<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On November 21st 2014 The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 35 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) At 20:15, Israeli forces closed Wadi Al-Hilweh road in Silwan neighbourhood and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 22:20, Israeli forces closed Shu’fat checkpoint then reopened it later. • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:00 on November 21st 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya, clashed with several residents, detained two residents and assaulted two others: Mohammad Abu Al-Hummus and Raed Abu Mayala. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:45, Israeli forces positioned near Sur Bihar village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and again at 21:30. (ii) At 12:50, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram North junction fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured six residents including a child: Tarik Ghazawneh (17 years old), Mohammad Hamadien, Tahadi Al-Takhouni, Karim Ghazawneh and Mohammad Faraj.

	<p>(iii) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured three residents including a woman: Nawal Al-Tamimi, Ammar Al-Ghalban and Sa'ed Al-Masri.</p> <p>(iv) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned near Beit Iksa checkpoint fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured two residents: Mohammad Al-Shiekh and Diya Al-Shiekh.</p> <p>(v) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <p>(vi) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Thuri neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <p>(vii) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Anata fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <p>(viii) At 19:45, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <p>(ix) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <p>(x) At 23:15, Israeli forces positioned in Bab Hata area in the old city of Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On November 21st 2014, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over Suzan Al-Qard in Shu'fat neighbourhood and as a result left her hospitalised with contusions. (ii) At 18:40, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Tur neighbourhood and stoned several residents and vehicles. (iii) At 22:30, a group of Israeli settlers assaulted Hamada Al-Ghoul (A resident of Silwan) and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions. (iv) At 22:30, a group of Israeli settlers armed with steel pipes stormed Jerusalem and assaulted Sanaa Al-Salaymeh and as a result left her hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:00 on November 21st 2014, Israeli forces detained three residents: Ibrahim Awad, Mohammad Al-Rajjabi and Jihad Zaytounch. (ii) At 03:30 on November 21st 2014, Israeli forces detained two residents including a child: Ayman Khader 17 years old) and Shadi Al-Mighrabi near Bab Al-Amoud gate in the old city of Jerusalem. (iii) Israeli forces detained Hani Obied and Mohammad Obied in Al-Eisawiya. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

	<p>the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages.</p> <p>(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.</p> <p>(iii) Since 11:30, on October 27th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Bet El Settlement located near Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks.</p> <p>(iv) At 23:10, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Labban Al-Gharbiya with cement blocks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in south Al-Bireh fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 12:50, Israeli; forces positioned at the entrance of Abboud fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at “Ofar” military base/Prison fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured five residents: Karam Marrar, Mohammad Al-Khaldi, Aram Al-Sabah, Mohammad Ishaq and Ahmad Othman. (v) At 14:45, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (vi) At 15:15, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (vii) At 15:15, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Deir Nathim village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 09:40, Israeli settlers stormed Ein Sinya village then withdrew at 10:15. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:40, a demonstration took place in Ni’lin protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 12:45, a demonstration took place in Bil’in protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and left several others suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation. (iii) At 13:00, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against land confiscation for the purpose of Israeli settlement construction during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as result injured 3 residents: Usayed Rshid (16 years old), Nariman Al-Tamimi and Ali Al-Khatib and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:15, Israeli forces raided Tamoun, stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 05:20.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Nawaf Bani Odeh. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near “Aveni Hivits”. (iv) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Nabi Eliyas village and the agricultural road located between Qalqiliya and Nablus with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00 and again 23:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 23:00. (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Jayyyus and Kafar Jamal until 21:00. (iii) At 22:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Kafr Laqif and Baqat Al-Hatab villages until 23:15. • <u>Detention:</u> At 14:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Azzun Atma village detained Suliman Abu Khaadija (A resident of Qalqiliya). • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Habala located in South Qalqiliya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 13:40, Israeli forces positioned at the east area of Azzun stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 20:10, Israeli forces positioned at “Ayal” gate located on the green line in North Qalqiliya stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli settler driving vehicles attempted to kidnap Shaher Al-Yamin (A resident of Jit village) near the main road in Al-Fanqud village. (ii) At 11:00, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Kafar Laqif villeg then withdrew later. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 12:00, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces who tried to disrupt the demonstration and as a result injured the child: Saam Al-Eishtawi as well as leaving several demonstrators suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.

	<p>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p>
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: At 18:05, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Kafil Harris until 19:00. • Temporary Detention: At 14:30, Israeli forces temporarily detained three children: Khaled Salah (12 years old), Ahmad Damarat (13 years old) and Iz-Al-Din Salah (13 years old) for alleged stoning then released them later.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: At 15:10, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District at 15:40. • Flying Checkpoint: At 11:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 12:15.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’mān village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu’mān: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near “Ifrat” settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to “Newe Daniyyel” settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and

(iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces raided Taqou', occupied Daoud Al-Amours home and converted its roof top into a military post then withdrew at 16:35. (iii) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Harmalah village, stormed a home and summoned Ra'fat Salahat to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. (iv) At 01:40, Israeli forces Bethlehem, Al-Aza, Al-Ayda and Al-Duhisheh camps, clashed with residents as they stormed several homes, summoned 7 resident's: Ali Salahat (A National Security Officer), Hassan Al-Wardiyah, Adel Jawarsih, Khaled Qaraq', Abdallah Saqr, Mohammad Al-Badwana and Mohammad Al-Ja'fari then withdrew at 05:40. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ali Al-Badawi (A Resident of Al-Urub camp). • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Tqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned in Dar Salah village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. (iii) At 15:55, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 10:50, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near "Ifrat" settlement stoned residents and vehicles travelling along the main road connecting Bethlehem and Hebron. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 11:55, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma'assra village protesting against the construction of the wall during which Israeli forces prevented residents from reaching the demonstration site.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiwn Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna locat6ed near the wall gate. (vii) At 13:40 on September 16th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna until 16:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:45, Israeli forces raided Halhul and stormed a home.
