JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City for Friday prayers. The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint. <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to

(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sleavawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) At 10:55, Israeli forces positioned near Atara bridge fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and injured 2 residents. (iii) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned at Ofar prison in Beituniya fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in south of Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets towards residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Arqa village. • <u>Attack:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jammala checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Yusef Masharqa in Ya'bad. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services

	for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> the Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Tubas and detained a resident. • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:55, Israeli forces positioned near Atuf village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades for alleged stoning and detained 2 residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) As mentioned in the previous report, at 01:50 on November 20th 2012, Israeli forces detained Nasr Abdel Raziq during their raid into Kashda village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Daraghma in Tubas. (iii) Israeli forces detained Ayman Bashirat and Mohammad Qatishat in Atouf village.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Shweikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem and detained 3 residents. (ii) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Bal'a and detained a resident. 	<p>(i) At 14:30 and again at 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint in south Qalqiliya fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and injured 3 residents.</p> <p>(ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned at the north entrance of Azzun fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and injured 2 residents.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p> • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continue in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.

(ii) At 22:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Jiftlik village junction. • <u>Attack:</u> At 20:15, Israeli forces positioned in the center of Al-Oja village fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents participating in demonstrations against Israel's assault on Gaza.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) On July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Hebron. (ii) At 00:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge and detained a child. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya. (ii) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:55, Israeli forces positioned near Zif village junction fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and injured 5 residents. GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 11 November 2012 at 18:00. • On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by conducting military operation under the code name "Pillar of Defence" by firing tank artillery shells from their positions behind the Green Line, launching missiles from Naval vessels, Israeli fighter jet launching 70 missiles towards all districts in Gaza which killed 29 residents killed including 2 children, 3 Journalists and 19 Palestinian gunmen and injured 170 residents including 63 children, 34 women and 2 journalists. • Israeli fighter jet missiles destroyed 2 bridges and destroyed 12 homes during their assault on Gaza. • Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching 242 projectiles and opening fire towards the Green Line. • Since November 15th 2012, all schools and Universities have cancelled classes because of Israel's assault on Gaza. • Israeli air strikes destroyed 21 mosques, damaged several tombs during strikes on 4 cemeteries, damaged 5 hospitals and health clinics, destroyed a health fitness center and destroyed 28 vehicles in the Gaza strip.

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed. • <u>Attack:</u> On November 20th 2012, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line and Naval vessels launched several tank artillery shells and missiles towards Beit Hanun and Beit Lahiya. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:40, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line launched tank artillery shells towards barren land located east of Jabaliya.
