EVENTS

 On November 16th 2012, demonstrations took place in all the districts of the West Bank against Israeli military aggression towards the Gaza Strip and against the construction of the Wall.

WEST BANK

• Closure:

- (i) On November 16th 2012, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City for Friday prayers.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint.

JERUSALEM

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **<u>Demonstration</u>**: At <u>14:30</u>, a demonstration took place after Friday prayer in Al-Aqsa mosque in the old city of Jerusalem against Israel's military assault on the Gaza strip, clashed with Israeli forces who detained 2 residents.

- (ii) At 13:35, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Taqou' fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents
- Detention: Israeli forces detained Layth Nassrallah in the vicinity of Billal Bin Rabah mosque in north Bethlehem.
- **Settler Violence:** At 18:20, Israeli settlers stoned vehicles near "Taqu'a" settlement junction.
- **Demonstration:** At 12:20, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma'asra protesting the construction of the wall and demonstrators clashed with Israeli forces who prevented them from reaching the demonstration site.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in North West of Beit Jala town.

Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the (ii) Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

Closure of Main Roads:

- The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-(i) Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as (iii) detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to (iv) the entrance to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- On July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat (v) and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

Raid:

- (ii) At 00:30. Israeli forces raided Hebron.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRITS

- At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 11 November 2012 at 18:00.
- On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark.
- Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by conducting military operation under the code name Pillar of Defence" by firing tank artillery shells from their positions behind the Green Line, launching missiles from Naval vessels, Israeli fighter jet launching 200 missiles towards all districts in Gaza which killed 13 residents killed including 1 child, 1 female resident, an elderly resident and 9 Palestinian gunmen and injured 216 residents including 118 children and 39 female residents.
- Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching 306 projectiles and opening fire towards the Green Line.

• <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed.

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli Naval vessels launched several missiles towards Beit Lahiya.
- (ii) At 16:40, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line launched tank artillery shells towards Al-Sheikh Zayid in Beit Lahiya and injured 2 Palestinian gunmen.
- <u>Aerial Assault:</u> On November 16th 2012, Israeli fighter jets launched several missiles towards residential homes and Palestinian gunmen positions in Beit Hanun and Beit Lahiya including:
 - (i) At 09:50, Israeli fighter jets launched a missile towards Jabaliya and injured 2 children.
 - (ii) At 10:00, Israeli fighter jets launched 2 missiles towards Palestinian gunmen in Jabaliya, killing 2 gunmen and injured 9 residents.
 - (iii) At 12:30, Israeli fighter Jets launched a missile towards Palestinian gunmen in Beit Lahiya and injured 4 residents.
 - (iv) At 14:05, Israeli fighter Jets launched a missile towards homes in Beit Lahiya, killing a resident and critically injuring Mohammad Suleiman (child)
 - (v) At 17:50, Israeli fighter jets launched a missile towards Palestinian gunmen in Beit Lahiya.
 - (vi) At 04:05, Israeli fighter jets launched a missile towards a plot of land near Abu Obeida secondary school in Beit Lahiya.
