected resident’s identification cards until 20:15. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on November 14th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Obidiya and summoned Ismail Mohammad Al-Assa to report to Israeli Intellegnce for questioning and again at 01:25 in November 15th 2015 raided the area until 05:50. (ii) At dawn on November 14th 2015, Israeli forces raided Taqou’, summoned Riyadh Ahmad Khalaf Jibril to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. (iii) At 18:30, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, clashed with several residents as they chased a civilian vehicle {for allegedly attempting to run over an Israeli settler along road (60) as alleged by the Israeli Military} then withdrew later. (iv) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Khader until 23:45. • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:45, Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem, fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured six residents and left 18 others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**

(i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.

(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.

(iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.

(iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.

(v) At 05:50 on November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading Farsh Al-Hawa area in Hebron with Cement blocks.

(vi) At 10:30 on November 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the junction located near "Hagi" settlement located in south Hebron with cement blocks.

(vii) At 21:00 on November 11th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Beit Awwa and Al-Majd village with cement block and dirt mounds.

(viii) At 11:55, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Samou' village and prevented residents from entering or exiting the village.

- **Flying Checkpoint:**

(i) At 11:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Sarah village junction located in south Dura then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards.

(ii) At 11:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Al-Thahriya and Al-Ramadin village then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards.

(iii) At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar camp junction, temporarily detained two residents: Osama Khaled Mahmoud Khalaf (A resident of Dura) and Wissam Nabil Issa (A resident of Al-Fuwar camp) then released them at 22:30.

- **Raid:**

(i) At 15:15 on November 13th 2015, Israeli forces raided Yatta and detained two residents including a University student.

(ii) At 12:15, Israeli forces raided Khursa village and confiscated surveillance camera footage from a home.

(iii) At 12:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Huwar area located in North Halhoul and confiscated surveillance camera footage in several merchant shops.

(iv) At 15:30, Israeli forces raided Deir Sammit village and confiscated surveillance camera footage from "Al-Sa'adeh" reception hall in the village.

(v) At 20:50, Israeli forces raided Hebron, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched a home and detained 2 residents then confiscated a vehicle and summoned Majdi Ahmad Mohammad Hussien Mutawa' to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning and again at 00:35, Israeli forces raided Hebron and detained 2 other residents {total detained 4} then withdrew at 06:05.
