WEST BANK

JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeding the free flow of traffic.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) On the evening of November 21st 2013, Israeli forces detained Ikram Al-Sharafa inside the vicinity of Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem.
 - (ii) On the evening of November 21st 2013, Israeli forces positioned in Ein Al-Louz area in Silwan neighbourhood detained Mohammad Abu Adib and Khalil Qara’in as they stormed the area and clashed with its residents.
- **Temporary Detention:** At 08:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Eizarira junction temporarily detained Auws Al-Faroukh (A Palestinian Police Officer) then released him at a later time.
- **Attack:** At 19:10, Israeli forces positioned in Be’ir Ayoub area in Silwan neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Home Demolition:** At 08:00, Israeli forces served demolition orders to demolish a 3 floor 900m home owned by Mohammad Dari in Al-Issawiya village.
- **Assault on Places of Worship:** At 09:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers.
- **Wall Gates:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya

	west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atara bridge. • <u>Raid:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Abu Mash'al village, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes then withdrew at 21:10. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Deir Abu Mash'al fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 15:55, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Hammad Hammad. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis village.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Arraba junction until 16:00. (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ya'bad and detained a Presidential Guard then withdrew at 15:30. (iii) At 15:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Yamoun. • <u>Raid:</u> At 10:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Zabadiya, temporarily detained several residents as they stormed several homes then released them after questioning then withdrew at 16:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ramiz Abu Bakr (A National Security Officer) at the entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 14:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:25, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem until 10:15. (ii) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Faraoun village stormed a vehicle spare parts shop, confiscated several vehicle spare parts and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Taysir Hamad in Faroun village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.

<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib village. (ii) At 14:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya. (iii) At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Azzun, stormed and searched several homes, detained 4 residents including a child then withdrew at 07:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 4 residents: Mohammad Rayan (14 years old), Assad Mash'al, Adam Saleem and Ala Othman in Azzun. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector impeded the free flow of traffic and at 11:55 closed the main entrance gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq. (ii) At 18:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beita until 20:00.
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iii) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Al-Dik.

	<p>(iv) At 18:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Deir Istya, impeded the free flow of traffic after the alleged firebombing of an Israeli settler vehicle then reopened it at a later time.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raid: At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Deir Ballout and detained 2 residents. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Ramiz Musa and Muhanad Khier in Deir Ballut. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Since 14:00 on October 18th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Surif and Al-Jab'a village with dirt mounds • Flying Checkpoint: At 21:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Taqou until 23:10. • Raid: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Obidiya until 10:55. (ii) At 11:20, Israeli forces raided Harmalla and detained 2 residents. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Khalid Mahmoud Al-Zir and Khalid Adel Al-Zir in Harmalla village. • Temporary Detention: At 11:35, Israeli forces temporarily detained 4 residents including 2 Journalists : Mamdouh Hamara (Journalist), Abed Al-Nathseh (Journalist), Ibrahim Musa and Ahmad Salahas they were documenting Israeli forces as they levelled 20 dunumes (Acres) in Batan Assi area in Al-Khadr then released them at 12:30. • Attack: At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp fired rubber coated

	<p>steel bullets and tears gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On the evening of November 21st 2013, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces installed several tents near the west entrance of Taqou. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction continued in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Hebron. (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Wadi Qubbun area located in North Hebron. (iii) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Dura and Al-Fuwar camp. (iv) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge. (v) At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna • <u>Raid:</u> At 20:50, Israeli forces raided Sa'ir until 04:00. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> • Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. • Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open the entry and exit of residents, tourists' medical patients and, 83 truckloads of construction material for internationally funded projects. • Sufa Crossing is closed. • Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination, diesel fuel , truckloads of construction material for Internationally funded projects as well as several shipment of agricultural crops.
