<b>JERUSALEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On November 15<sup>th</sup> 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound, which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> <li>(iii) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks.</li> <li>(iv) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za’im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.</li> <li>(ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</li> <li>(iii) At 13:35, Israeli forces closed Jaba’ checkpoint located along the main road connected Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho districts and impeded the free flow of traffic until reopening it at 02:00.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 20:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Jadirah village then searched vehicles and inspected resident’s identification cards.</li> <li>(ii) At 23:10, Israeli forces raided Bir Nabala village then searched vehicles and inspected resident’s identification cards until 02:00.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 13:55, Israeli forces raided Hizma village and clashed with several residents.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<p>(ii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp, demolished an Apartment {using explosive detonation} owned by the family of a Palestinian detainee Mohammad Abu Shahin {who is detained for allegedly opening fire towards and killing a Israeli settler and injuring another near Deir Ibzi'}, clashed with several residents as they attempted to prevent the demolition and as a result killed 2 residents and injured 4 others including 1 critically injured, detained a child from inside an Ambulance as he was receiving treatment for injuries and also damaged house furniture and other surrounding apartment in the building from the detonation then withdrew at 05:10.</p> <p>(iii) At 04:30, Israeli force raided Bir Nabala then stormed and searched a home.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Killing:</u></b> Israeli forces killed two residents: Ahmad Subhi Abu Ayash (27 years old) and Layth Asharf Manasrah (22 years old) in Qalandiya camp.</li> <li>• <b><u>Temporary Detention:</u></b> On the evening of November 15<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces temporarily detained two children: Tawfiq Ihab Najeeb (13 years old) and Mohammad Taha (13 years old) on Al-Wad road located in the old city of Jerusalem then released them later.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned at the wall gate in Qutna village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Jabal area junction located in Abu Dis fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On November 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood detained Ibrahim Abu Al-Hawa .</li> <li>(ii) Israeli forces detained Yusef Abu Latifa (17 years old) in Qalandiya camp.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u></b> At 08:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 13:35, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Hizma checkpoint located at the North east entrance of Jerusalem and chanted anti Arab and racist slurs.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

On October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks.</li> <li>(iii) Since 18:40 on October 16<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the road between Silwad and Deir Jreir village located near "Ofra" settlement and closed the road connecting Silwad and Ain Yabrod with dirt mounds.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Yabroud Village Bridge then searched residents and vehicles until 11:35.</li> <li>(ii) At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Silwad then searched residents and vehicles until 11:45.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(iii) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Beit Ur Al-Foqa and Beit Ur Al-Tahta villages then searched residents and vehicles until 12:00.</li> <li>(iv) At 10:30 and again at 18:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atarah bridge located in North Bir Ziet then searched residents and vehicles until 20:30.</li> <li>(v) At 17:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Janiya village then searched residents and vehicles and detained a child.</li> <li>(vi) At 19:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Eiyoun Al-Haramiya area located along the main road connecting Ramallah and Nablus then searched residents and vehicles until 19:45.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 12:25, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near “Bet El” settlement in North Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (who were protesting against the continued Israeli Military and Settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound) for alleged stoning and as a result injured 6 residents.</li> <li>(ii) At 13:50, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Deir Nathim village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and temporarily detained 2 residents including a child: Thiyab Saleh Al-Sufi (17 years old) and Qusay Thiyab Al-Tamimi then released them at 14:15.</li> <li>(iii) At 16:50, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(iv) At 19:50, Israeli forces positioned near the east entrance of Sinjil fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Injury:</u></b> At 15:30, the child Adel Khader Shahin (2 years old) {a resident of Bir Nabala in Jerusalem} was injured after being ran over by an Israeli military Jeep near Surda village and as a result left him hospitalised.</li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Janiya village detained Muhanad Sami Badoun (17 years old) {A resident of Al-Janiya village}.</li> </ul>
<b>JENIN</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Road:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan.</li> <li>(ii) Since the evening of November 25<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 03:20, Israeli forces raided Jenin, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched a home after damaging the main entrance, then raided the Industrial zone and detained two residents after assaulting one resident and then withdrew at 06:15.</li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> Israeli forces detained Alaa Hassan Shahi {after assaulting him} and Anas Anoum in Jenin.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.</li> </ul>

QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.</li> <li>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</li> <li>(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds</li> <li>(iv) Since 10:40 on September 1<sup>st</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel Gate</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 15:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun then searched residents and vehicles.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> At 15:15, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in West Qalqiliya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 8 residents including Jafar Ishtayeh {A journalist} and left 14 other suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> Since December 17<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.</li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.</li> <li>(iii) At 22:00 on October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta village with dirt mounds.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> At 19:20, Israeli forces closed Beit Furiq checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic until 20:00.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 11:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Aqraba then searched residents and vehicles.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 13:20, Israeli forces raided Huwara, stormed several merchant shops and confiscated surveillance camera footage.</li> <li>(ii) At 03:15, Israeli forces raided Askar camp in Nablus, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 05:30.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 15:45, Israeli forces positioned at Huwara checkpoint detained Abdel-Rahman Saleh Abdel-Raheem Aliyan (A resident of Askar camp).</li> <li>(ii) At 21:20, Israeli forces positioned at Beit Furiq checkpoint detained Ahmad Hussein Hanini (A resident of Beit Furiq).</li> <li>(iii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Saber Ali Al-Laham and Mohammad Ahmad Nabhan in Al-Askar camp in Nablus.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Physical Assault:</u></b> At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned near Odallah village junction assaulted Oday Nathim Mahmoud Muharib (A resident of Huwara) and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions.</li> </ul>
<b>SALFIT</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.</li> <li>(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.</li> <li>(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Salfit, searched residents and vehicles until 21:00.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Qarwat Bani Hassan , stormed and searched several homes then withdrew at 02:35.</li> </ul>
<b>JERICHO</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District.</li> </ul>
<b>BETHLEHEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.</li> <li>(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.</li> <li>(iii) Since August 2<sup>nd</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.</li> <li>(iv) Since May 8<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

**HEBRON**

- **Closure:**

(i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.

(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.

(iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.

(iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.

(v) At 05:50 on November 5<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading Farsh Al-Hawa area in Hebron with Cement blocks.

(vi) At 10:30 on November 8<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the junction located near "Hagi" settlement located in south Hebron with cement blocks.

(vii) At 21:00 on November 11<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Beit Awwa and Al-Majd village with cement block and dirt mounds.

(viii) At 15:45 on November 15<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Samiya village junction located at the west entrance of Al-Samou' with cement blocks.

(ix) On November 15<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances of Khliat Al-Miya and Al Dirat and the two bypass roads leading east Yatta with cement blocks.

- **Flying Checkpoint:**

(i) At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Awwa and impeded the free flow of traffic.

(ii) At 13:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Hagi" settlement junction located in south Hebron and impeded the free flow of traffic after closing then main entrance gate and reopened it at 13:35.

(iii) At 15:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Einoun village junction then searched vehicles and residents.

- **Raid:**

(i) At 18:50 and again at 01:45, Israeli forces raided Hebron, set up a checkpoint, stormed and searched several homes, detained 4 residents then withdrew at 07:00.

(ii) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Bani Na'im until 04:00.

(iii) At dawn on November 16<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Ulla, stormed a Local Charity after breaking open the main entrance and confiscated a computer and several files.

(iv) At dawn on November 16<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Sa'ir, stormed the family home of Raed Jarradat {who was killed by Israeli forces inside Al-Ahli hospital}, damaged the front entrance and searched the home.
