JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli army continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 01:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Ram junction. • <u>Raid:</u> On November 23rd 2013, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya, stormed a home and summoned the child Mohammad Mansour (16 years old) to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma ’ale Adumim for Sabbath Holiday.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:35, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints at the entrance of Turmus'ayya and between Turmus'ayya and Khirbit Abu Falah village. (ii) At 08:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atara bridge. (iii) At 15:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Taybeh located along the road connecting Ramallah and Jericho. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh, temporarily detained Nida Al-Bitar as they stormed and searched 2 homes and a sewing shop which resulted in damaging several pieces of furniture owned by Osama Al-Bitar then withdrew at 06:00. (ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Qubar village. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 12:30, Israeli settlers positioned at "Bet El" settlement junction stoned several vehicles passing near the main road at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp during which Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they attempted to prevent the settler attack and as a result injured 6 residents including 2 children: Yusuf Al-Khali (12 years old), Jamal Najla (14 years old), Fadi Qaddum, Khadr Masaleh, Alaa Al-Amouri and Islam Hussien. Israeli forces also detained 2 residents and assaulted the child Wajih Shiekha (14 years old) as they temporarily detained then released them at a later time. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Hamza Jamil and Fadi Abu Sharafa in Al-Jalazoun camp. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages for Sabbath holiday.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:35 on November 23rd 2013, Israeli forces raided Silat Al-Thaher, clashed with several residents as they stormed 2 homes and summoned 2 residents: Maher Atiya and Bakr Maloul to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Jenin and its camps, stormed several homes, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 05:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Ahmad Abu Ziena and Tawfiq Jarbou' in Jenin. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Detention:</u> At 18:55, Israeli forces positioned "Eniv" checkpoint detained 3 residents: Zaki Aliyan, Nihad Salim and Jihad Saleem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted

	<p>special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.</p>
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Izbit Al-Tabib village. • <u>Detention:</u> At 01:45 on November 11th 2013, Israeli forces detained Adib Al-Ghalban , a resident of Qalqiliya. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 13:00, a demonstration took place at the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib village protesting against land confiscations for the purpose of settlement expansion. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u>Wall construction was halted in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement for Sabbath holiday.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) Israeli military continue to close the south entrance of Qaryut village with earth mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Qusin village junction. (ii) At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Nablus and Assira Al-Shimaliya. • <u>Raid:</u> At 14:25, Israeli forces raided Tel village until 15:00. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:05, Israeli settlers stormed Burin under the protection of Israeli forces that fired tear gas grenades towards several residents as they attempted to prevent the settler attack. (ii) At 20:10, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over Mohammad Hamad (74 years old), resident of Bal’a near Huwara leaving him hospitalised with contusions.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city

	<p>to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.</p> <p>(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement for Sabbath holiday.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 16:00 Israeli forces closed Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District until 22:00. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fasayil village junction until 20:30.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Since 14:00 on October 18th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Surif and Al-Jab'a village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Khadr until 20:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:50 on November 23rd 2013, Israeli forces raided Al-Ubidiya and summoned Mohammad Al-Asa to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Taqou', stormed a home and summoned Amr Al-Badan to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:45.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:55, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 14:55, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Taqou' assaulted the child: Suliman Al-Amour (17 years old) leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction halted in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks. (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Hebron. (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Wadi Qabbun area located in North Hebron. (iii) At 11:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Wadi Risha area in Ithna. (iv) At 11:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Farsh Al-Hawa area located in North Hebron. (v) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge. (vi) At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Urub camp. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:25, Israeli forces raided Hebron. (ii) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar and detained 3 residents.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Muntassir Awad, Nur and Washah and Ibrahim Al-Adam in Beit Ummar. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned the wall gate near Al-Ramadin village assaulted 2 residents: Ahmad Al-Alama and Adham Al-Alama leaving them hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 09:10, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Khirbeit Um Al-Aris village located in south Yatta and assaulted 4 residents: Ahmad Awad, Mohammad Awad, Khalid Awad and Samir Awad during which Israeli forces temporarily detained 5 residents including a child: Samira Awad 915 years old), Fida Awad (13 years old), Sa'id Awad, Mohammad Awad and Hamdan Awad then released them after questioning by Israeli intelligence officers. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town for Sabbath holiday.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Rafah. • Palestinian gunmen broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire and launched projectiles towards the Green Line.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed. • <u>Injury:</u> the names of 2 previously unidentified residents who were injured in Jabaliya are Mohammad Afana and Ismail Aloush as mentioned in the previous report.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
CENTRAL GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> On the evening of November 23rd 2013, Israeli forces detained 3 unidentified residents as they were crossing the border fence into Israel.

RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u>• Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed.• Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed.• Sufa Crossing is closed.• Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.• <u>Palestinian Attack:</u> On the evening of November 22nd 2013, Palestinian gunmen launched 2 projectiles the Green Line during which Israeli forces opened fire towards Al-Shweikiya in east Rafah.
