WEST BANK

• Closure:

- (i) Since 07:40 on November 18th 2014, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city (after an incident which left 4 Israeli settlers killed injured 4 others during which Israeli forces opened fire towards and killed 2 residents for the alleged attack).
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

JERUSALEM

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- (iii) At 09:30 and again at 19:00, Israeli forces closed Jaba' checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho thus preventing residents from entering or exiting the checkpoint and reopened it at a later time.
- (iv) At 10:30, Israeli forces closed Shu'fat checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic then reopened it later.
- (v) At 13:50, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Hizma checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces set up several checkpoints in Silwan neighbourhood and closed the entrances with cement blocks.
- Raid: At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram, stormed and searched a home,

damaged several pieces of furniture, detained two residents then withdrew at 04:50.

• Attack:

- (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces positioned near Shu'fat checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned in Aqbat Al-Sireh area in the old city of Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 16:45, Israeli forces positioned near Jaba' village bridge in Al-Ram fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 19:15, Israeli forces positioned in Hushiyeh neighbourhood, Al-Qarmi, Alsira neighbourhoods in the old city of Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (v) At 19:15, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (vi) At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and fire bombing of an Israeli Police vehicle.
- (vii)At 19:40, Israeli forces positioned in Sur Bahar village and Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured four residents: Ahmad Aliyan, Nour Obeida, Malik Al-Mahali and Ahmad Al-Hadad (A Paramedic).
- (viii) At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned in Beit Hanina fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and firing "fireworks" towards Israeli settler vehicles.
- (ix) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they stormed the condolence events for the two residents {who stabbed and killed four Israeli settlers} and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- (x) At 03:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Eisawiya village and in Silwan neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (xi) At 03:20, Israeli forces positioned near Shu'fat camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

• Physical Assault:

- (i) On the evening of November 18th 2014, Israeli forces positioned near "The Beout" settlement in Jerusalem assaulted and Injured Bashar Dindies while he was on duty at his work place "Dominos" factory.
- (ii) At 11:30, Israeli Police officers positioned at Salah Al-Din road in the old city of Jerusalem assaulted the child: Khader Al-Ajouli (16 years old) and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions.
- (iii) At 19:30, Israeli forces assaulted Ahmad Qassem (A Resident of Al-Ram) and hit him in the face with the rifles leaving hospitalised with facial fractures and contusions.
- <u>Provocation of Palestinian Security Forces:</u> At 02:40, Israeli forces positioned near Jaba' checkpoint prevented a Palestinian Civil Defence "Fire truck" to pass through the checkpoint as it was on duty to put out a fire in Anata.

• Home Demolition:

- (i) On the evening of November 19th 2014, Israeli forces stormed Al-Thuri neighbourhood in Jerusalem and served an eviction order for the implementation of demolition of a home owned by Mu'taz Hijazi {who was killed by Israeli forces}.
- (ii) At dawn on November 20th 2014, Israeli forces stormed Shu'fat camp and served a demolition order for a home owned by Ibrahim Al-Akari {who was killed by Israeli forces}.
- <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem under the protection of Israeli Police and Military forces.
- <u>Settlement Activity:</u> On November 19th 2014, Israeli Authorities approved planes for the construction of 78 settlement unites, (50 of which will be built in "Har Homa" settlement and 28 will be built in "Ramot" settlement) in Jerusalem on Palestinian land occupied ion 1967.

• Settler Violence:

- (i) At 14:05, Israeli settlers assaulted several school children in the old city of Jerusalem.
- (ii) At 14:30, Israeli settlers stormed Deir Yassin area and assaulted two Bedouin residents: Fakhri Abu Irmeleh and Foad Obied (Both residents of Jerusalem).
- (iii) At 15:00, Israeli settlers stormed Sur Bahar and attacked a vehicle owned by Hamza Otwan and as a result smashed the vehicles windows.
- (iv) At 15:50, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over the child Fawzi Saleh (11 years old) in Beit Hanina and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions.
- (v) At 22:30, Israeli settlers stormed Romima area in Jerusalem and assaulted Ma'moun Abidien and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions.
- (vi) At 18:50, Israeli settlers stormed Khan Al-Humar area located between Jerusalem and Jericho assaulted several residents under the protection of Israeli forces who opened fire towards residents and detained two residents as they attempted to prevent the settler assault.

• <u>Detention</u>:

- (i) On November 18th 2014, Israeli forces positioned at Salah Al-Din road in the old city of Jerusalem detained Ahmad Zaloum.
- (ii) On November 18th 2014, Israeli forces positioned at the north junction off Al-Ram detained Rami Nabil.
- (iii) At 09:00, Israeli forces detained four residents: Obada Najib, Omar Abu Al-Hawa, Eyad Al-Shubaki and Omar Al-Harbawi in Jerusalem.
- (iv) At 09:00, Israeli forces detained two residents: Rashid Nimer and Tarik Nimer in Sur Bahar village.
- (v) At 19:15, Israeli forces detained the child: Ahmad Al-Agha (14 years old) in Aqbat Al-Sireh area in the old city of Jerusalem.
- (vi) At 19:20, Israeli forces detained Munir Hamad in Sur Bahar village.
- (vii)At 19:50, Israeli forces positioned at Zaytouneh checkpoint located between Jerusalem and Al-Eizariya detained the child Mohammad Far'oun (13 years old).
- (viii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Aliyan and Mohamamd Aliyan in Al-Ram.
- (ix) Israeli forces Khan Al-Humar area located between Jerusalem and Jericho detained Ahmad Ka'abneh and Tayil Ka'abneh.

- (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.
- (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
- <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.
- <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces closed the main entrance gate at Huwara checkpoint, impeded and redirected the free flow of traffic until 09:00.

- (v) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Nablus as they escorted a group of Israeli settlers who stormed Jesephs Tomb, clashed with several residents and as a result injured 4 residents: Yusef Oday, Tamer Al-Missi, Hussein Al-Meesi and Osama Fadel then withdrew at 04:05

- (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned near Awarta and Awalada village's junctions fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- Settler Violence: At 15:35, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Furiq village under the protection of Israeli forces who fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.

- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 21:05, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Husan village and stoned residents and vehicles.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.

HEBRON

- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bani Na'im.
- (ii) At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at AL-Sima village junction until 09:20.
- (iii)At 16:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge.

Raid:

- (i) At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 01:30.
- (ii) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Fuwar camp and detained a resident.
- (iii)At dawn on November 20th 2014, Israeli forces raided Beit Umar, stormed several homes, detained three residents and summoned Yusef Kamel to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- (iv)At dawn on November 11th 2014, Israeli forces raided Surif, stormed several homes and detained a resident.
- (v) At dawn on November 20th 2014, Israeli forces raided Beit Awa and detained two residents.
- (vi)At dawn on November 20th 2014, Israeli forces raided Deir Sammit village and detained a resident.

• Detention:

- (i) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned in Tal Al-Rumayada neighbourhood detained Diya Daoud, temporarily detained 2 children: Ahmad Al-Aza (15 years old) and Azam Jaber (16 years old) then rekeased them later.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Rami Al-Khatib in Al-Fuwar camp.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Eyad Sabarneh, Rami Sabarneh and Ayman Al-Za'aqiq in Beit Ummar.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained Khaled Daraghmeh in Surif.
- (v) Israeli forces detained Akram Masalmeh and Baha Masalmeh in Beit Awa.
- (vi) Israeli forces detained Kahled Huroub in Deir Sammit village.

Attack

- (i) At 09:10, Israeli forces positioned near "Khalil Al-Rahman" school in Tariq bin Zayed area of the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 11:55, Israeli forces positioned near Ta'at Abu Hadid area in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 18:40, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Physical Assault:** At 20:40, Israeli forces positioned at Zif village junction sprayed pepper spray onto the face of Ahmad Al-Shamti and left him hospitalised with burnt eyes and suffocation.
- <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces stormed Um Al-Kheir village in east Yatta and served demolition orders for seven homes owned by Anas Al-Hathalin, Adel Al-Hathalin, Abdallah Al-Hathalin, Ayda Al-Hathalin, Aziza Al-Hathalin, Amar Al-Hathalin and Kheiry Al-Hathalin.

• Settler Violence:

- (i) At 10:15, a group of Israeli settlers positioned at Al-Shuhada road in the old city of Hebron provoked several residents, stormed a school as they were hosting several International delegates from (TIPH).
- (ii) At 23:00, Israeli settlers positioned near "Nugohot" settlement stoned

GAZA STRIP

At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom **ALL DISTRICTS** of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line toward Khan Yunis. Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza. Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad **NORTHERN** through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. **GAZA** Attack: At 09:30, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya. **Closure of Crossing Points:** (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. **GAZA** (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Attack: On the morning of November 19th 2014, Israeli forces positioned behind **KHAN YUNIS** the Green Line opened fire towards several farmers in east Khaz'a. • Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed. **RAFAH** (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance.
