JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:40, Israeli forces positioned at the North Ram Junction checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 19:50, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Suwana neighbourhood and Jabal Al-Mukabir fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 22:20, Israeli forces positioned in Abu Dis and Al-Eizariya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned in Shu’fat neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and injured Saed Yadmour. (v) At 23:15, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Sa’aydeh neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 15:30, a group of Israeli settlers assaulted the child Ihda’ Nur (13 years old) {A resident of Kafar Aqab} leaving her hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Detention:</u> At 23:30, Israeli forces detained three residents: Musa Abu Ghanam,

(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:20, Israeli forces set up two checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Qadis village and in the area between Ni’lin and Kharbathat Bani Harith village until 17:20. (ii) At 18:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atarah Bridge until 19:20. (iii) At 07:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Abu Mash’al village. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:35, Israeli forces raided Beit Rima, stormed several homes summoned two residents: Adham Al-Barghouthi and Marwan Rahmiya to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 01:00. (ii) At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Awarta and summoned Sadam Al-Barghouthi to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:10. (iii) At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Deir Ghassaneh until 01:20. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:10, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Deir Abu Mash’al fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 17:15, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Sinjil fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Basel Odeh (17 years old) leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 04:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed agricultural land in Khirbeit Abu Falah, set fire to a home owned by Abdel-Karim Hamayel with 3 women inside the home as well as spray-painting racist graffiti on the walls.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Qabatiya until 03:20.
<p>TUBAS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> At 03:15 on November 22nd 2014, Israeli forces detained Ammar Odeh during their arid into Tamoun as mentioned in the previous report. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 13:00, Israeli settlers positioned near the north Jordan valley assaulted Hillal Darghmeh (A resident of Ein Al-Hilweh) as the temporarily

	detained; him then released him at 14:40.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 14:30 and again at 18:45, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 22:00.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Wadi Awayda area in North Jayyus. (ii) At 19:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint the east entrance of Qalqiliya. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in West Jayyus fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned near “Ayal” crossing located on the Green Line in North Qalqiliya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 07:05, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwarah checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sarah village. (ii) At 06:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Assirah Al-Shimaliya junction and impeded the free flow of traffic.

SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 18:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Deir Istiya with dirt mounds. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Kafil Harris until 15:00. (ii) At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Kafil Harris and Harris until 17:05. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya until 01:15.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 09:25, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:55, Israeli force set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-New’meh village in North Jericho until 21:00. • <u>Detention:</u> At 20:20, Israeli forces positioned near “Maswa”: settlement detained 6 residents: Muhanad Abu Hillal, Saher Mir’I, Hamad Bani Thiyab, Mahmoud Bani Thiyab, Mohamad Bani Thiyab and Mo’ayad Thiyab. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 19:30, Israeli settlers positioned near Ein Dweik village and stormed Ein Dweik Al-Foqa village then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces at 20:30.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’mān village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu’mān: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near “Ifrat” settlement

HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada’ Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron’s Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
