<b>JERUSALEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On 27 November 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> <li>(iii) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks.</li> <li>(iv) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the 4 entrances of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood with cement blocks.</li> <li>(v) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the three entrances of Sur Bahar with Cement blocks.</li> <li>(vi) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za’im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks.</li> <li>(vii) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Wadi Al-Rabaybeh area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.</li> <li>(ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On 23 November 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Anan village and handed over notifications to two brothers requiring them to report to the military intelligence. The brothers are: Baha’ Ali Rabee’ and Mohammad Ali Rabee’.</li> <li>(ii) On 23 November 2015, Israeli forces raided the village of Qatanna and arrested two brothers. At 23:00, Israeli forces raided the village a second time and clashed with civilians during a raid on a martyr’s home: Ahmad Jamal Taha who was killed in Beit Ur Tahta. One civilian was injured during clashes: Ismail Khatib who was taken to hospital.</li> <li>(iii) At 15:00, Israeli forces raided the town of Beir Nibala and arrested 3 civilians.</li> <li>(iv) At 22:00, Israeli forces raided the town of Izariyye and clashed with civilians during patrol.</li> <li>(v) At 22:20, Israeli forces raided the main road near Qalandia refugee camp (under the pretext of unknown shooting at the checkpoint), fired illuminating cartridges and combed the area.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Killings:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 11:30, a girl called Hadil Wajeeh Awwad, 16 was killed and another called</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

Israel soldiers opened fire at the girls under the pretext of allegedly attempting to stab a settler (according to Israeli claims).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Arrests:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 16:00, Israeli forces arrested a civilian called Mohammad Majid Hawarin from the town of Izariyye.</li> <li>(ii) At 17:05, Israeli forces arrested on the road to Jericho a civilian called Karim Shajaiyye from Dier Jarir.</li> <li>(iii) The two civilians arrested in Qatanna are Joudeh Jamal Houshiyye and Ahmad Said Houshiyye.</li> <li>(iv) The three civilians arrested in the town of Beir Nibala are: Mohammad Zakaria Hamdan, Fathi Zakaria Hamdan and Malik Mohammad Kuhle.</li> <li>(v) The girl arrested after serious injury in Jerusalem is Nourhan Ibrahim Awwad, 15, from Qalandia refugee camp.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Attacks:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Mukabber neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired live and rubber coated bullets and stun and tear gas grenades towards civilians for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(ii) At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Qalandiya checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(iii) At 16:05, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of the town of Issawiyye in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(iv) At 16:35, Israeli forces commissioned with guarding the Separation Wall near the village of Qatanna fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(v) At 16:40, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Ram fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(vi) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandia checkpoint fired live and rubber coated bullets and stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Attacks on Places of Worship:</u></b> At 09:00, Israeli settlers backed up by Israeli forces stormed in Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in Jerusalem and provoked civilians.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 14:20, an Israeli settler stabbed a civilian in Jerusalem called Youssef Harbi Saleh Hroub from the town of Dura in Hebron and caused him serious injury.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

In addition, Israeli forces set up camp in front of the house and withdrew at 13:00.</li> <li>(ii) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Jalazon refugee camp, clashed with residents during a house raid, arrested 1 civilian and withdrew at 04:00.</li> <li>(iii) On 24 November 2015, Israeli forces raided the village of Deir Nizam, searched homes and clashed with civilians.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Attacks:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 13:50, Israel forces positioned at Al-Mahkameh checkpoint near Bet El settlement north of Al-Bireh city fired metal and rubber coated bullets and tear gas canisters at civilians for alleged stoning in protest of Israeli settlers' attacks on Al-Aqsa Mosque.</li> <li>(ii) At 15:10, Israel forces positioned at the entrance of Pisgot settlement east of Al-Bireh city fired stun grenades and tear gas canisters at civilians for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(iii) At 15:40, Israeli forces near the village of Mugheir fired live and rubber coated bullets, stun grenades and tear gas canisters at civilians for alleged stoning injuring three civilians: Abdel Nasser Rohi Naasan, Iyad Khalid Naasan, and Iyad Ali Naasan, and arrested 1 civilian.</li> <li>(iv) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Jalazon refugee camp fired rubber coated bullets, stun grenades and tear gas canisters at civilians for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(v) At 16:05, Israeli forces near the gas station on bypass road 443 near the village of Beit Ur opened fire toward 1 civilian and killed him for alleged stabbing of a settler and injuring a soldier (according to Israeli claims).
