JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On November 22nd 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On November 16th 2015, Israeli forces closed the south entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem, which leads to “Armon Hantsiv” settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Biddu village then searched vehicles and residents. (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jib village then searched residents and vehicles. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and stormed a home. (ii) At 18:00 and again at 07:45, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and detained two residents including a child. (iii) At 05:30, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp, stormed and searched a home and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on November 22nd 2015, Israeli forces detained two residents: Obada Dandis and Loia Dandis in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood in Jerusalem.

(iii) Israeli forces detained Thaer Ibrahim Al-Jamouzi in Qalandiya camp. • <u>Killing:</u> At 10:25, Shadi Mohammad Mahmoud Khasib (31 years old) {A resident of Awarta in Ramallah} after Israeli forces opened fire towards him near Al-Khan Al-Ahmar area as he was driving his Taxi cab from Jericho to Ramallah {for allegedly attempting to stab a Israeli settler {As alleged by the Israeli Military}}. • <u>Attack:</u> At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Anata fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 10:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near “Bet El” settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) On November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Silwad and Ein Yabroud. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 07:05 on November 22nd 2015, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Illu then searched residents and vehicles. (ii) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Ammar village then searched residents and vehicles. (iii) At 15:05, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Um Saffa village then searched residents and vehicles until 15:30. (iv) At 16:50, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village then searched residents and vehicles. (v) At 16:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Surda village and Al-Jalazoun camp then searched residents and vehicles. (vi) At 20:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atarah bridge in Bir Ziet then searched residents and vehicles .until 22:20. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:30 on November 22nd 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Rima and summoned Tariq Abdallah Atiya to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Jalazoun camp, detained 3 residents then withdrew at 03:25. (iii) At 05:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city stormed and searched a home, assaulted Fadi Hussien Shehadeh Assi and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions then withdrew at 07:30. (iv) At dawn on November 23rd 2015, Israeli forces raided Deir Nathim village, stormed two homes, detained two residents and temporarily detained the child Jaber Ahmad Mazaher (15 years old) then released him after assaulting him. • <u>Detention:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Shafiq Ibrahim Al-Masri, Shadi Hassan Sa'adat Safi, and Anas Hassan Nakhlah. (ii) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Ibrahim Ahmad Mizher (13 years old) and Moath Ahmad Al-Khatib (15 years old). • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:40, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 15:15, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near "Bet El" settlement in North Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (who were protesting against the continued Israeli Military and Settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound) for alleged stoning. (iii) At 17:05, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Janiya village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned near "Pesagout" settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 07:00 on November 22nd 2015, Israeli forces set up two checkpoints at Kafriya village junction and Al-Taram village entrance then searched residents and vehicles until 12:50. (ii) On the evening of November 22nd 2015, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ya'bad and impeded the free flow of traffic then fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) On the evening of November 22nd 2015, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Turat village then searched residents and vehicles. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Al-Thaghra area located in east Tiubas then searched residents and vehicles until 12:20. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> At 06:00, Israeli forces forcibly removed several families from their homes in Humsa Al-Foqa village located in the North Jordan valley in Tubas from 06:00 until 24:00 on November 23rd 2015 in order to conduct military training in the area.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 08:50, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 09:45. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Shufa village then searched residents and vehicles until 09:10.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.

	<p>(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds</p> <p>(iv) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel Gate</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:35, Israeli forces raided Azzun, closed the entrance of town, detained three residents and temporarily detained two residents including a child: Anas Ghalib Odwan (13 years old) and Ayman Nathim Abu Haniya then released them later and confiscated a vehicle owned by Ayman Abu Nathim then withdrew at 23:00. (ii) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, detained a child then withdrew at 04:30. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Sa'id Ziyad Abu Haniya, Arkan Ghalib Mohammad Msh'al and Baha Haytham Adwan in Azzun. (ii) Israeli forces detained Abdallah Suliman Mahmoud Qur'an (17 years old) in Qalqiliya. • <u>Attack:</u> At 12:10, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in West Qalqiliya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Mohammad Khaldoun Radwan (15 years old) leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned near "Ama No'el" settlement temporarily detained Jihad Awad Mahmoud Samara (A resident of Baqat Al-Hatab village) then released him later. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) At 22:00 on October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta village with dirt mounds. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.
