JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city for the alleged stabbing of an Israeli settler.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
 - (iii) At 08:00, Israeli forces closed Al-Za’im checkpoint then reopened it later.
 - (iv) At 15:15, Israeli forces closed Jaba’ checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- **Flying Checkpoints:** At 00:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Adumin” settlement located at the east entrance of Al-Eizariya and detained a resident.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 03:00 on November 26th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Jadirah village and detained three residents.
 - (ii) At dawn on November 27th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and detained three residents.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces detained Daniya Al-Mughrabi (A resident of Jabal Al-Mukkabir) as she was attending a court hearing for Amani Abu Al-Hawa in Jerusalem.
 - (ii) At dawn on November 27th 2014, Israeli forces detained Sha’ban Hamad in Shu’fat camp.
 - (iii) Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint near “Adumin” settlement located at the east entrance of Al-Eizariya detained Ahmad Jarradat (A resident of Jerusalem).
 - (iv) Israeli forces detained three residents: Ahmad Hindi, Majed Azzam and Muffid Al-Massri in Al-Jaddirah village.
 - (v) Israeli forces detained three residents: Wallid Mahmoud, Mohammad Obied and Abdel-Qadder Al-Dari in Al-Eisawiya.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Injury:</u> At 21:45 on November 25th 2014, Musa Abu Al-Hawa suffered a head injury during confrontations with Israeli forces in Al-Tur neighbourhood in addition to those mentioned in the previous report. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 18:00, Israeli settlers positioned near Yaffa road in Jerusalem city stabbed Ayoub Jarradat (A resident of Jerusalem) and as a result, left him hospitalised. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) At 23:10, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Labban Al-Gharbiya with cement blocks. • <u>Raid:</u> At 22:40, Israeli forces raided Beit Illu village, set up a checkpoint at the village entrance, prevented residents from entering or exiting the village and surveyed the area for alleged shooting at an Israeli settler vehicle.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Detention:</u> At 14:30, Israeli forces detained Nahal Ghawadrah (A resident of Beir Al-Basha) as she was visiting her husband in Al-Nakkab prison as she was accompanied by her children: Balqis (8 month old) and Bara’ (2 years old).
<p style="text-align: center;">TUBAS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Tamoun, stormed and searched a home owned by Nawaf Odeh, confiscated his cellular telephone then withdrew at 03:15. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:10, Israeli forces positioned at Tayassir checkpoint temporarily detained two residents: Ammar Abu Labba and Ayham Sawafta (both residents of Bardalah village) and released them at 08:40. (ii) At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned at Tayassir checkpoint temporarily detained two residents: Ahmad Sawafta and Ghassan Abu Ammar (both residents of Tubas) then released him later.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 16:55, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:25, Israeli forces raided Shufa village, set up a checkpoint then withdrew at 18:40. (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces raided the east area of Zieta, and fired flash grenades into the sky. (iii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Shwakiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem, stormed several homes, detained three residents then withdrew at 04:25. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained three residents: Mohammad Nayefa, Yusef Sarhan and Nasr Za'al in Shwakiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit junction until 16:00. (ii) At 15:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. • <u>Attack:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned at "Ayal" crossing located in North Qalqiliya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 14:45, Israeli settlers positioned near Al-Nabi Eliyas village assaulted Ahmad Abu Bakr (A resident of Arraba village in Jenin) as he was working at a vehicle repair shop in the village and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Deir Sharaf village (located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus) until 08:40. (ii) At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Nablus and Assirah Al-Shamaliya until 10:20. (iii) At 16:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Shave Shomron" settlement junction. • <u>Raid:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Burin village, stormed a home and summoned Mohammad Amran to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.

<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 19:45, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic until 20:10. • <u>Detention:</u> At 14:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of "Braqaan" settlement detained Husam Jabr (A resident of Harris village). • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 03:05, Israeli forces positioned at Zatra' checkpoint detained Adel Hijazi (A resident of Bethlehem) then released him after summoning him to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 03:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 05:50. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On November 26th 2014, Israeli settlers from "FeroD Yarihu" settlement pumped sewage waste from the settlement in to Wadi Qult area located in central Jericho.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.

	<p>(viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:00 and again at 16:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Kafar Itsiyon” settlement and temporarily detained Mohammad Abdel-Rahman Abdallah (A National Security force officer) and released him later and impeded the free flow of traffic until 16:45. • <u>Raid:</u> At 23:05, Israeli forces raided Za’tara until 00:30.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiw Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna located near the wall gate. (vii) At 13:40 on September 16th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge. (ii) At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Samou’. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed several homes, detained five residents then withdrew at 03:00. (ii) At dawn on November 27th 2014, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and summoned Jihad Khalil to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained five residents: Sa’di Al-Natsheh, Abdel-Alim Da’neh, Ramadan Qufishah, Ashraf Abu Sneineh and Khaled Al-Rajabi in Hebron. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.

(iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance.
