JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Since 07:40 on November 18th 2014, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city (after an incident which left 4 Israeli settlers killed injured 4 others during which Israeli forces opened fire towards and killed 2 residents for the alleged attack). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 09:50 and again at 20:40, Israeli forces closed Jaba’ checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jerusalem , Ramallah and Jericho thus preventing residents from entering or exiting the checkpoint and reopened it at a later time. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram and detained two residents. (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Anata and detained two residents. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Mukabbir neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they stormed the homes of the two residents whom attacked and killed five Israeli settlers in a synagogue in Jerusalem. (ii) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned the north junction of Al-Ram fired

rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and detained a resident.

- (iii) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis, at the entrance of Shu'fat camp and the old city of Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (v) At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they stormed the home of the two residents whom attacked and killed five Israeli settlers in a synagogue in Jerusalem and as a result left several residents suffocating from tear gas inhalation.
- (vi) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis and in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (vii) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Eizariya and Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (viii) At 23:20, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- **Detention:**

- (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abu Jamal {The father of one of the 2 residents whom attacked and killed 5 Israeli settlers in a synagogue in Jerusalem} after storming and searching his home.
- (ii) At 20:40, Israeli forces detained Saher Al-Masmous near Bab Hata area in the old city of Jerusalem.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Shadi Ghawazneh and Ayad Ka'abneh in Al-Ram.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained two residents: Iz-Aldin Al-Fuqiya and Abdel-Rahman Al-Fuqiya in Annata.
- (v) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Salaymeh near the north junction of Al-Ram.

- **Home Demolition:** At 01:00, Israeli forces stormed Silwan neighbourhood and detonated using explosives the 4th floor apartment owned by the residents who ran over several Israeli settlers in Shu'fat neighbourhood in Jerusalem as mentioned in October 23rd report after forcing its residents out of the home.

- **Settler Violence:**

- (i) At 16:00, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Yafa road in West Jerusalem attacked and stabbed 2 residents as a result injured them including 1 critically injured: Imad Ghayth (A resident of Beit Hanina){critically injured} and Mohammad Abu Bakr (A resident of the old city of Jerusalem).
- (ii) At 17:00, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Al-Masarat neighbourhood, attacked and stabbed Fadi Radwan (A resident of Kafr Aqab) and as a result left him hospitalised.

- **Wall Gates:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) At 23:10, Israeli force set up a checkpoint near the entrance of Al-Mughier village and opened fire towards several residents then withdrew at 24:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh and Ramallah cities and clashed with several residents. (ii) At 23:35, Israeli forces raided Ras Kar Kar village and assaulted Hussein Abu Fakhdiya. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:10, Israeli forces positioned at Atarah bridge in North Bir Zeit, fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and temporarily detained the child :Mansour Shawamrah (A resident of Ramallah the released him at 22:45. (ii) At 12:40, Israeli forces positioned near “Ofar” Military Base/ Prison fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 19:40, Israeli forces positioned near Beitin village fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Ibrahim Daraghmeh with live bullet wound to his neck. (v) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned near “Ofrat” settlement opened fire towards a vehicle driven by Riyad Mir’I and as a result smashed his windshield. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli settlers positioned near Ein Qinya village opened fire towards several residents. (ii) At 15:20, Israeli settlers positioned near “Shilo” settlement stoned residents and vehicles travelling along the main road connecting Nablus and Ramallah

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 07:40, Israeli forces closed Al-Rihan-Barta’a checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until reopening the steel gate at 07:50.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 09:45, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 12:55. • <u>Raid:</u> At 08:50, Israeli forces raided Shwakiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem. • <u>Attack:</u> At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near “Ghishouri” factories in West Tulkarem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30 and again at 15:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jit village until 16:30. (ii) At 09:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 10:50. (iii) At 21:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. (iv) At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Azzun and Kafr Thulth until 22:30. • <u>Raid:</u> At 13:50, Israeli forces raided Izbit Al-Tabib village, stormed a home, temporarily detained Riziq Tabib, released him at a later time then withdrew at 14:50 • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:40, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Jayyus fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 10:00, Israeli settlers positioned near “Karni Shamron” settlement stoned residents and vehicles travelling along the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

(ii) At 19:10, Israeli settlers positioned near “Yitsahar” settlement stoned residents and vehicles travelling along the main road connecting Nablus and Ramallah and as a result injured Ehab Ishtaya (A resident of Salem village). (iii) At 20:35, Israeli settlers positioned near Burin village set fire to a home owned by Ghalib Al-Najjar and stoned several other homes.

(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to

BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
