Killing	2	-	2	A resident was killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards him for allegedly attempting to stab a Israeli soldier near Za'tara checkpoint in Salfit and another resident was killed during confrontations near the entrance of Al-Aroub camp in Hebron.

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On November 26th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound, which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On November 16th 2015, Israeli forces closed the south entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem, which leads to “Armon Hanzif” settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on November 26th 2015 and again at 18:30, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, detained a resident after storming his home then withdrew at 21:30. (ii) At dawn on November 26th 2015, Israeli forces raided Biddu village until 09:30. • <u>Injury:</u> At 04:30 on November 26th 2015, 9 residents were injured including one critically injured during their raid into Qutna village. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 04:30 on November 26th 2015, Israeli forces detained five residents including a Preventive Security Force Officer: Mohammad Jaber Shamasneh, Hussien Mohammad Al-Fuqiyeh, Khaled Abdel-Nasser, Jihad Salah Husieyeh and Ramadan Abdallah Shamasneh during their raid into Qutna village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Eirikat in Abu Dis. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:40, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned near Beit Anan village fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 residents including 2 children: Anas Khalil Ahmad Rabah (17 years old)

	<p>{A resident of Qutna village}, Ahmad Ass'ad Hamaydeh (15 years old) {A resident of Beit Annan village} and Mohammad Raja'I Hamaydeh (A resident of Beit Annan village).</p> <p>(iii) At 22:50, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Thuri neighbourhood fired live ammunition; stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured an 11-year-old child with a bullet wound to his abdomen.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Physical Assault: At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya checkpoint assaulted Jawad Abdien Sha'ban (54 years old) {A resident of Ramallah} as he was passing through the checkpoint and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions. • Assault on Places of Worship: At 10:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) . On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) On November 24th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance gate leading to Sinjil and the east entrance of Mughier with cement blocks. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Ein Sinya village junction then searched residents and vehicles. (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Yabroud Village Bridge then searched residents and vehicles. (iii) At 20:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village and impeded the free flow of traffic after closing the steel entrance gate thus preventing residents from entering or exiting the village until reopening it later. (ii) At 20:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Taybeh. (iii) At 22:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city stormed and searched a Factory and NGO then confiscated surveillance camera footage then withdrew at 05:00. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Tarik Abdel-Rahman Hamayel, Alaa Sadeq Ba'irat and Waleed Ismail Dabrani {all residents of Kafr Malik village} during their raid into Deir Jrier village. • Attack:

(iii) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Sinjil fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • Raid: At dawn on November 26th 2015, Israeli forces raided Kafr Ra’I and detained two residents. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Muhanad Ismail Ya’aqba and Yusef Jamal Yusef Jawabra in Kafr Ra’i. • Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Home Demolition: On November 26th 2015, Israeli forces stormed Al-Hadidiya village located in the North Jordan valley village then demolished two residential barracks’ owned by Abdel-Raheem Basharat and Ali Mohammad Basharat.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic • Raid: At 23:05, Israeli forces raided Far’oun village until 00:30. • Attack: At 10:15, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of “Ghishouri” factories area located in wet Tulkarem fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they were protesting against the Israeli Military and settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem for alleged stoning and as a result injured 6 residents including a child: Abdel-Fattah Midhat Abdel-Kareem Ghannam (17 years old), Mu’in Ghazi Ali Basharat, Ramzi Omar Ali Sarhan, Islam Ayman Obied, Ghanam Mohammad Mahmoud Ghannam and Samer Kamal Kamal Fakhouri.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with a steel Gate • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the entrance of Azzoun Atmeh village then searched residents and vehicles, (ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Qalqiliya then searched residents and vehicles. • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:40, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate located in West Jayyous fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several

	<p>residents for alleged stoning .</p> <p>(ii) On November 26th, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate located in West of Qalqeleh, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning, and as a result injured 7 residents and lest several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:00 on November 26th 2015, Israeli forces detained Sa'ed Ibrahim Faris Nofal during their raid into Qalqiliya, (ii) At 02:10, Israeli forces detained Sannan Ahmad Mujahid Radwan during their raid in into Azzun. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) Since October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta village with dirt mounds. (iv) Since 06:30 on November 22nd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Aqraba and Yanoun village with dirt mounds. • <u>Closure of Checkpoint:</u> At 09:10, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic then at 10:30 closed the checkpoint during which Israeli forces opened fire towards a resident and as a result killed him for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier then impeded the free flow of traffic until 12:45. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Yitsahar settlement junction" located in North Huwara {after Israeli forces opened fire towards a residents and as a result killed him for allegedly stabbing a Israeli soldier} and impeded the free flow of traffic until 12:45. (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Osirin village junction then searched residents and vehicles. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on November 26th 2015, Israeli forces raided Beita and detained a resident. (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Iraq Burin village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 16:50. (iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Nablus, clashed with several residents as they stormed homes and detained two residents including a journalist then withdrew at 05:50. • <u>Detention:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On November 26th 2015, Israeli forces detained Bara' Izhiman (A resident of Nablus) as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon. (ii) Israeli forces detained Kahyri Jamil Haleel Dwikat in Beita. (iii) Israeli forces detained Samer Al-Assi (A journalist) and Abdallah Naji Abdallah Abu Samarah in Nablus. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Qa'dat area located near "Yitmar" settlement located in Beit Furiq fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces closed Za'tara checkpoint (during which Israeli forces opened fire towards a resident and as a result killed him for allegedly attempting to stab a Israeli soldier) then reopened it at 12:45 and at 19:40 Israeli forces closed the checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic {because a group of Israeli settlers gathering in the area} and reopened it at 20:55. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Ballout then searched residents and vehicles. (ii) At 21:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east Marda village thus preventing residents from entering or exiting the area until 21:50. • <u>Raid:</u> At 17:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya and occupied a home owned by Yasser Abu Zied and converted it into a military post then withdrew at 17:35. • <u>Attack:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces positioned near Za'tara checkpoint opened fire towards residents and as a result killed him for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli settler as alleged by the Israeli military. • <u>Killing:</u> Israeli forces positioned at Antara checkpoint opened fire towards and killed Samer Hassan Sarisi (51 years old) {A resident of Jenin}. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 21:35, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Za'tara checkpoint stoned residents and vehicles passing through the checkpoint.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Detention:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge detained Omar Mohammad Ali Hadoush {A resident of Surif village in Hebron} as he was travelling to Jordan. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 02:10, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Hamra checkpoint assaulted Haytham Assad Odah Alawneh (A resident of Al-Nassiriyah village in Nablus) and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man:

a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near “Ifrat” settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.

- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to “Newe Daniyyel” settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za’tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub’a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) Since January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- (ix) Since 10:45 on September 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near “Malee Amous” settlement with dirt mounds.
- (x) Since 15:30 on November 20th 2015, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinata with dirt mounds.
- (xi) At 13:10 on November 22nd 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Marah Rabah village with dirt mounds.

- **Flying Checkpoint:**

- (i) At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Beit Fajjar and prevented residents under the age of 25 from leaving the area.
- (ii) At 11:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Za’tara then searched residents and vehicles.
- (iii) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North west entrance of Beit Jallah and impeded the free flow of traffic until 16:40.
- (iv) At 15:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Taqou’ then searched residents and vehicles until 16:10.
- (v) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Manshiya village located in west Taqou’ then searched residents and vehicles until 19:55.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 18:50, Israeli forces raided Um Salmouna village until 20:50.
- (ii) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Obidiya until 01:50.

- (i) At 14:40, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp located in North Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and occupied an abandoned home owned by Al-Shwiki family and converted its rooftop into a military post then withdrew at 17:20.

	<p>(ii) At 20:25, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Taqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 09:20, Israeli forces stormed the area near the entrance of Husan village, and demolished three construction equipment shops owned by Fayez Sbatin, Izhaq Shushah and Bajes Shousheh for allegedly being built without a licence because of its location in area C which is under Israeli Military and Administrative authority.
<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) At 11:00 on August 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Hajara village located in south Dura with cement blocks. (vii) At 05:50 on November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading Farsh Al-Hawa area in Hebron with Cement blocks. (viii) Since November 11th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Beit Awwa and Al-Majd village with cement block and dirt mounds. (ix) Since November 11th 2015, Israeli forces closed the steel gate entrance of Beit Einoun village and Al-Fuwar junction and the entrance of Bani Na'im with cement blocks. (x) At 15:45 on November 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Samiya village junction located at the west entrance of Al-Samou' with cement blocks. (xi) On November 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances of Khaliat Al-Miya and Al-Dirat villages located along the bypass roads near east Yatta with dirt mounds. (xii) At 15:00 on November 10th 2015, Israeli forces closed the north entrance of Al-Thahriya. (xiii) At 14:00 on November 20th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Obadat, Beit Amrah, Deir Al-Assil, Razeh, and Qorma villages with cement blocks. (xiv) At 22:30, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Tal'at Abu Hadid area located

in the old city of Hebron with cement blocks.

- **Flying Checkpoint:**

- (i) At 07:50 on November 26th 2015, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Hebron located along road (35) near Halhoul bridge) then searched residents and vehicles.
- (ii) At 07:50 on November 26th 2015, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ras Al-Jorah area located in North Hebron city then searched residents and vehicles.
- (iii) At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Safa area located between Halhoul and Tarqumiya then searched residents and vehicles.
- (iv) At 09:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Zif village junction then searched residents and vehicles.
- (v) At 09:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Tarmah village junction then searched residents and vehicles.
- (vi) At 20:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhoul Bridge.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At dawn on November 26th 2015 and again at 04:00 on November 27th 2015, Israeli forces raided Hebron, detained two residents and stormed the home of Sa'ed Al-Atrash and took measurements of the house in order to prepare for its demolition.
- (ii) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Fuwar camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched several homes and as a result injured 5 residents : Huda Abdel-Azziz Kamal Nassar (71 years old), Cluadiya Al-Najjar, Mamdouh Abu Rabi', Qusay Mahmoud Abu Al-Haj, Shadi Jamil Abu Awwad as well as leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation then withdrew at 13:00.
- (iii) At 14:45, Israeli forces raided Beit Ulla then stormed and searched several homes.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli force positioned in the south area of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 16:05, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Tabaqa village area fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 16; 50 and gain at 19:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Aroub camp fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result killed a resident.

- **Killing:** Israeli forces opened fire towards and killed Khaled Mahmoud Jawabra (20 years old) {A resident of Al-Aroub camp}.

- **Detention:**

- (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces detained Munthir Abed Abu Ras (A resident of Dura) as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Malik Nader Karmat and Haytham Ziyad Hijazi Al-Rajabi in Hebron.

- **Destruction of Property:** At 12:10, Israeli forces stormed Al-Huwar area located in North Halhoul and demolished a water well network owned by Abdallah Karaja.
