WEST BANK

Closure:

- (i) At 07:40, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city (after an incident which left 4 Israeli settlers killed injured 4 others during which Israeli forces opened fire towards and killed 2 residents for the alleged attack).
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- (iii) At 17:00, Israeli forces closed Jaba' checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jerusalem , Ramallah and Jericho thus preventing residents from entering or exiting the checkpoint and reopened it at a later time
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Ram and closed it with cement blocks for alleged shooting incidents towards Israeli forces.

• Raid:

- (i) At 03:00 on November 17th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya and detained a resident.
- (ii) On the morning of November 17th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home and detained a resident.

Killing:

(i) At 03:00 on November 17th 2014, Yusef Al-Rumani (A resident of Al-Tur

- neighbourhood) was killed by Israeli settlers as he was on duty working as a bus driver for "Egged" Bus Company during which the Israeli settler beat him and then strangled him to death and left him hanged by a rope inside the bus.
- (ii) At 07:10, 2 residents: Ghassan Abu Jamal and Oday Abu Jamal (residents of Jabal Al-Mukabir) were killed by Israeli forces after they allegedly entered a Jewish synagogue in Jerusalem and killed 4 Israeli settlers and in injured 8 others.

• Detention:

- (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces detained Mahdi Burqan in Al-Thuri neighbourhood.
- (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces detained four residents including 2 women: Hiba Al-Taweel, Raed Abu Wahdan , Ekram Al-Sjarfa and Taha Al-Shalidi in the old city of Jerusalem.
- (iii)On the morning of November 17th 2014, Israeli forces detained three residents: Amar Zidani, Mohammad Zidani and Mohamamd Abu Sneieneh in Jerusalem.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained Oday Obied in Al-Eisawiya village.
- (v) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Al-Ja'bari in Al-Ram.

• Attack:

- (i) On the morning of November 17th 2014, Israeli forces positioned in Abu Dis and Al-Eizariya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) On November 17th 2014, Israeli forces positioned Ein Al-Louz area in Silwan fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) On November 17th 2014, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) On 18:05, Israeli forces positioned at the north junction of Al-Ram fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Home Demolition:** On November 17th 2014, Israeli forces stormed Al-Eisawiya village and served a demolition order for a home owned by Alaa Dari ffor allegedly being built without a licence.
- Assault on Places of Worship: At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshipers.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> On the morning of November 17th 2014, a group of Israeli settlers assaulted Tarik Dweik (A resident of the old city of Jerusalem) as he was on his way to Haddassah hospital.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.

Flying Checkpoint: (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atarah Bridge until 10:30. (ii) At 20:25, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Burqa village until 21:30. (iii) At 23:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Nathim village until 00:30. Raid: (i) At 15:35, Israeli forces raided Deir Nathim village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 16:15. (ii) At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Bir Ziet, Ein Sinya, Abu Oash and Surda villages. (iii) At 03:45, Israeli forces raided Silwad, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:30. (iv) At dawn on November 18th 2014, Israeli forces raided Bi'in and detained three residents. **Detention:** (i) At 23:30, Israeli forces detained three residents: Rami Khalaf, Mohamamad Khalaf and Jihad Khalaf (All residents of Rantis village) as they were working near "Ofrirm" settlement. (ii) Israeli forces detained Nash'at Hamad in Silwad. (iii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Majdi Burnat, Mohammad Yassin and Samih Al-Khatib in Bil'in village. Settler Violence: At 23:45, Israeli settlers near "Halamish" settlement stoned residents and vehicles passing along the main road. **Closure of Main Road:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. **JENIN** (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. Raid: At 20:10, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad until 20:30. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near "Aveni Hivits". (iv) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Nabi Eliyas village and the agricultural road located between Qalqiliya and Nablus with cement blocks. **TULKAREM Checkpoint:** At 14:45, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint and imped the free flow of traffic until 16:15. Flying Checkpoint: At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Shufa village. Raid: (i) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Shiwkiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem until 02:15. (ii) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem. **Detention:** At 03:20 on November 17th 2014, Israeli forces detained two residents: Salah Mashah and Raed Na'waleh during their raid into Shiwkiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem as mentioned in the previous report. **Closure of Roads:**

(i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second **QALQILIYA** Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. **Flying Checkpoint:** (i) At 11:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Jayyous and Khirbet Sir Villages until 12:50. (ii) At 17:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya, detained a resident then withdrew at 20:00 Raid: (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Kafr Thulth until 12:00. (ii) At 18:45, Israeli forces raided Jit village served a halt to construction order for a home owned by Nathim Sada for allegedly being built without a licence. **Detention:** (i) At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Azzun Attma detained Ehab Hussien (A resident of Azzun). (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Khaled (A resident of Jayyus) in east Qalqiliya. **Wall Gates:** The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-(i) Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. Checkpoint: At 21:15, Israeli forces closed the main entrance gate at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 22:40. Flying Checkpoint: At 13:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Madma until 14:50. **NABLUS** Raid: (i) At 17:20, Israeli forces raided Agraba. (ii) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Beit Furiq, stormed four homes then withdrew at 05:00. (iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Nablus until 02:40. **Settler Violence:** At 16:40, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Burin village,

stoned several residents during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades

- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 12:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Aqbat Hassnah area located in Husan village until 14:10.

• Raid:

- (i) At 03:00 on November 16th 2014, Israeli forces raided Husan village and detained two residents.
- (ii) At 21:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar.
- (iii) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Tagou' until 03:00.

• Attack:

- (i) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Husan village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 15:15, Israeli forces positioned at the west entrance of Taqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

• Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained Omar Hamarah and Hilmi Hamarah in Husan village.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Hamarah at the entrance of Husan village

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- Raid: At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron then stormed and searched a home.
- <u>Detention:</u> At 19:30, Israeli forces detained three children (Residents of Beit Ummar): Ahmad Salibi (13 years old), Abdallah Abu Mariya (14 years old) and Wassim Abu Mariya (14 years old) at the entrance of Al-Urub camp.

HEBRON

At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by **ALL DISTRICTS** the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Rafah. Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical **NORTHERN** patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad **GAZA** through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. **Closure of Crossing Points:** (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. **GAZA** (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. **Closure of Crossing Points:** (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and **RAFAH** foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance. Attack: On the evening of November 17 2014, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Rafah city and damaged a fishing boat.
