• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city for the alleged stabbing of an Israeli settler.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- (iii) At 15:20, Israeli forces closed Jaba' checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and impeded the free flow of traffic.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 11:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Adumin settlement located at the east entrance of Al-Eizariya and detained two residents.
- (ii) At 11:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Khan Al-Ahmar area (located along the main road connecting Jerusalem and Jericho) until 12:50.

• <u>Detention:</u>

- (i) At 22:00 on November 24th 2014, Israeli forces detained Fadi Al-Salamiya (A resident of Al-Ram) in Jerusalem.
- (ii) At 03:00 on November 25th 2014, Israeli forces detained two residents: Rushdi Al-Rishq (15 years old) and Bidawi Abu Assab (15 years old) in the old city of Jerusalem.
- (iii) At 11:00, Israeli forces detained Yacoub Al-Rajabi after storming his home in Silwan neighbourhood.
- (iv) At 18:00, Israeli forces detained Amani Abu Al-Hawa after assaulting her and her mother Nadiya Abu Al-Hawa (A special needs patient) after storming their home in Al-Tur neighbourhood.
- (v) At 18:00, Israeli forces detained Hamadah Al-Malazim in the old city of Jerusalem.

JERUSALEM

- (vi) At dawn on November 26th 2014, Israeli forces detained Anas Dabash and Mahdi Atwan in Sur Bahar village.
- (vii)Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint near Adumin settlement located at the east entrance of Al-Eizariya detained two residents: Ibrahim Jafara and Mohammad Jafara (both residents of Abu Dis).

Attack:

- (i) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they stormed a condolence event for the 2 residents: Ghassan Abu Jamal and Oday Abu Jamal {who stabbed and killed 4 Israeli settlers} and as a result left several residents suffocating from tear gas inhalation.
- (ii) At 21:45, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Tur and Silwan neighbourhoods fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured two residents; Jasser Abu Al-Hawa and Ahmad Abu Al-Hawa.

• Expulsion:

- (i) On November 25th 2014, the Israeli military issued orders for the expulsion of three residents including two children: Abdel-Athim Abu Sbieh (17 years old), Mohammad Abu Sneineh (16 years old) and Karam Al-Rimlawi preventing them from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound for a period of 30 days.
- (ii) On November 25th 2014, the Israeli military issued orders for the expulsion of two residents: Dalal Al-Hashlamoun and Lattifah Al-Lattif from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound for a period of 3 months.

• Settler Violence:

- (i) On November 24th 2014, Israeli settlers positioned near Deir Yassin area in Jerusalem assaulted Islam Obied as he was working in the area and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions.
- (ii) At 18:00, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over and injured Majed Aliyan (A resident of Beit Safafa) and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions.
- Assault on Places of Worship: At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshipers.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.
- (iii) At 23:10, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Labban Al-Gharbiya with cement blocks.

• Raid:

- (i) At 02:00 on November 25^{th} 2014, Israeli forces raided Deir Abu Mash'al village and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 02:00 on November 25th 2014, Israeli forces raided Ni'lin, stormed a home and summoned Eyad Sarour to report to Israeli Intelligence for
