| JERUSALEM | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On November 16th 2013 Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 16:45, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Kabsa area located between Abu Dis and Al-Eizariya fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 residents: the child Abed Abu Al-Rum (17 years old), Mustafa Far’oun and Mohammad Al-Khatib. • <u>Settlement Activity:</u> On November 15th 2013, Israeli authorities approved plans (A/11092) for the construction of a park on approximately 740 acres (dunumes) of land in Al-Tur neighbourhood and Al-Isawiya in east Jerusalem on land occupied in 1967. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al- |

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • Flying Checkpoint: At 22:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Taybeh junction. • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned at Yabrud village bridge checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents including a child: Majd Hamad (17 years old) and Abdallah Hamad and also detained 2 children and temporarily detained Mohammad Hamad (12 years old) then withdrew at 19:20. (ii) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazun camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • Detention: Israeli forces detained 2 children: Majd Hamad (17 years old) and Abdallah Hamad (17 years old) in Yabrud village. • Demonstration: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:40, a demonstration took place in Bil'in village protesting against the construction of the wall, clashed with demonstrators as a result injured 3 residents including a child: Ismail Abu Rahmeh (17 years old), Mohammad Al-Barghouthi and Mohammad Hammad as well as leaving several demonstrators including International Peace Activists suffocated from tear gas inhalation (ii) At 12:40, a demonstration took place in Nil'in village protesting against the construction of the wall, clashed with demonstrators and left several demonstrators suffocated from tear gas inhalation (iii) At 16:00, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against land confiscation for the purpose of settlement construction, demonstrators clashed with Israeli forces and left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages. |

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoint: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv: checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: At 20:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Lid junction. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall. |

(ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Izbit Al-Tabib village , stormed a home, temporarily detained Thaer Al-Tabib then released him after questioning • Attack: At 18:25, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in south Qalqiliya fired stun grenades towards several residents. • Settler Violence: At 16:20, Israeli settlers stoned several residents and vehicles passing along Kafr Laqif village junction and as a result damaged a vehicle owned by Jamal Odeh. • Demonstration: At 13:10, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance, clashed with Israeli forces as they attempted to disrupt demonstrators and as a result injured 2 residents: Jum'a and Nayef Ishtawi after tear gas grenade canisters struck them leaving them hospitalised with contusions also left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate closed the steel gate at 11:55 and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction was continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of |

(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Ballut. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement. |

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) At 14:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Mohammad Abu Daoud leaving him hospitalised with contusions and assaulted 6 residents: Ibrahim Abu Daoud Mohammad Abu Daoud , Ni’meh Abu Daoud, Ibrahim Abu Daoud , Fadi Abu Daoud and Ahmad Abu Daoud after storming their home and converting it into a military post and as a result left them hospitalised with contusions. (iii) At 16:15, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Tabaqa village junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Diya’ Baroush (17 years old) leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 14:25, Israeli settlers stormed Far’ah area in Ithna and chased away several Sheppard’s as they were herding their sheep. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town. |
