	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> On November 18th 2012, demonstrations took place in all the districts of the West Bank against Israeli military aggression towards the Gaza Strip.

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City for Friday prayers. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint. <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram, fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades then withdrew at 22:00. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:50, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint clashed with demonstrators protesting Israeli assault on Gaza and opened fire towards them for alleged stoning. (ii) At 14:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Ram fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators, protesting Israel's assault on Gaza, for alleged stoning. (iii) At 14:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Isawiya and in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem, fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators, protesting Israelis assault on Gaza, for alleged stoning. (iv) At 16:40, Israeli forces positioned in Abu Dis neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired tear gas grenades towards demonstrators, protesting against Israel's assault on Gaza, for alleged stoning and injured a University student; left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation and detained 4 residents including a University student. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 24:00 on November 17th 2012, Israeli forces detained Diy'a Baydoun and Yazan Siyam in Silwan. (ii) Israeli forces detained Musa Musa and Ziyad Abu Nassar in Silwan. (iii) Israeli forces detained 4 residents of which only 1 could be identified: Ahmad Taha in Abu Dis. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> On November 18th 2012, Israeli authorities closed "Yasser Arafat" Palestine National theatre for a period of 24 hours and forcibly removed residents participating in the commemoration of President Yasser Arafat's death and peacefully demonstrating against Israel's assault on Gaza. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sleavawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city and Bir Zeit. (ii) At 14:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Mughier village, fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and torching an Israeli settler vehicle. (iii) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Mazari' Al-Nubani village, stormed 2 homes, summoned Rafiq Al-Qadi and Nour Al-Qaq to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:00. • <u>Attack:</u> At 11:20, Israeli forces positioned near Ofar prison in Beituniya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents participating in demonstrations against Israel's assault on Gaza leaving several residents suffocating from tear gas inhalation.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At dawn on November 19th 2012, Israeli settlers stormed Sinjil, torched a vehicle owned by Ahmad Khalil and wrote racist graffiti “Price Tag” vandals. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of ‘Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement ‘Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Arqa village and detained a resident. (ii) At 21:15, Israeli forces raided Faquq’a and Deir Abu Da’if villages, fired tear gas grenades towards several residents then withdrew at 21:45. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Jawad Waqad in Al-Arqa village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> the Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Tamoun, stormed a home and detained a resident. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On November 18th 2012, Israeli settlers stormed the Jordan valley under the protection of Israeli forces and assaulted several Sheppard’s, Israeli forces then detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Adam Bani Matar in Tamoun. (ii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Awad in the Jordan Valley.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Shweikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem. (ii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Far’un village. • <u>Attack:</u> On November 18th 2012, Israeli forces positioned in the area of west of Tulkarem, fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators protesting Israel’s aggression towards Gaza and detained 2 residents including a University student. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ahmad Shuhab and Ahmad Kan’an in west Tulkarem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Land leveling for adjustment of the Wall route was halted in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route is to be constructed west of the village for Sabbath holiday.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> On November 17th 2012, Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint detained Amar Jouli a resident of Azzun as he was on his way to Ramallah. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:50, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in south Qalqiliya fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and again opened fire at 16:30 which injured Mahmoud Milhim. (ii) At 18:10, Israeli forces positioned at the north entrance of Azzun fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators protesting Israel's assault on Gaza for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. (iii) At 17:30, Israeli forces closed the wall gate near Jayyus which leads to agricultural land located behind the wall and temporarily detained several residents and prevented them from reaching their homes. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continue in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:40, Israeli forces raided Madma village, for the alleged stoning of Israeli settler vehicle and stormed 2 homes. (ii) At 23:10, Israeli forces raided Sarah village until 23:50. (iii) At dawn on November 19th 2012, Israeli forces raided Awarta village and detained a resident. • <u>Attack:</u> At 12:10, Israeli forces positioned at Huwwara checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents demonstrating against Israel's assault on Gaza, for alleged stoning, assaulted 2 residents and injured another resident who was hit by a tear gas canister. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:00 on November 18th 2012 (as mentioned in the previous report), Israeli forces detained Taysir Omar and Sa'id Sa'id as they stormed Nablus. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mo'ayad Sharab in Orif village. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:20, Israeli settler under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Burin village and damaged a vehicle owned by Yusef Al-Najjar then withdrew at 21:00. (ii) At 05:15, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Orif village, set fire to a local mosque then withdrew at later time.

SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and QatanAl-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Bruqin and Kafr Al-Dik until 08:50. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 08:15, Israeli forces increased its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts and detained 11 residents including 5 Police officers and released them at a later time. • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:30, Israeli forces raided Jericho then withdrew at 21:20. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On November 12th 2012, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Humra checkpoint detained Anas Odeh. (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby crossing detained Tallib Jabarar, a resident of Turmus'ayya as he was travelling to Jordan.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:20, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, stormed a home and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On November 17th 2012, Israeli forces detained Wissam Hamdan, a National Security Officer near Husan village junction.

	<p>(ii) On November 18th 2012, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jab'a checkpoint detained Ahmad Ighnayamat, a resident of Hebron for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier.</p> <p>(iii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Al-Harimi in Bethlehem.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:50, 16:00 and again at 20:30, Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque in North Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators protesting Israel's assault on Gaza injuring 11 residents including an international peace activist, Nidal Al-Sabah (National Security Officer), Ahmad Farid and Mohammad Al-Tarsh and left several others suffocating from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 15:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Taqou' fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators protesting Israel's assault on Gaza. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzaq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) On July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar junction. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on November 18th 2012, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, opened fire as they detained a resident and injured him. (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Abu Asal and Beit Al-Roush villages. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:25, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Rayhiya village fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards participants in a demonstration against Israel military aggression on Gaza, for alleged stoning. (ii) At 11:35, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Urub camp fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and at 21:30 opened fire towards several children for

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 11 November 2012 at 18:00. • On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by conducting military operation under the code name "Pillar of Defence" by firing tank artillery shells from their positions behind the Green Line, launching missiles from Naval vessels, Israeli fighter jet launching 150 missiles towards all districts in Gaza which killed 42 residents killed including 9 children, 9 women and 13 Palestinian gunmen and injured 156 residents including 62 children and 9 women. • Israeli fighter jet missiles damaged 586 homes and destroyed 46 homes during their assault on Gaza. • Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching 274 projectiles and opening fire towards the Green Line. • Since November 15th 2012, all schools and Universities have cancelled classes
