WEST BANK

JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) At 07:30 The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city for the alleged stabbing of an Israeli settler.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikse villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikse village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
 - (iii) At 09:40, the Israeli military intensified their restrictions at Jaba’ checkpoint located on the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Eizariya.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At dawn on November 16th 2014, Israeli forces detained the child Ibrahim Abu Al-Hawa (17 years old) after storming his home in Al-Tur neighbourhood.
 - (ii) At dawn on November 16th 2014, Israeli forces detained the child Mohammad Al-Rajabi (13 years old) in Silwan neighbourhood.
 - (iii) On November 16th 2014, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Sunah neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem detained Ahmad Mu’nis and Majdi Abu Ghazaleh.
- **Temporary Detention:** At 08:00, Israeli forces temporarily detained two residents including a child: Muhanad Zawahrah (17 years old) and Adham Zawahrah (residents of Bethlehem) in Jerusalem for allegedly entering the city without a permit then released them at 18:30.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Shu’fat camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Mayar Al-Natsheh (10 years old).
 - (ii) At 02:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired

	<p>rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning (who were protesting the murder of Yusef Al-Rimawi who was strangled to death by Israeli settlers in Jerusalem).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> On the morning of November 16th 2014, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) At 23:10, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Labban Al-Gharbiya with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 1400, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village until 16:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00 on November 16th 2014, Israeli forces raided Kafr Malik village and stormed several homes. (ii) At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Deir Jerier village until 04:40. (iii) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Deir Abu Mash’al until 02:00. (iv) At dawn on November 17th 2014, Israeli forces raided Bil’in village, clashed with several residents as they surrounded the home of the head of the village council and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 20:35, Israeli forces raided Zabada village and stormed a home.
<p>TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Bal’a village junction. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:20 and again at 03:25, Israeli forces raided Anabta, clashed with several residents, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:35. (ii) At 03:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Shwakiya neighbourhood, detained three residents then withdrew at 05:40. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Sharaaqa in Anabta

	(ii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Hamza Fayeaz, Ahmad Ikbariya and Moath Jamal in Al-Shweikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrances of Azzun and Izbit Al-Tabib and impeded the free flow of traffic for alleged fire-bombing of a military post near the entrance of Azzun. (ii) At 17:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Jayyus and Azzun until 18:15. • <u>Raid:</u> At 22:50, Israeli forces raided Azzun, stormed four homes, summoned Ahmad Salamah to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 24:00. • <u>Attack:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Azzun fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> On November 16th 2014, Israeli forces stormed Hajja village, served demolition orders for five homes owned by Yusef Hillal, Samir Hillal, Ahmad Hillal, Ibrahim Hillal, Billal Masalha and Nathim Masaalha for allegedly being built without a licence because of its location in area C which is under Israeli Military and administrative control. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 17:30 and again at 07:15, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Burin and Madma villages. (ii) At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 21:30.

(ii) At 17:45, Israeli forces raided Kafr Kalil village and stormed a home. (iii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Nablus, detained a resident then withdrew at 05:20. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Alaa Al-Qudsi in Nablus.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 18:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Deir Istiya with dirt mounds. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 17:40, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:10, Israeli forces raided Salfit, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 02:00. • <u>Detention:</u> At 00:55, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint detained Nassar Arafat (A resident of Balata camp in Nablus).
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction until 08:50. (ii) At 17:55 and again at 23:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 00:20. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Jericho and Ein Al-Sultan camp, stormed a home then withdrew at 05:00.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with

<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiw Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna located near the wall gate. (vii) At 13:40 on September 16th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces set up three checkpoints in Huwara area, the entrance of Al-Fawar camp and Al-Fah's area in south Hebron.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards North Gaza and Khan Yunis and as a result injured three residents.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • <u>Attack:</u> At 15:00 on November 14th 2014, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green line opened fire towards east Jabaliya and as a result injured two residents: Billal Al-Natur and Riyad Hamad.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
KHAN YUNIS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> On the evening of November 16th 2014, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green line opened fire towards an unidentified resident near the border fence in Al-Qarara.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance. • <u>Detention:</u> On November 16th 2014, Israeli forces positioned near Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing detained three unidentified residents as they attempted to climb the border fence into Israel.
