	On November 17 th 2012, demonstrations took place in all the districts of the West Bank against Israeli military aggression towards the Gaza Strip and against the construction of the Wall.

WEST BANK

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City for Friday prayers.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Anata junction.
- <u>Raid:</u> At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Annan village, stormed a home and destroyed the main gate entrance using explosives then detained a resident.
- Detention:

JERUSALEM.

- (i) On November 16th 2012, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Darwish in Al-Isawiya village.
- (ii) On November 17th 2012, Israeli forces detained Ali Salameh and Omar Salameh in Jerusalem.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Hameed in Beit Anaan village.

Attack:

- (i) At 15:50, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint clashed with demonstrators protesting Israeli assault on Gaza and opened fire towards then for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Ram fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators, protesting Israel's assault on Gaza, for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 19:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Shu'fat camp fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators, protesting Israelis assault on Gaza, for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned in Wadi Al-Joz neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired tear gas grenades towards demonstrators, protesting against Israel's assault on Gaza, for alleged stoning.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sleavawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction was halted in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim for Sabbath holiday.
- <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 19:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Atara bridge and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village until 21:30.

• Raid:

- (i) At 15:30, Israeli forces raided Beituniya and stormed a home.
- (ii) At 20:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city.
- (iii) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Sira and set up a checkpoint at its entrance.

• Attack

- (i) At 13:20, Israeli forces positioned near Ofar prison in Beituniya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents participating in demonstrations gains Israel's assault on Gaza and injured 9 residents, Mohammad Hilmi, Yaha Jamal, Mohammad Qabha, Fadi Badawi, Isra Ibrahim, Moath Sbieh, Khalid Al-Sabar, Mohammad Atalla and Islam Fartij.
- (ii) At 16:00, Israeli positioned at Turmus'ayya junction fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators protesting against Israeli's assault on Gaza.
- (iii) At 16:40, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Nabi Saleh village entrance, opened fire towards residents and injured Rashid Al-Tamimi, a Palestinian Police officer, with a bullet wound in his leg.

TULKAREM	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. Checkpoints: The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. - <u>Attack:</u> At 12:30 and again at 18:45, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Billal Bin Rabah mosque in north Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several demonstrators protesting Israel's aggression towards Gaza, injured Jamil Jawarish (15 years) and Salah Harbi suffocating from tear gas inhalation.
- **<u>Killing:</u>** At 20:00, Omar Hamid, a resident of Taqou' died of injuries sustained after being assaulted and beaten by Israeli forces as they detained him from his home 8 years ago which left him c hospitalised with severe brain damage.

• Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Abu Ghaliya in Beit Jalla.
- (ii)Israeli forces detained Shadi Abu Afiya at Al-Nashash junction.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 08:05, Israeli settlers stoned vehicles near the main road connecting Bethlehem and Hebron.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction was halted in North West of Beit Jala town for Sabbath holiday.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) On July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

HEBRON

• Raid: At 18:45, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, clashed with residents, injured a resident who was struck by a tear gas grenade to his stomach and left several other suffocating from tear gas inhalation.

• Attack:

- (i) At 10:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards participants in a demonstration against Israel military aggression on Gaza, for alleged stoning and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 10:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Zahad area fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 11:10, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub entrance fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 18:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Shalash road in the old city of

- Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning, injured Hamza Jabarin (15 years) and assaulted Issa Al-Imrin leaving him hospitalised with contusion.
- (v) At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned near Farsh Al-Hawa area in Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (vi) At 20:55, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Urub camp area fired towards several children for alleged stoning, injuring Mahmoud Abu Sil (17 years) and detained a resident.
- (vii)At 21:50, Israeli forces positioned near Kharsa villagejunction fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and injured Izz Al-Din Jaribat, Layth AlAtrash and Mu'taz O'twan.

• Detention:

- (i) At 21:50, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abu Sinineh, a Palestinian Police officer in the old city of Hebron.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Wassim Khalaf (13 years old) in Al-Fuwar camp.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Samid Jawabra near Al-Urub camp.
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town for Sabbath holiday.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRITS

- At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 11 November 2012 at 18:00.
- On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark.
- Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by conducting military operation under the code name Pillar of Defence" by firing tank artillery shells from their positions behind the Green Line, launching missiles from Naval vessels, Israeli fighter jet launching 250 missiles towards all districts in Gaza which killed 19 residents killed including 1 infant, 2 resident and 15 Palestinian gunmen and injured 80 residents including several women and children.
- Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching 259 projectiles and opening fire towards the Green Line.

Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed.

(i)

- (i) On November 17th 2012, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line launched several tank artillery shells towards Beit Hanun and Beit Lahiya.
- (ii) At 02:30, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line launched tank artillery shells towards homes in Tel Al-Za'tar in Jabaliya killing 2 children including an infant and injured 2 residents.

• <u>Aerial Assault:</u> On November 17th 2012, Israeli fighter jets launched several missiles towards residential homes and Palestinian gunmen positions in Beit Hanun, Beit Lahiya and Jabaliya including:

- (i) At 09:15, Israeli fighter jets launched 2 missiles towards Beit Hanun and Jabaliya and damaged 2 homes.
- (ii) At 13:00, Israeli fighter jets launched 2 missiles towards homes in Jabaliya and injured a child (8 years old) and a female resident (45 years old).
