WEST BANK**JERUSALEM**

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city for the alleged stabbing of an Israeli settler.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikse villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikse village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
 - (iii) At 16:20, Israeli forces closed Jaba’ checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and impeded the free flow of traffic then reopened it later.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram, stormed and searched the Headquarters of the Palestinian Football Association then 10:20.
 - (ii) At 22:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya, stormed and searched a home, summoned Ragheb Jabr to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 23:20.
 - (iii) At dawn on November 25th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya, stormed and searched several homes and detained two residents.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At dawn on November 24th 2014, Israeli forces detained Ehab Al-Adrah after storming and searching his home in Al-Tur neighbourhood.
 - (ii) At dawn on November 24th 2014, Israeli forces detained Hassan Halfawi after storming his home in Jerusalem.
 - (iii) At dawn on November 24th 2014, Israeli forces detained Omar Hijazi in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood (As mentioned in the previous report).
 - (iv) At dawn on November 24th 2014, Israeli forces detained Wael Al-Rajabi after storming his home in Silwan neighbourhood.
 - (v) At 20:00, Israeli forces detained two residents: Husam Al-Alami and Abboud Al-Haddad in the old city of Jerusalem.
 - (vi) At 20:30, Israeli forces detained Nasser Al-Shawish (A resident of Jerusalem) for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli settler near Al-Khalil

	<p>gate in the old city of Jerusalem.</p> <p>(vii) At dawn on November 25th 2014, Israeli forces detained two residents Adnan Ghayth and Sadiq Ghayth after storming their home in Silwan neighbourhood.</p> <p>(viii) Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Zidan and Yunis Aliyan in Al-Eisawiya village.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan neighbourhood temporarily detained Rashid Abu Sarah (10 years old) and released him later. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces positioned near the North Junction of Al-Ram fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 20:20, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 23:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Quds University in Abu Dis fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the evening of November 24th 2014, Israeli settlers positioned near “the French Hill” settlement in Jerusalem assaulted Mohammad Obied as he was travelling to his home in Al-Eisawiya. (ii) On the evening of November 24th 2014, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over the child: Khalil Al-Kiswani (14 years old) near Al-Rumima area in west Jerusalem and as a result left him hospitalised with a broken arm and contusions. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 17:15. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: At 18:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic until 19:30. • Flying Checkpoint: At 23:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Qarwat Bani Hasssan until 03:00.

(iii) At 21:20, Israeli forces raided Husan village and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Fadil Shakarnah in Husan village. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 21:35, Israeli settlers positioned near a bypass road in Nihalin village stoned residents and vehicles.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.

Detainees update

- On November 24th 2014, The Palestinian Minister of Detainees and Ex-Detainees affairs confirmed that the Israeli Prison authorities in Rimon prison assaulted several detainees and as a result injured six including two critically injured: Issah Jabarin and Adel Al-Nashash leaving them hospitalized in critical condition.
