JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 09:30, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba’ checkpoint along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and as a result impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Detention:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint detained Falastin Nijim, a resident of Nablus for allegedly carrying a knife. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> On the afternoon of November 20th 2013, Israeli forces in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem temporarily detained Malik Da’na (11 years old) as they stormed a barber shop then released him after questioning. • <u>Obstruction of Places of Worship:</u> At 10:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem provoked several worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Turmus'aya until 14:20. (ii) At 16:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Taybeh junction. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Aroura until 03:50. (ii) At 00:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city and stormed a home. (iii) At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Kobar village, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:50. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Mohammad Zibar in Kobar village. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:45, Israeli force raided Kafr Dan as they escorted several scientists as they conducted tests on water wells then withdrew at 13:30. (ii) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Rumana village. • Temporary Detention: At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jamalat checkpoint temporarily detained Mohammad Al-Yamani then released him at a later time. • Destruction of Property: At 23:00, Israeli forces served demolition orders to demolish 6 homes (under construction) and 2 barracks owned by Ziyad Sa'dalla, Haytham Al-Nabulsi, Mohammad Qubaha,, Mohammad Qubaha, Taysir Ali and Midhat Qubaha in Khirbet Abdallah Al-Yunis and Khor Al-Daba' areas in Barta'a located behind the wall gate for allegedly being built without proper licensing because of its location in area C which is under Israeli military and administrative control. • Demonstration: At 11:00, a demonstration took place in south Ya'bad protesting against Israeli forces decision to uproot 100 Olive trees located along the main road connecting Jenin and Tulkarem which 20m in length and 3m wide which are owned by 70 residents during which Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators and as a result injured Arafat Amouri and Atef Badarna from suffocation as a result of tear gas inhalation during which they detained a residents and temporarily detained Ali Abu baker and released him at a later time. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Haytham Abu Bakr in Yatta. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 14:00, Israeli forces raided Khirbeit Yarza, stormed and searched 3 homes.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv: checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem until 04:25 • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya, impeded the free flow of traffic after closing the entrance then reopened it at a later time. (ii) At 15:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Immatin village. (iii) At 24:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Azzun bridge and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint beneath Azzun bridge detained Lu’ay Hawari, a resident of Azzun. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate closed the steel gate at 11:55 and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Sharaf village junction until 13:40.

(iii) At 13:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Burqa village until 14:20. (iv) At 18:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Qusra village junction until 19:20. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Khirbeit Al-Tawil area in Aqraba and demolished a barracks owned by Marwan Bani Odeh and a water tank owned by Imad Miniya. (ii) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Nablus.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 12:45, Israeli forces raided Bruqin. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road 90 junctions located near Nue'meh village until 23:15. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Jiftlik village, demolished a home and 5 barracks owned by Sa'ud Qa'abna {Home and barracks}, Rabi' Daraghmeh {residential Barracks}, Salem Qa'abneh {2 barracks} and Suliman Daraghmeh {barracks} and at 23:20 Israeli forces again raided Al-Jiftlik village during which they demolished a home and summoned Ahmad Sa'ed to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 24:00. (ii) At 19:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village. • <u>Injury:</u> At 13:50, 2 residents: Fadi Sharaydeh and Mohammad Sawafta were injured after being attacked by Israeli military guard dogs as they were passing through Al-Hamra checkpoint. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby crossing temporarily detained Hikmat Al-Nabrisi as he was returning from Jordan and released him after being questioned by Israeli Intelligence. (ii) At 16:00, at 15:00, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby crossing temporarily detained Subhi Al-Sufias he was returning from Jordan then released him at 22:20. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 10:30, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Jericho in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.</p> <p>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta.
