JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On November 27th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On 16 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the 4 entrances of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On 19 September 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Hizma village and searched residents and vehicles. (ii) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the junction of Jabaa village and searched civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 05:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Qatanna village and denied civilians access to the village. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:30 on 25 November 2015, Israeli forces raided Anata town and arrested 1 civilian. (ii) At 17:10, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, set up a checkpoint in front of the Palestinian police station and withdrew at 18:10. (iii) At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Qatanna village, clashed with civilians, stormed into civilian homes, killed 1 civilian and withdrew at 08:00. (iv) At 05:20, Israeli forces raided and patrolled Bir Nibala town and Jib village. • <u>Killing:</u> The martyr killed in Qatanna village is Yihya Yusri Taha, 21. • <u>Arrests:</u> The civilian arrested in Anata town is Mustafa Ahmad Mustafa Ibrahim. • <u>Attacks:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Isawiyya entrance fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 16:25 and 06:00, Israeli forces guarding the Separation Wall near Qatanna village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 21:45, Israeli forces positioned at Shufat checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Attacks on Places of Worship:</u> At 11:00, Israeli settlers backed up by Israeli forces stormed into Al-Aqsa Mosque compound and provoked civilians. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(iii) On 5 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Silwad town with Ein Yabroud village. (iv) On 24 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance gate leading to Sinjil and the east entrance of Mughier with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the junction of Ein Sinya village and searched residents and vehicles until 17:15. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 04:30 on 25 November 2015, Israeli forces raided Kadoura refugee camp in Ramallah and arrested 1 civilian. At 03:30 on 26 November 2015, Israeli forces raided the camp a second time and arrested 1 civilian (which makes two civilians arrested). (ii) At dawn on 25 November 2015, Israeli forces raided Budrous village, detained a child Ali Awad Rashid, 16, and released him at a later time. (iii) At dawn on 25 November 2015, Israeli forces raided Kafr Nimeh village and arrested 2 civilians. (iv) At 17:10, Israeli forces raided Beitunia town, clashed with civilians, arrested 1 child. At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Beitunia a second time and arrested 2 civilians (which makes 3 civilians arrested including 1 child). Moreover, Israeli forces delivered notifications to 2 civilians to report to the Israeli military intelligence: Ali Al-Mallah and his son Ahmad, 15. Israeli force withdrew at 03:30. (v) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Kharbatha Misbah village, stormed 1 civilian home and arrested 1 civilian. • <u>Arrests:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:15 on 25 November 2015, Israeli forces arrested two children near the entrance of Abu Mishal village: Abdelrahman Talal Barghouti, 17, and Sanad Walid Abdelrahman Barghouti, 17. (ii) The 2 civilians arrested in Kadoura refugee camp in Ramallah are: Mohammad Abu Abdo and Hassan Nakhleh. (iii) The 2 civilians arrested in Kafr Nimeh village are: Sami Faraj Atiyye and Hassan Yacoub Ataya. (iv) The civilians arrested in Beitunia town are: Ismail Said Nabhan Al-Haddad,

(ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of al-Mahkama checkpoint near Bet El settlement north of Al-Bireh city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 14:05, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Jalazon refugee camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>House Occupation:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:40, Israeli forces occupied a deserted home in Sinjel town (on Ramallah-Nablus main road) owned by Mohammad Said Shabaneh and converted it into a military post. (ii) Since the evening of 25 November 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:10 on 25 November 2015, Israeli forces raided Bourqin town and arrested 1 civilian. (ii) At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Arraba town, stormed into and searched 7 civilian homes, caused damage to the home of Allam Shaer and withdrew at 04:45. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 15:30, Israeli forces intensified restrictions at Einav checkpoint and impeded traffic flow until 16:45. • <u>Raids:</u> At dawn on 25 November 2015, Israeli forces raided Balaa town and arrested one civilian.

QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 10:40 on 1 September 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel Gate • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Qalqilya city, stormed into and searched 2 civilian homes, arrested 2 civilians and withdrew at 04:55. (ii) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Azzun town, stormed into and searched several civilian homes, arrested 1 civilian and detained 2 civilians: Samaha Ahmad Mujahid Radwan and Mohammad Ahmad Mujahid Radwan who were released at a later time. Israeli forces withdrew at 04:30. • <u>Attacks:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:35, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in West Qalqiliya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents including 1 child called Amir Sufyan Kakouni, 17, and Amir Raslan Abu Daoud. (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near the Separation Wall west of Jayyous town fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Arrests:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The 2 civilians arrested in Qalqilya city are: Mohammad Abed Hamid Walweel and Adham Faris Nofal. (ii) The civilian arrested in Azzun is Mahmoud Nidal Ibrahim Salim. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

(ii) Since 11:00 on 30 July 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 09:15, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. Israel forces also bulldozed the bus stop near the checkpoint, put cement blocks in place and installed surveillance cameras on electric posts. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:20, Israeli forces raided Surda village, clashed with civilians and arrested 2 civilians: Hilal Nizam Ali Baddah and Mahmoud Bassam Ali Baddah, but released them at a later time and withdrew at 17:40. (ii) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Zawiye village, stormed into and searched several civilian homes, inflicted damage to home furniture of Sleiman Abdel Karim Shqeir, arrested 1 civilian and withdrew at 03:15. • <u>Arrests:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:15, Israeli forces arrested at the junction of Zaatara checkpoint 1 civilian called Abdel Aziz Abde Karim Al-Safadi from Surif village in Nablus. (ii) The civilian arrested in Zawiye town is Hassan Baker Ali Shqeir. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 13:00, Israeli forces at the junction of Zaatara checkpoint detained 1 civilian called Mohammad Riyad Hussami and released him at 13:30.

(ii) At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Jericho city and delivered a notification to Mohammad Hassan Jalayta to report to the Israeli military intelligence and withdrew at 03:05.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement, the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iv) Since 10:45 on 8 September 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amous" settlement with dirt mounds. (v) Since 15:30 on 20 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinata with dirt mounds. (vi) At 13:10 on 22 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Marah Rabah village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, 16:15 and 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Deir Salah on the eastern entrance to Beit Sahour and searched residents and vehicles until 21:30. (ii) At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the western entrance of Beit Fajjar town and searched civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 09:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the northwest entrance of Beit Jala and impeded traffic flow until 17:10. (iv) At 18:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint on the junction of Harmala village and searched civilians and vehicles until 20:00. (v) At 20:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint on the western entrance of Teqoa town and searched civilians and vehicles until 23:20. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:55, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar and fired stun grenades during a raid on a quarry in Khilet Hijje area, and confiscated a stonecutter belonging to Mohammad Azmi Thawabteh. At 01:20, Israeli forces raided and patrolled the
