JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Activity not yet reported.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, the Israeli army entered the city of Ramallah, where it raided and surrounded a building located in the center. The army fired live ammunition at several targets, and arrested one civilian. (ii) At 17:00, the Israeli army, along with 7 military jeeps, raided the town of Beit Rima. The army surrounded and then searched a house and arrested one individual. (iii) At 00:30, the Israeli army, along with a bulldozer, raided the refugee camp of Al-Jalazoun. The army surrounded one house, the owner of which is currently in an Israeli jail. The purpose of the raid was to demolish the house. This led to a confrontation between the civilians in the area and the army. The civilians moved inside the house to prevent its demolition. The Israeli army withdrew. • <u>Arrests:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Radwan Badran, from the Al-'Am'aree refugee camp; and (ii) Hazem Taher Al-Khatib, from the town of Rima.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Tubas, searched several civilian homes and arrested 3 brothers. (ii) At 02:30, the Israeli army entered the city of Jenin, and raided the eastern section and remained there for two hours. The army searched several houses, and arrested 2 civilians. • <u>Arrests:</u> The Israeli army arrested the following civilians: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Mohammed Daraghma, from Tubas; (ii) Rashid Daraghma, from Tubas; (iii) Ahmad Daraghma, from Tubas; (iv) Mohammed Ghaleb Al-Sa'adi, from Jenin City; and (v) Arafat Sleiman Al-Sa'adi, from Jenin City.

JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Activity not yet reported.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure</u>: Despite Israeli claims that closure over the District had been removed, all major entry/exit points are closed. • <u>Raid</u>: At 00:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Beit Fajjar, where it surrounded a house and arrested one civilian, • <u>Arrest</u>: The Israeli army arrested Abeer Thawabteh.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint</u>: At 01:30, the Israeli army placed several flying checkpoints along Route 57, including at the junctions of Iktaba and Bala' and at the entrance of the refugee camp of Nour Shams. All civilian vehicles were stopped and searched, identification checked and traffic severely disrupted. • <u>Attack</u>: The Israeli army deployed near the entrance of Nour Shams refugee camp, where it intimidated Palestinian traffic. Israeli provocation led to a confrontation between the army and the civilians in the area. The army used live ammunition, rubber bullets and tear gas against the crowd. No reported injuries. • <u>Raid</u>: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, the Israeli army entered the eastern parts of the District, where it surrounded and a raided a civilian property to arrest an individual. (ii) At 02:00, the Israeli again raided the eastern parts of the District and fired sound grenades. No reported injuries. (iii) At 03:00, several Israeli jeeps raided the city center and residential neighborhoods in the vicinity. The army withdrew at 07:00. • <u>Demonstration</u>: At 19:00, a civilian demonstration took place in the village of Seida. The demonstration was against Israeli occupation, construction of the wall and illegal settlement activities.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure</u>: The city remains a closed military area. • <u>Detention</u>: At 19:00, the Israeli forces detained a civilian, Abd-Salam Hamadneh, 30 years. She was later released three hours later.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Activity not yet reported.
QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Activity not yet reported.

SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure</u>: At 08:00, the Israeli army imposed a closure on Salfit. It only allowed cement trucks to enter in order to continue building the City Hospital. The Israeli closure policy on the city remains in effect.
