- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Za'tara bridge.
- (ii) At 20:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Fajjar.
- **Raid:** At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Taqou' and detained 2 residents.

- (i) At 11:55, Israeli forces positioned near Bilal bin Rabah mosque in Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning, injured Eyad Abu Sa'r and detained 4 residents.
- (ii) At 19:45, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Taqou' fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii)At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Hussan village fired tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.

Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained Saed Abu Mafraf and Samer Abu Mafrah in Taqou'.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Khalil Abu Ikir, Murad Al-Khatib and Abdallah Obiedat near Bilal bin Rabah mosque in Bethlehem.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in North West of Beit Jala town.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) On July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

• Attack:

- (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrances of Abu Na'im, Al-Urub camp, Halhul bridge, Biet Anun junction, Zif junction, Al-Fuwar junction, Bab Al-Zawiya area, Abu Snieneh neighbourhood and Al-Shalashla road in the old city of Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators protesting Israel's assault on Gaza and as a result left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation including Hassan Ata (a Palestinian Police officer).
- (ii) At18:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Halhul bridge fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning, injuring Rami Al-Shahatit and Diya' Abu Ayad.
- (iii) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Kahil fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 21:45, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Khursa village fired rubber coated steel bullets towards residents for alleged stoning and injured Abdel Qadder Milhim.

• Detention:

- (i) At 01:35 on November 21st 2012, Israeli forces detained Hamda Abu Sharkh, A'hed Abu Sharkh and Bassim Abu Sharkh in Al-Thahriya.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Rayan near Halhul bridge.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Izz Al-Tmeizi (15 years) in Ithna.
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

- At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire.
- On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark.
- Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by conducting military operation under the code name Pillar of Defence" by firing tank artillery shells from their positions behind the Green Line, launching missiles from Naval vessels, Israeli fighter jet launching 80 missiles towards all districts in Gaza which killed 21 residents killed including 2 children, 1 Woman and 14 Palestinian gunmen and injured 125 residents including 12 children and 35 women.
- Israeli fighter jet missiles destroyed 6 vehicles, damaged 9 mosques, damaged 5 hospitals and health clinics, damaged 35 schools and a University, damaged 4

- banks, 3 Soccer fields and 3 hotels during their assault on Gaza.
- Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching 170 projectiles and opening fire towards the Green Line.
- Since November 15th 2012, all schools and Universities have cancelled classes because of Israel's assault on Gaza.

• Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed.

- <u>Attack:</u> On November 21st 2012, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line launched several tank artillery shells and missiles towards Beit Hanun and Beit Lahiya.
 - (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line launched tank artillery shells towards Al-Landa towers.
 - (ii) At 13:10, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green line launched several tank artillery shells Beit Hanun Hospital in Beit Hanun.
 - (iii) At 15:10, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line launched several tank artillery shells towards agricultural land in Beit Hanun.
- <u>Aerial Assault:</u> On November 21st 2012, Israeli fighter jets launched several missiles towards residential homes and Palestinian gunmen positions in Beit Hanun, Beit Lahiya and Jabaliya including:
 - (i) At 09:00, Israeli fighter jets launched 1 missile towards Tel Al-Za'tar area located in north Jabaliya killing 1 Palestinian gunman.
 - (ii) At 14:00, Israeli fighter jets launched 1 missile towards Palestinian gunmen in Al-Tawam area and killed 1 gunman.
 - (iii) At 17:00, Israeli fighter jets launched a missile towards Palestinian gunmen located in west Beit Lahiya killing 1 gunman.
