WEST BANK **Closure:** The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at (i) the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and denied citizens younger than 40 years old from entering the the Old City for Friday prayers. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a (iii) hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating (ii) the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (iii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint. **Checkpoints:** (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border **JERUSALEM** crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. **Detention:** On November 24th 2012, Israeli forces detained Amar Al-Thalji in the old city of Jerusalem. **Settler Violence:** At dawn on November 25th 2012, Israeli settlers damaged 8 vehicles and spray painted "price tag" on 8 vehicles in Shu'fat camp in Jerusalem. • Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate (ii) on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sleavawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. Wall Construction: Wall construction was halted in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim for Sabbath holiday.. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. Flying Checkpoint: At 01:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Bir Ziet RAMALLAH & University junction. **AL BIREH Raid:** At 20:45, Israeli forces raided Beit Liqua.

• <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 16:20, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Al-Mazra'a Al-Gharbiya during which several residents attempted to prevent the settler attack.

| | • Wall Construction: Wall construction was halted in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages for Sabbath holiday. |

| JENIN | Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. Flying Checkpoint: (i) At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ajja village. (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Ya'bad and Zabda village. (iii) At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Rumana village. (iv) At 21:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Qad junction. Raid: (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Maythaloun. (ii) At 08:20, Israeli forces raided Jenin, clashed with several students from the American University of Jenin then withdrew at 12:00. |

| TUBAS | Checkpoints: the Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. |
| TULKAREM | Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. Checkpoints: The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. Flying Checkpoint: At 21:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Quffin village. Wall Gates: Land leveling for adjustment of the Wall route was halted in the area surrounding Jubara village for Sabbath holiday. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route is to be constructed west of the village. |
| QALQILIYA | Closure of Roads: Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. Flying Checkpoint: At 18:00, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints at the north and eastern entrances of Azzun. At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Laqif village. At 20:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction. |
| | (iv) At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Immatin village junction. Raid: At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Amin village. Wall Gates: |

| | (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction was halted in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement for Sabbath holiday. |

| | Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and |
| NABLUS | Qaryut. Raid: At dawn on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces raided Jama'in and detained 5 residents. At 16:00 and again at 02:30, Israeli forces raided Orif village, fired tear gas grenades towards residents. Detention: Israeli forces detained Mustafa Hundiya(16 years old), Hamza Awad (16 years old), Bassam Awad, Mohammad Ghazi and Majd Ali in Jama'in village. Settler Violence: At 14:50, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Qasra village, demolished walls surrounding the land and opened fire towards several residents while terrorizing them then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces. |
| SALFIT | Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and QatanAl-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. Checkpoints: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. Flying Checkpoint: At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the bypass road near Kafr Al-Dik until 19:40. At 19:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Ballut. Raid: At 19:45, Israeli forces raided Deir Ballut. At 22:25, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya. Detention: At 12:10, Israeli forces positioned at Zatara checkpoint detained Mu'in Dibayat, a National Security officer from Tubas. Temporary Detention: At 12:15, Israeli forces positioned at Zatara checkpoint temporarily detained 5 National Security officers and released them at a later |

The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as (iii) detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to (iv) the entrance to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. On July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat (v) and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. Raid: (i) At 09:00 and again at 03:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya, stormed a home and detained 3 residents. (ii) At 09:55 and again at 02:40, Israeli forces raided Yatta, stormed a home, summoned Othma Abu Aram to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning and detained a resident. (iii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron. (iv) At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Dura and detained a resident. **Detentions:** (i) Israeli forces detained Shaqir Shanur, Issa Samara and Diya Samara in Al-Thahriya. (ii) Israeli forces detained Issa Zien in Yatta. (iii) Israeli force detained Ahmad Amro in Dura. Wall Construction: Wall construction was halted in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town for Sabbath
