JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On November 24<sup>th</sup> 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> <li>(iii) On November 16<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the south entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem, which leads to “Armon Hantsiv” settlement with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.</li> <li>(ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At dawn on November 24<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Duquq village and detained 2 residents.</li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 10:05, Israeli forces detained Yusef Ribhi Al-Rajabi (A resident of Bab Hata area in the old the old city of Jerusalem) for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli settler (as alleged by the Israeli Military).</li> <li>(ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces detained Abdallah Eid Abu Ghaliya (A resident of Al-Eizariya.</li> <li>(iii) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Nizar Arkama Fadel Rayan and Amin Nash’at Rayan in Beit Duquq.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Qutna village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Jabal area junction in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(iii) At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Al-Tur neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u></b> At 10:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<b>TULKAREM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Shweikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 19:00.</li> <li>(ii) At 03:05, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem until 04:10.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> At 09:30, Israeli forces positioned near “Ghishori” factory Industrial zone located in West Tulkarem fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (who were protesting against the continued Israeli Military and Settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound) for alleged stoning and as a result injured 12 residents including 2 children: Anwar Abdel-Latif Darwish Farahnah(17 years old), Ihsan Abdallah Saleem Al-Da’mah (15 years old), Mus’ab Mohammad Sa’adeh, Mohammad Waleed Sabah, Ahmad Nasser Daraghme, Abdallah Mohammad Rabah Badeer, Mohammad Hashim Rajah Amr, Jafar Sameer Abu Safaqa and Jafar Abdel-Rahman Mohammad Al-Jitawi as well as leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation and then several Green House were set on fire after tear gas grenade canisters fired by Israeli forces exploded in the area during which Palestinian Civil Defence forces were able to extinguish the flames.</li> </ul>

  - (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Nasser Marzouq in Irtas village.
- **Temporary Detention:**
  - (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Taqou' temporarily detained Yassin Ali Hamidat Al-Bathan (10 years old) {A resident of Taqou' } then released him at 17:15.
  - (ii) At 19:20, Israeli forces positioned near Betar village temporarily detained Loai Munir Mohammad Jadallah (A RESIDENT OF Al-Duhisheh camp in Bethlehem) then released him after summoning him to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- **Attack:**
  - (i) At 10:25, Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque in North Bethlehem and near Al-Ayda, camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
  - (ii) At 20:45, Israeli forces positioned near Harmalah village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

**HEBRON**

- **Closure:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) At 05:50 on November 5<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading Farsh Al-Hawa area in Hebron with Cement blocks.
- (vi) At 10:30 on November 8<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the junction located near "Hagi" settlement located in south Hebron with cement blocks.
- (vii) At 21:00 on November 11<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Beit Awwa and Al-Majd village with cement block and dirt mounds.
- (viii) At 15:45 on November 15<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Samiya village junction located at the west entrance of Al-Samou' with cement blocks.
- (ix) On November 15<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances of Khliat Al-Miya and Al Dirat and the two bypass roads leading east Yatta with cement blocks.
- (x) Since 14:00 on November 20<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Yatta.
- (xi) Since 15:00 on November 20<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the north entrance of Al-Thahriya.
- (xii) Since 14:00 on November 20<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances of Obada, Beit Marah, Deir Al-Asal , Deir Razeh and Qurma villages with dirt mounds.
- (xiii) Since 15:10 on November 21<sup>st</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Beit Ummar.
- (xiv) Since 19:25 on November 21<sup>st</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Aroub camp with cement blocks.
- (xv) At 13:40, Israeli forces closed the entrance to Bani Na'im with dirt mounds.\
- (xvi) At 13:30 on November 23<sup>rd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Karama village located near "Anatil" settlement with cement blocks.
- (xvii) At 14:10 on November 23<sup>rd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-



Qom village located in North Beit Awwa with cement blocks.

- **Flying Checkpoint:**

- (i) At 07:50 on November 24<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Tuwani village located in east Yatta then searched residents and vehicles.
- (ii) At 08:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna then searched residents and vehicles.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At dawn on November 25<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Korisat village and stormed 2 homes.
- (ii) At dawn on November 25<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar and detained 2 children.
- (iii) At dawn on November 25<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Thorat area in Halhoul and detained a child.
- (iv) At dawn on November 25<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Awwa and detained 3 residents including a child.
- (v) At dawn on November 25<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Sa'ir village and detained a resident.
- (vi) At dawn on November 25<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Shiyoukh village and detained a resident.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 11:35 and again at 23:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Aroub camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 14:10, Israeli forces positioned in Beit Ummar fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) On the evening of November 24<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Fuwar camp junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- **Detention:**

- (i) At dawn on November 25<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Kasarat area in the old city of Hebron detained Nafith Mohammad Al-Huhtasib after storming his home
- (ii) Israeli forces detained two children: Mohammad Kassab Abu Daya (16 years old) and Jamal Hussien Adi (16 years old) in Beit Ummar.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Hamza Yusef Mohammad Za'amra (17 years old) in Al-Thorat area in Halhoul.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Mohammad Yasser Yusef Masalmeh (17 years old), Hamdi Qassim Yusef Masalmeh and Qusay Sami Shalash in Beit Awwa.
- (v) Israeli forces detained Hamza Yusef Shaladat in Sa'ir.
- (vi) Israeli forces detained Tamer Ja'far Ibrahim Awidat in Al-Shiyoukh.
- (vii) Israeli forces detained the child Khatab Waheed Abu Mariya (12 years old) near the entrance of Beit Ummar.

- **Temporary Detention:** On November 24<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque compound in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Judi Al-Tamimi (A journalist) then released her at a later time.

- **Settler Violence:** At 16:40, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque compound in the old city of Hebron assaulted several residents.
