- (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and, 02:00
- (ii) At 'Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00, and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint.

• Flying checkpoints:

- (i) At 08:00 and again at 22:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Sarrah junction.
- (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Al Maslakh area junction (the entrance leading to east Nablus), searching civilians and vehicles.
- (iii) At 16:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Wadala village junction, searching civilians and vehicles.
- (iv) At 23:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Deir Sharaf junction, searching civilians and vehicles.

• Raids:

- (i) At 02:35 on November 24th 2011, Israeli forces raided Ein Beit Al-Ma refugee camp in Nablus and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 12:25, Israeli forces raided Madma village.
- (iii) At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Azmout village.
- (iv) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Asira Al-Shamaliya and detained a resident.
- (v) At dawn on November 25th 2011, Israeli forces raided Beit Fourik, searched a home and detained a civilian.

(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.

- (ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic.

	checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic and at 22:55, Israeli forces closed
	the checkpoint and denied entry of residents and reopened it at a later time.

Wall Construction: Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town. **Closure:** The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq (i) Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the (ii) Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-(i) Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as (iii) detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village Since 15. 10. 2011, Israeli forces closed two entrances leading to Beit Ummar (v) town. **Flying Checkpoints:** (i) At 08:45. Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance of Hebron City, searching civilians and vehicles. At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Deir Samet junction. (ii) (iii) At 07:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Halhoul Bridge. Raids: (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Bass area in Ithna, demolished a home owned by Ahmad Al-Jiyawi in addition to a room housing an electricity generator and 2 agricultural storage rooms owned by Haitham Al-Jiyawi. Hebron Israeli forces also destroyed 3 irrigation ells and a fence surround a plot of land owned by Ahmad Al-Jiyawi, Abdel Rahman Farjallah and Ahmad Farjallah for allegedly being built without proper licensing; properties are in Area C (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Yatta, demolished 3 barracks, a cave and a room used for housing, owned by Mohammad Hamamda, Hatem Hamamda and Maher Hamamda. Forces also demolished a mosque, a clinic, a number of barns and several water collection wells for allegedly being built without proper licensing. The demolished properties are located in Area C. Israeli forces also detained two residents and assaulted Halima Hamamda when she attempted to stop the demolition; Halima was later hospitalized. . (iii) At 11:05, Israeli forces raided Susia, demolished a home and a barn belonging to Mohamad Mughnem for allegedly being built without proper licensing; properties are located in area C.,.

At 15:50, Israeli forces raided Hebron City.

At 21:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahria.

At 21:30, Israeli forces raided Kurza and fired stun grenades.

- <u>Injury:</u> At 02:50, Wajdi Al-Sharif sustained injuries in his left hand after being shot by Israeli police who pursued him while he was inside Israel.

- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.
