JERUSALEM	 Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint. Checkpoints: (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim. 				
	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. Flying Checkpoint: At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village, impeded the free flow of traffic and later allowed cars to pass through 				
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	the checkpoint. (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Attara village bridge (iii) At 14:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Mazra'a Al-Sharqiya. (iv) At 15:25, Israeli force set up a flying checkpoint at Surda junction.				

	 Raid: (i) At 14:45 and again at 02:05, Israeli forces raided Bir Zeit and set up a flying checkpoint at Bir Zeit University junction, during which confrontations ensued between university students and Israeli troops. (ii) At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Al Jalazoan camp. (iii) At 03:25, Israeli forces raided El-Bireh City until 04:55.
	• Attack: At 15:30, Israeli forces fired teargas grenades towards civilians for alleged stoning at the entrance Al-Nabi Saleh village.
	 <u>Detentions:</u> In addition to those mentioned in the previous report, Israeli forces detained Walid Hanashiya during their raid into Ramallah at 01:50 on November 22nd 2011.
	 Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al- Gharbi and Rantis villages.
	• <u>Closure of Main Road</u> : The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan.
JENIN	 <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 18:15, Israeli forces closed "Mofodan" checkpoint located on the main road in southern Yaabad and reopened it at 20:00.
	• Flying checkpoint: At 16:45, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Yaabad.
	• Raid: (i) At 18:15 Israeli forces raided Yaabad, opened fire towards agricultural land while searching the southern outskirts of Yaabad for alleged attackers of a settler's vehicle, who they say threw a Molotov cocktail; treoops withdrew at 20:00.
	 (ii) At 23:50, Israeli forces raided Bir Al-Basha. Detentions: In addition to those mentioned in the previous report, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Nassar at 01:05 on 21.11.2011 during their raid into Jenin as
	 <u>Wall Gates</u>: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
	 <u>Checkpoints</u>: the Israeli army continues to tighten restrictions on Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint to between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00.
TUBAS	• Raids: At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Tubas fired sound grenades, detained 2 residents and withdrew at 03:55.
	 <u>Detentions:</u> Israeli forces detained Zein Sawafta and Thaer Sawafta during their raid into Tubas.
	• Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Large ligarous continues to alone with dirt mounts the most connecting West.
TULKAREM	 The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village.
	(ii) At 13:00, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road.
	 <u>Checkpoints</u>: At 20:00 the Israeli army increased restrictions on Palestinian access at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic.

	stormed and searched several homes, including the home of Abeer Odeh from
	Saida and Iman Gazawi, a resident of Atil (both are former detainees who
	were released in the prisoner exchange deal). Israeli forces also served 2
	residents, Saed and Samer Abu Khazna, summons to Israeli intelligence.
	(ii) At 23:40, Israeli forces raided Kafr Lubbad.
	(iii) At 01:05, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem and Tulkarem refugee camp, stormed
	a home, detained a resident and served Amjad Turk a summon to Israeli
	intelligence.
	• <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Amer Turk during their raid into Tulkarem
	refugee camp.
	• Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted
	special Israeli permits, undercutting access to education and health services for
	civilians living behind the Wall.
	• Wall Construction: Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in
	the area surrounding Jubara village According to an Israeli High Court decision,
	the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.
	Closure of Roads:
	(i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of
	the town of Azzun.
	(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i> ,
	the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to
	Kafr Qaddum village.
	• Flying checkpoints: At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the
	entrance of Kafr Laqif.
	• Raids:
	(i) At 15:40, Israeli forces raided Azzoun.
	(ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces raided Izbat Al-Tabib.
	(iii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Hablah.
	• Wall Gates:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to
QALQILIYA	search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the
	village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows
	residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at
	the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students
	to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
	Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqef village north of
	Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement;
	east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement and between Azzun
	Atmeh town and Ornet settlement.
	Closure of Main Roads:
NABLUS	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-
	Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the
	settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the
	village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the
	village of Osrin.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. **Checkpoints:** Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on (i) Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and, 02:00 At Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross (ii) between 05:00 and 20:00 and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. At 10:25, Israeli forced increased restrictions at Shave Shomron checkpoint, (iii) impeding the free flow of traffic. At 16:50, Israeli forces increased restriction at Huwara checkpoint, impeding (iv) the free flow of traffic. Flying checkpoints: At 08:00 and again at 18:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the (i) entrance of Beit Furik, impeded the free flow of traffic and detained a university student. (ii) At 10:40, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Agraba and Osrin villages. (iii) At 15:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Salem village junction, searching civilians and vehicles. (iv) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Sarrah village junction (on the main road connecting Nablus and Qalqilya). (v) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Deir Sharaf junction (on the main road connecting Nablus and Tulkarem). (vi) At 23:05, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Deir Sharaf junction (on the main road connecting Nablus and Tulkarem). Raids: At23:20. Israeli forces raided Beita. (i) (ii) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided residential areas in eastern Nablus and Askar refugee camp and fired flash grenades. **Detentions:** On November 21st 2011, Israeli forces positioned at Shave Shomron" (i) checkpoint detained Yousef Khamis, a officer in the Presidential Guard.. Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Mleitat during their raid into Beit Furik (ii) village. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two (i) detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to (ii)Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of **SALFIT** traffic and at 09:30 Israeli forces closed the electronic gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. **Checkpoints:** At 20:05 The Israeli army increased restrictions at Za'tara

checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic opening it at a later time
Flying checkpoints: At 17:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at

	the entrance of Harries village.
	Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya
	town southeast of the illegal settlement.
	• <u>Closure of Main Road</u> : The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between
	Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks.
	• <u>Checkpoints</u> :
	(i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up
	along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to
	residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area. At 16:30, Israeli forces
JERICHO	closed the checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.
	(ii) Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on
	the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho
	District and others with access permits.
	• Land Levelling: At 09:20, bulldozers, protected by Israeli forces raided and
	levelled 18 dunums of agricultural land, and destroyed a building and crops on 120
	dunums belonging to Hassan Erekat and Khalid Da'abas.
	Closure:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the
	exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of
	the village.
	(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from
	accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya
	area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.
BETHLEHEM	• Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi
	Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to
	Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al

	• Checkpoints: At 11:00, Israeli forces increased restrictions at the container
	checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.
	• Flying Checkpoint: At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nashash
	junction and temporarily detained Rabi'e Shamron, releasing him at a later time
	Wall Construction: Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town.
	• <u>Closure</u> :
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq
	Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition
	to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues
	to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables
	market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
	(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the
	Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall
	construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them
	access to the area.
	• Closure of Main Roads:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-
	Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil
	villages.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling
	along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
	(iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as

- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village.
