(ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Al-Murasha'hat area located in West Jericho. (iii) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Oja village until 21:45.

(ii) Israeli forces detained Yusef Hassasneh (17 years old) in Al-Ubeidiya. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:15, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction has continued in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
