<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On November 18th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound, which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On November 16th 2015, Israeli forces closed the south entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood, which also leads to “Armon Hatziv” settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 12:50, Israeli forces closed Qalandiya checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic because of an alleged suspicious Unidentified object then reopened it at a later time. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Eizariya then searched residents and vehicles. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Qutna village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) On the evening of November 18th 2015, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Anata village, Al-Eisawiya village, Shu’fat , Abu Dis, Al-Thuri neighbourhood and Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhoods in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces detained the child Nour Ghayth (11 years old) in Al-Thuri neighbourhood in Jerusalem. • <u>Assault on Medical Sector:</u> At 08:30, Israeli forces stormed Al-Makasid hospital in Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem in order to search for Ibrahim Ayad {A Resident of Abu Dis} and took photographs of the entire hospital. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 12:15, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near “Bet El” settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) Since 18:40 on October 16th 2015, Israeli forces closed the road between Silwad and Deir Jreir village located near “Ofra” settlement and closed the road connecting Silwad and Ain Yabrod with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atarah Bridge located in North Bir Ziet then searched residents and vehicles until 09:50. (ii) At 09:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ur Al-Foqa village then searched residents and vehicles until 16:00. (iii) At 15:25, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 16:35, Israeli forces raided Silat Al-Thaher, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 17:25. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 19:00, a group of Israeli settlers stormed the abandoned area of "Homish" settlement then withdrew later. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds (iv) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel Gate • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 07:30, on November 18th 2015 and again at 14:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya then searched residents and vehicle. (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jit village then searched residents and vehicle. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:20, Israeli forces raided Azzun, stormed and searched "Al-Lo'lo'a" reception hall, detained a resident then withdrew at 02:00. (ii) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, stormed and searched several homes and storage rooms then withdrew at 05:00. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Abdel-Haleem Muthna Hussien in Azzun. • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in the west Qalqiliya, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured five residents and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 16:50, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in west Jayyous fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) At 22:00 on October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta village with dirt mounds.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. (ix) Since 10:45 on September 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amous" settlement with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nashash junction located at the south entrance of Bethlehem and temporarily detained Yusef Mahmoud Taqatqa (A resident of Beit Fajjar) then released him at 15:15.

(ii) At 04:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Duhiesheh camp in Bethlehem, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched several homes and as a result injured 6 residents including a child: Mustafa Atita Al-Hasnat (17 years old), Eayad Ahmad Ayash Shamarkha, Yusef Fawzi Mohammad Sajadiya, Islam Ibrahim Al-Masri, Ahmad Mohammad Abu Atafat, Jihad Issa Mohammad Ma'ali and also left Mayseer Hassan Hussien Abu Faraj (63 years old) suffocated from tear gas inhalation and detained 2 residents and summoned 6 residents Mohammad Nayef Daoud Salem, Abdallah Nayef Daoud Salem, Bassam Al-Hasnat, Ammar Sami Mahmoud Hajajrah, Anas Izat Abu Daya and Wael Khalil Atallah Salem to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 06:50. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained two residents: Mohammad Abu Aker and Salah Mohammad Al-Ju'edi in Al-Duhiesheh camp in Bethlehem. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 22:50, Israeli forces positioned near "Kafr Itsiyon" settlement assaulted Abdel-Rahman Mohammad Qabajat (A resident of Tarqumiya in Hebron District) and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Husan village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards a local boy's school while students where near the school entrance. (ii) At 14:15, Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem, fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 16:15, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Taqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Saber Ribhi Al-Amour after he was struck by a tear gas grenade canister in the head.

 - **Raid:**
 - (i) At 02:40 on November 18th 2015, Israeli forces raided Yatta and detained two residents including a child.
 - (ii) At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron, detained a resident then withdrew at 06:15.
 - **Detention:**
 - (i) At 01:20 on November 18th 2015, Israeli forces detained the child Thiyab Eyad Mizhir (14 years old) during their raid into Hebron.
 - (ii) At 09:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron detained the child Ahmad Nasser Ahmad Sharawnah (16 years old) {A resident of Deir Sammit village} for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier.
 - (iii) At 13:20, Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint located at the entrance of Al-Shuhada road in the old city of Hebron detained Leen Haytham Tawfiq Al-Hih (A resident of Surif).
 - (iv) At 19:50, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Juhar area located in the old city of Hebron detained Amjad Abdel-Rahman Al-Rajabi and Faysal Naji Al-Batsh.
 - (v) At 23:30, Israeli forces positioned near Zif village junction detained Mohammad Hijazi Hassan Bahis after assaulting him and confiscating a waterer tank truck he was driving.
