(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikse villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikse village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Raids:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Hanina, demolished a residential barracks, stormed a home and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on November 25th 2011, Israeli forces detained Basem Idreas, a school boy in Jerusalem. (ii) At dawn on November 25th 2011, Israeli forces detained Abdel Rahman Eweis in Jerusalem. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu |

At 14:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Al-Sudan village, searching civilians and vehicles. At 15:40, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Beit Ur Al-Fauqa, searching civilians and vehicles. At 18:20 Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Atara, searching civilians and vehicles. • Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Um Saffa village, stormed a car repair shop and car wash belonging to Mohammad Al-Sbeity, for allegedly not having proper licensing. At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Taybeh. • Settler Violence: At 13:55, an Israeli settler ran over Mohammad Daraghma (16 years old) and Nassar Daraghma with his vehicle, leaving them with broken bones and severely injuries. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages. |

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i>, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying checkpoints: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Jit village junction, searching civilians and vehicles. (ii) At10:45 and again at 19:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Qalqilya. (iii) At 14:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Al-Nabi Elyas and Izbet Al-Tabib. (iv) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrances of Azzun and Izbet Al-Tabib, prevented residents from passing through as they surveyed the area, alleging that a Molotov cocktail was thrown at a settler bus as it passed through the Qalqilya–Nablus road. • Raid: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:25, Israeli forces raided Ras Atiya village. (ii) At 19:50, Israeli forces raided Azzoun and Izbet Al-Tabib and took up position in front of the Palestinian national security headquarters. • Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras 'Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement. |

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 <i>dunums</i> of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 10:45 Israeli army continues to restrict access at the "Container" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic and at 22:55, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint and denied entry of residents and reopened it at a later time. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Dar Salah, east of Beit Sahour. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Taqou, searching civilians and vehicles (iii) At 14:00 and again at 20:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Al-Nashash junction (at the northern entrance of Bethlehem), searching civilians and vehicles. (iv) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Hija village, temporarily detained 4 residents and released them at 18:00 after security coordination intervened. |

(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village (v) Since 15. 10. 2011, Israeli forces closed two entrances leading to Beit Ummar town. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance of Hebron City, searching civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Deir Samet junction. (iii) At 07:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Halhoul Bridge. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Bass area in Ithna, demolished a home owned by Ahmad Al-Jiyawi in addition to a room housing an electricity generator and 2 agricultural storage rooms owned by Haitham Al-Jiyawi. Israeli forces also destroyed 3 irrigation canals and a fence surrounding a plot of land owned by Ahmad Al-Jiyawi, Abdel Rahman Farjallah and Ahmad Farjallah for allegedly being built without proper licensing; properties are in Area C (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Yatta, demolished 3 barracks, a cave and a room used for housing, owned by Mohammad Hamamda, Hatem Hamamda and Maher Hamamda. Forces also demolished a mosque, a clinic, a number of barns and several water collection wells for allegedly being built without proper licensing. The demolished properties are located in Area C. Israeli forces also detained two residents and assaulted Halima Hamamda when she attempted to stop the demolition; Halima was later hospitalized. . (iii) At 11:05, Israeli forces raided Susia, demolished a home and a barn belonging to Mohamad Mughnem for allegedly being built without proper licensing; properties are located in area C.,.
